

Looking for “Feminine Writing” in Literature

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Introduction

Is there such a thing as “feminine discourse”? Is there a discernable difference between the writing of male and female authors? People discussing this subject are trying to find out. There is a discussion about this subject even in different languages as if writing is not dependent upon language. If these intellectuals find a “feminine writing”, is this good or bad? Would “feminine writing” be based upon biology or culture? These are just a few questions about this topic.

While I would, personally, not argue that there is or is not a “feminine voice”, I would be put to task to define the difference. I know that I, as a reader, am one of the minorities who hear a voice while reading. This makes my reading slower, but my retention is also higher. I also notice that I do not remember being wrong about the gender of the writer, even when I read the text of a type where I do not immediately note the author, especially in academic writing. I often do not pay a lot of attention to the author before reading non-fiction, but when I find out the author’s name I can normally extrapolate the gender from it. While collaborative writing may be problematic, I do not remember ever noting that I had heard the wrong voice. It would be very interesting to find out why. Perhaps, in passing, I saw the author’s name and yet did not notice it consciously, but my mind matched it anyway. Perhaps, there is a difference between male and female writing.

I found Susan Sellers to be a little difficult to pin down. She quotes Cixous, and she attaches texts, but I just cannot make the connection between them. For example, in the introduction Sellers writes: “Cixous suggests that feminine writing is potentially the province of both sexes, she believes women are currently closer to a feminine economy than men. As a result, she sees in women’s writing the potential to circumvent and reformulate existing structures through the inclusion of other experiences.....Cixous

Hélène Cixous Verena Andermatt Conley, 1991-01-01 Born in Algeria in 1937 Hélène Cixous achieved world fame for her short stories criticism and fictionalized autobiography *Dedans* 1969 Her work quickly became controversial because it frankly tested a distinction between male and female writing Her literary experiments and her conclusions make her one of the most stimulating and most elusive feminist theorists of our time Verena Andermatt Conley a professor of French and women's studies at Miami University has written the first full length study of Cixous in English Looking at Cixous as writer teacher and theoretician Conley takes up Cixous's ongoing exploration of the feminine as related to the masculine words not to be equated with woman and man and her search for a terminology less freighted with emotion and prejudice Conley has updated this paperback edition with a new preface bibliography and interview with Cixous conducted by the editors of *Hors Cadre* *Rape and Writing in the Heptaméron of Marguerite de Navarre* Patricia Francis Cholakian, 1991 Marguerite de Navarre 1492-1549 the sister of the French king François I composed the *Heptaméron* as a complex collection of seventy-two novellas creating one of the first examples of realistic psychological fiction in French literature These novellas framed by debates among ten storytellers all noble lords and ladies reveal the author's desire to depart from the purely masculine voice of the age Cholakian contends that this Renaissance text is characterized by feminine writing She reads the text as the product of the author's personal experience Beginning her study with the rape narrative in the autobiographical novella 4 she examines how the *Heptaméron* interacts with male literary traditions and narrative conventions about gender relations She analyzes such words as rape and honor noting how they are defined differently by men and women and how these differences in perception affect the development of both plot and character Writing Against, Alongside and Beyond Memory Marilyn Metta, 2010 The thesis will conclude by bringing together reflections on the political social and therapeutic implications of writing personal life narratives the limitations of reflexive research methodologies and knowledge making and the implications of lifewriting research for feminist scholarship research and practice The concept of Ecriture Feminine in Helene Cixous's "The Laugh of the Medusa" Simon Wortmann, 2013-04-15 Essay from the year 2012 in the subject English Language and Literature Studies Literature grade 1-7 Christian Albrechts University of Kiel language English abstract In the year 1975 the French feminist author Helene Cixous published an essay called *The Laugh of the Medusa* In it she develops an entirely new theoretical concept with the aim of giving rise to feminist voice The central ideas of *Ecriture Feminine* literally women's writing are going to be presented in this paper In the first part a brief description of Cixous's intellectual milieu is given in order to show the actual reason that led her to come up with a new notion of liberating women from patriarchy In this context an elaboration on poststructuralism the philosophical current Cixous belonged to follows Closely related to that is the author's skepticism towards Sigmund Freud's language philosophy Specifically speaking Freud's statements on the penis envy theory Primary attention is paid to the theory of phallogentrism which can be seen as one of the main reasons for

Cixous's writings For a better understanding of this term the concept of logocentrism is also explained as well Logocentrism can be seen as a pillar of the theory of phallogentrism and therefore it deserves to be mentioned at this point In the second part we deal with the question of what is actually meant by women's writing Furthermore we will analyze which role the female body and sexuality plays in this context This excursion is highly interesting as it is crucial for the understanding of her concept Since the female body is considered a key for women to resist masculinist thinking and hence the systematic repression of women Apart from that we try to show whether features of *Écriture Feminine* are evident in the *The Laugh of the Medusa* Moreover a different viewpoint on Cixous's theory is shown in the chapter *Criticism* in which arguments for and against her theory are shown In point five Conclusion the main aspects of this paper are summed up When writing this paper the main source of information were essays on women's writing and French feminist writing dating from 1987 to 1986 Besides secondary literature on literary and cultural theory as well as feminist practice and poststructuralist theory were used Recent research on Cixous's work however could not be found The only source dealing particularly with her writings dates from 1991
