The Western Confluence Matthew McKinney, Will Harmon, 2004-07-30 For 150 years the American West has been shaped by persistent conflicts over natural resources. This has given rise to a succession of strategies for resolving disputes: prior appropriation, scientific management, public participation, citizen ballot initiatives, public interest litigation, devolution, and interest-based negotiation. All of these strategies are still in play, yet the West remains mired in gridlock. In fact, these strategies are themselves a source of conflict. *The Western Confluence* is designed to help us navigate through the gridlock by reframing natural resource disputes and the strategies for resolving them. In it, authors Matthew McKinney and William Harmon trace the principles of natural resource governance across the history of western settlement and reveal how they have met at the beginning of the twenty-first century to create a turbid, often contentious confluence of laws, regulations, and policies. They also offer practical suggestions for resolving current and future disputes. Ultimately, Matthew McKinney and William Harmon argue, fully integrating the values of interest-based negotiation into the brier patch of existing public decision-making strategies is the best way to foster livable communities, vibrant economies, and healthy landscapes in the West. Relying on the authors' first-hand experience and compelling case studies, *The Western Confluence* offers useful information and insight for anyone involved with public decision-making, as well as for professionals, faculty, and students in natural resource management and environmental studies, conflict management, environmental management, and environmental policy.

The Governance of Western Public Lands Martin Nie, 2008-02-08 Issues like clearcutting, wilderness preservation, and economic development have dominated debates over public lands for years, yet we seem no closer to resolving these matters than we ever were. Martin Nie now looks at why there continues to be so much conflict about public lands and resource management and how we can break through these impasses. Showing that such conflicts have been driven by interrelated factors ranging from scarcity to mistrust and politics, he charts the present status and future prospects of public lands management in America. Nie looks closely at two of today's most intractable conflicts: the designation of U.S. Forest Service roadless areas and management of the Tongass National Forest in Alaska. He uses these cases to investigate more inclusive issues about governing federal lands in the West, such as the contested use of science and lengthy planning processes and controversial practices of Congress and the president in managing environmental disputes. Along the way, he addresses such other conflict areas as snowmobiles in Yellowstone, bear and wolf protection, fire, and forest health drilling in Montana's Rocky Mountain Front, and federal grazing policy. Nie emphasizes the complicated and often contentious interaction between the branches of the federal government as a major factor in misunderstandings. He particularly cites the problem of vague statutory language, which tells our public land agencies little about what they should be doing but lots about how they should be doing it. Nie reexamines this confusing body of law and policy in which the rulemaking process wags the dog and agencies are caught in political quagmires to show how the pieces fit but more often don't. Throughout the

book Nie considers the factors that make some public land conflicts so controversial revisits how they have been dealt with in the past and proposes ways they might be better managed in the future Eschewing the single policy approach to public lands management such as encouraging free markets he instead surveys a diverse array of other available options His big picture outlook for the twenty first century is a bold call for reshaping ongoing conflicts and for reinvesting in our public lands

Morris, William Allen Gibson, William Marshall Leavitt, Shana Campbell Jones, 2013-09-26 The nation s approach to managing environmental policy and protecting natural resources has shifted from the national government s top down command and control regulatory approach used almost exclusively in the 1970s to collaborative multi sector approaches used in recent decades to manage problems that are generally too complex too expensive and too politically divisive for one agency to manage or resolve on its own Governments have organized multi sector collaborations as a way to achieve better results for the past two decades We know much about why collaboration occurs We know a good deal about how collaborative processes work Collaborations organized led and managed by grassroots organizations are rarer though becoming more common We do not as yet have a clear understanding of how they might differ from government led collaborations Hampton Roads Virginia located at the southern end of the Chesapeake Bay offers an unusual opportunity to study and draw comparative lessons from three grassroots environmental collaborations to restore three rivers in the watershed in terms of how they build organize and distribute social capital deepen democratic values and succeed in meeting ecosystem restoration goals and benchmarks This is relevant for the entire Chesapeake Bay watershed but is also relevant for understanding grassroots collaborative options for managing protecting and restoring watersheds throughout the U S It may also provide useful information for developing grassroots collaborations in other policy sectors The premise underlying this work is that to continue making progress toward achieving substantive environmental outcomes in a world where the problems are complex expensive and politically divisive more non state stakeholders must be actively involved in defining the problems and developing solutions This will require more multi sector

collaborations of the type that governments have increasingly relied on for the past two decades Our approach examines one subset of environmental collaboration those driven and managed by grassroots organizations that were established to address specific environmental problems and provide implementable solutions to those problems so that we may draw lessons that inform other grassroots collaborative efforts
