

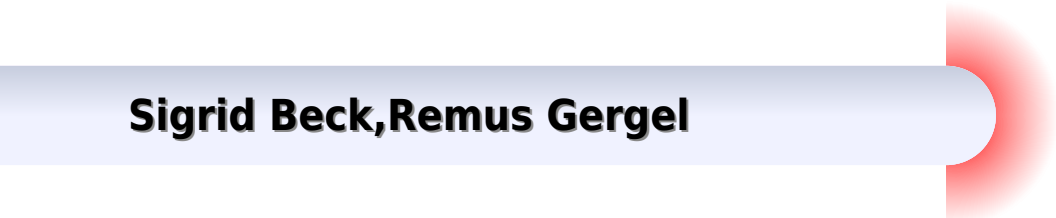

The Syntax of German Hubert Haider, 2010-01-07 What do you know if you know that a language has Object Verb structure rather than Verb Object Answering this question and many others this book provides an essential guide to the syntactic structure of German It examines the systematic differences between German and English which follow from this basic difference in sentence structure and presents the main results of syntactic research on German Topics covered include the strict word order in VO vs word order variation in OV verb clustering clause union effects obligatory functional subject position and subject object asymmetries for extractions Through this a cross model and cross linguistic comparison evolves highlighting the immediate implications for non Germanic OV languages and creating a detailed and comprehensive description of the syntactic differences that immediately follow from an OV type in contrast with a VO type like English It will be of interest to all those interested in syntax and Germanic languages *Germanic syntax* Stefan Müller, 2023-04-25 This book is an introduction to the syntactic structures that can be found in the Germanic languages The analyses are couched in the framework of HPSG light which is a simplified version of HPSG that uses trees to depict analyses rather than complicated attribute value matrices The book is written for students with basic knowledge about case constituent tests and simple phrase structure grammars advanced BA or MA level and for researchers with an interest in the Germanic languages and or an interest in Head Driven Phrase Structure Grammar Sign Based Construction Grammar without having the time to deal with all the details of these theories **Encyclopaedia of German diatheses** Michael Cysouw, 2023-03-14 Diathesis valency alternation is a sentence structure that reshapes the roles of a verb The prototypical example of such a diathesis is the well known passive However there are very many other such role remappings like antipassives applicatives causatives etc This book presents an encyclopaedic survey of diathesis in German The objective is to catalogue all diatheses that exist in this language Currently almost 250 different German diatheses are described in this book some highly productive some only attested for a handful of verbs The main goal of this book is to present this wealth of grammatical possibility in a unified manner while at the same time attempting to classify and organise this diversity A summary of the about 80 most prominent diatheses is also provided including many newly minted German names because most these diatheses did not have a German name yet It might come as a surprise that there are so many different diatheses in German but my impression is that in this respect German is no exception among the world s languages I expect that all languages have a similar abundance of different ways in which to construe a sentence around a lexical predicate In a sense a diathesis allows for the expression of a distinct perspective on the event described something that is arguably a common desire of any language user Except for diathesis this book also aims to completely catalogue its counterpart epithesis An epithesis is a derived sentence structure in which the marking of the verb roles remains constant Basically these are the grammaticalised constructions expressing tense aspect mood evidentiality in German The list of major epitheses is also quite long about 40 constructions but it is quite a bit

smaller than the list of major diatheses about 80 constructions This indicates that from a purely grammatical perspective diathesis grammatical voice is about a two times more elaborate topic than epithesis tense aspect mood marking in German

The licensing and usage of topic drop in German Lisa Schäfer, 2025-06-10

This book is concerned with the licensing and usage of the elliptical construction topic drop in German The term topic drop refers to the omission of the preverbal constituent in declarative verb second sentences for example the omission of the subject *ich* I in the sentence *Bin gleich zur ck Am* right back Topic drop exists in most of the Germanic verb second languages and typically occurs in spoken language and text types such as SMS chats notes etc While much of the previous research has focused on individual specific properties of topic drop often adopting a purely theoretical perspective this book presents a systematic investigation of both the syntactic properties and usage conditions of topic drop based on empirical evidence from a corpus study and 12 acceptability rating studies The first part of the book investigates the licensing of topic drop in particular its restriction to the preverbal prefield position The results of four rating studies on topic drop in different prefield configurations lead to a refined prefield condition based on proposals by Rizzi 1994 and Freywald 2020 that is independent of topicality Moreover they inform the discussion on the most suitable syntactic analysis of topic drop supporting a PF deletion approach The second part of the book presents and tests an information theoretic account of topic drop usage that builds on the Uniform Information Density hypothesis Levy Jaeger 2007 In a corpus study and seven rating studies several potential usage factors are investigated including grammatical person and verb predictability The results provide initial evidence suggesting that topic drop usage can be explained by general processing principles The prefield constituent is omitted when it is redundant and realized overtly when it facilitates the processing of the following verb This information theoretic explanation is based on independently evidenced processing mechanisms bundles isolated claims from the theoretical literature and allows for a unified analysis of topic drop with other types of ellipsis and reduction

Expletive and Referential Subject Pronouns in Medieval French Michael Zimmermann, 2014-09-12

Medieval French usually analyzed as a null subject language differs considerably from modern Romance null subject languages such as Spanish in the availability of non expressed subject pronouns specifically it shows characteristics reminiscent of non null rather than null subject languages such as the expression of expletive subject pronouns The central goal of this book is to put forward an account of these differences On the basis of the analysis of an extensive newly established data corpus the development of the expression of both expletive and referential subject pronouns until the 17th c is determined Following a thorough discussion of previous approaches an alternative approach is presented which builds on the analysis of Medieval French as a non null subject language The non expression of subject pronouns licit in specific contexts in non null subject

languages is shown to be restricted to configurations generally involving left peripheral focalization. These configurations and concomitantly non-expressed subject pronouns are finally argued to be eventually lost for good in the wake of the initial observation by 17th c writers of pertinent instructions campaigned for in highly influential works of language use.

Inner-sentential Propositional Proforms Werner Frey, André Meinunger, Kerstin Schwabe, 2016-07-26. This book deals with sentential proforms and their relationship to their associated clauses. Sentential proforms are highly interesting from the point of view of grammatical theory since their occurrence is determined not only by syntax but also by prosody and semantics. The present volume contributes to a better understanding of the interfaces between these different levels. By providing syntactic, prosodic, semantic, psycholinguistic and corpus based support, this book underpins the claim that there exist different sentential proform types in German and Dutch that these proform types correlate with different verb classes and that their associated related clauses are located in different syntactic positions. The present volume also looks at a Hungarian sentential proform construction which is similar to the Germanic structure but at the same time is different in its licensing conditions.

Morphosyntactic change in Late Modern Swedish Ida Larsson, Erik M. Petzell, 2022-03-16. This volume explores morphosyntactic change in the Late Modern Swedish period from the 18th century and onwards. This period is interesting for a number of reasons. This is when Swedish is established as a national standard language. New genres emerge and the written language becomes more generally available to all speakers. We also sometimes find diverging developments in the different North Germanic languages and some of the much discussed differences between Danish, Norwegian and Swedish are established during this period. In addition, during the 19th and 20th centuries, the traditional dialects undergo more dramatic changes than ever. Yet the Late Modern Swedish period has previously received fairly little attention in the syntactic literature. This volume aims to remedy this with studies that cover several different grammatical domains including case and verbal syntax, word order and agreement and grammaticalization in the nominal domain. The study by Cecilia Falk investigates the possibility of promoting an indirect object to subject in a passive that emerges during the period. A chapter by Fredrik Valdeson studies change in the use of ditransitive verbs from a constructional perspective. Three chapters are concerned with word order change. The study by Ida Larsson and Björn Lundquist investigates the development of a strict word order in particle constructions. Adrian Sangfelt studies the possibility of having adverbials and other constituents between the separate verbal heads in complex VPs in the final stages of the shift from OV to VO order. Erik M. Petzell investigates embedded verb placement and agreement morphology in the Viskadalian dialect which on the surface seems to contradict the Rich Agreement Hypothesis. Mikael Kalm discusses the emergence of different kinds of adverbial infinitival clauses in the standard written language compared to Vdalian. Finally, the study by Lars Olof Delsing is concerned with a case of grammaticalization in the nominal domain, specifically the development of the gradable adjectives *mycket* 'much' and *lite* 'little' into quantifiers.
