Research Handbook on the Sociology of Education Rolf Becker, 2019 Presenting original contributions from the key experts in the field the Research Handbook on the Sociology of Education explores the major theoretical methodological empirical and political challenges and pressing social questions facing education in current times *Trends in the Use of School Choice, 1993 to 1999* Stacey Bielick, Christopher Chapman, 2003 The National Household Education Surveys Program NHES provides a comprehensive set of information that may be used to estimate the use of school choice in the United States In this country school choice is primarily comprised of programs that allow students to attend any public school within or outside of their local school district a magnet or charter school a private school or homeschool This report examines data from three administrations or the NHES 1993 1996 and 1999 in which children's parents were asked if their children attended their assigned public schools public schools that they had chosen private schools that are church related or private schools that are not church related and about their satisfaction and involvement within these schools The report provides information about trends in the use and users of public schools of choice and private schools and outcomes of these choices parent satisfaction and involvement and student plans for postsecondary education The report also provides a brief analysis of homeschooled students This report cannot answer questions about the availability of public school choice or other school choice programs The report shows that the percentage of children enrolled in public assigned schools for grades 1 through 12 decreased from 80% in 1993 to 76% in 1999 The decrease in public assigned school enrollment was almost completely offset by an increase from 11 to 14% in public chosen school enrollment Enrollment in private church related schools remained relatively stable at 7 to 8% between 1993 and 1999 and enrollment in private not church related schools was about 2% in each year An appendix contains tables of numbers Contains 4 figures 11 tables and 42 references Author SLD
