Militarization and Democracy in West Germany's Border Police, 1951-2005 David M. Livingstone, 2024 A social history of

West Germany's Bundesgrenzschutz BGS Federal Border Police that complicates the telling of the country's history as a straightforward success story The 2020 murder of George Floyd by Minneapolis police officers shows that police violence is still a problem in Western democracies Floyd's murder prompted some critics to hail the German police as a model of democratic policing that should be emulated After 1945 Germany's police forces had supposedly shed the militarization and authoritarian impulses still prevalent in other nations' forces These uncritical appraisals however deserve closer analysis This book is a social history of West Germany's Bundesgrenzschutz BGS a federal border guard established in 1951 that became reunified Germany's first national police force It argues that the BGS revived authoritarian traditions of militarized policing and kept them alive long into the postwar era even though the country was supposedly consigning these problematic legacies to its past The BGS was staffed and led by Wehrmacht and SS veterans until the late 1970s and while West Germany was democratizing BGS commanders were still planning to fight wars and were teaching its officers street fighting tactics While the end outcome was positive the study contributes to the growing body of recent research that complicates the writing of the Federal Republic's history as a success story Dealing explicitly with post fascist West Germany's struggle to establish a democratic police force the book enters a conversation with studies concerned with democratization security and Germany's effort to overcome its Nazi past DAVID M LIVINGSTONE holds a PhD in History from the University of California San Diego He is retired as Chief of Police of Simi Valley California and is an adjunct professor at California Lutheran University

In Search of Criminal Responsibility

Nicola Lacey, 2016-05-12. What makes someone responsible for a crime and therefore liable to punishment under the criminal law? Modern lawyers will quickly and easily point to the criminal law's requirement of concurrent *actus reus* and *mens rea* doctrines of the criminal law which ensure that someone will only be found criminally responsible if they have committed criminal conduct while possessing capacities of understanding, awareness and self-control at the time of offense. Any notion of criminal responsibility based on the character of the offender, meaning an implication of criminality based on reputation or the assumed disposition of the person, would seem to today's criminal lawyer a relic of the 18th Century. In this volume, Nicola Lacey demonstrates that the practice of character-based patterns of attribution was not laid to rest in 18th Century criminal law but is alive and well in contemporary English criminal responsibility attribution. Building upon the analysis of criminal responsibility in her previous book *Women, Crime and Character*, Lacey investigates the changing nature of criminal responsibility in English law from the mid-18th Century to the early 21st Century. Through a combined philosophical, historical and socio-legal approach, this volume evidences how the theory behind criminal responsibility has shifted over time. The character and outcome responsibility which dominated criminal law in the 18th Century diminished in ideological importance in the following two centuries when the idea of responsibility as founded in capacity was gradually established as the core of criminal law. Lacey traces the historical trajectory of responsibility into the 21st Century, arguing that ideas of character responsibility and the discourse of responsibility as founded in risk are enjoying a renaissance in the modern criminal law. These ideas of criminal responsibility are explored through an examination of the institutions through which they are produced, interpreted and executed, the interests which have shaped both doctrines and institutions, and the substantive social functions which criminal law and punishment have been expected to perform at different points in history.

The International Criminal Court and Global Social Control

Nerida Chazal, 2015-12-14. The International Criminal Court was established in 2002 to prosecute war crimes, crimes against humanity and genocide. At its genesis, the ICC was expected to help prevent atrocities from arising or escalating by ending the impunity of leaders and administering punishment for the commission of international crimes. More than a decade later, the ICC's ability to achieve

these broad aims has been questioned as the ICC has reached only two guilty verdicts. In addition, some of the world's major powers including the United States, Russia, and China are not members of the ICC. These issues underscore a gap between the ideals of prevention and deterrence and the reality of the ICC's functioning. This book explores the gaps, schisms, and contradictions that are increasingly defining the International Criminal Court, moving beyond existing legal, international relations, and political accounts of the ICC to analyse the Court from a criminological standpoint. By exploring the way different actors engage with the ICC and viewing the Court through the framework of late modernity, the book considers how gaps between rhetoric and reality arise in the work of the ICC. Blood Inscriptions Hillel J. Kieval, 2022-02-15 Although the Enlightenment had seemed to bring an end to the widely held belief that Jews murdered Christian children for ritual purposes, charges of the so-called blood libel were surprisingly widespread in central and eastern Europe on either side of the turn to the twentieth century. Well over one hundred accusations were made against Jews in this period, and prosecutors and government officials in Germany, Austria, Hungary, and Russia broke with long established precedent to bring six of these cases forward in sensational public trials. In *Blood Inscriptions*, Hillel J. Kieval examines four cases: the prosecutions that took place at Tiszaeszlár in Hungary (1882–83), Xanten in Germany (1891–92), Polná in Austrian Bohemia (1899–1900), and Konitz (then Germany, now in Poland) (1900–1902) to consider the means by which discredited beliefs came to seem once again plausible. Kieval explores how educated elites took up the accusations of Jewish ritual murder and considers the roles played by government bureaucracies, the journalistic establishment, forensic medicine, and advanced legal practices in structuring the investigations and trials. The prosecutors, judges, forensic scientists, criminologists, and academic scholars of Judaism and other expert witnesses all worked hard to establish their epistemological authority as rationalists. Kieval contends: Far from being a throwback to the Middle Ages, these ritual murder trials were in all respects a product of post-Enlightenment politics and culture. Harnessed to and disciplined by the rhetoric of modernity, they were able to proceed precisely because they were framed by the idioms of scientific discourse and rationality.

Redeeming La Raza Gabriela González, 2018 The transborder modernization of Mexico and the American Southwest during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries transformed the lives of ethnic Mexicans across the political divide. While industrialization, urbanization, technology, privatization, and wealth concentration benefitted some, many more experienced dislocation, exploitative work relations, and discrimination based on race, gender, and class. The Mexican Revolution brought these issues to the fore within Mexican society, igniting a diaspora to el norte. Within the United States, similar economic and social power

dynamics plagued Tejanos and awaited the war refugees Political activism spearheaded by individuals and organizations such as the Idars Leonor Villegas de Magn n s White Cross the Magonista movement the Munguias Emma Tenayuca and LULAC emerged in the borderlands to address the needs of ethnic Mexicans whose lives were shaped by racism patriarchy and poverty As Gabriela Gonzalez shows in this book economic modernization relied on social hierarchies that were used to justify economic inequities Redeeming la raza was about saving ethnic Mexicans in Texas from a social hierarchy premised on false notions of white supremacy and Mexican inferiority Activists used privileges of class education networks and organizational skills to confront the many injustices that racism bred but they used different strategies Thus the anarcho syndicalist approach of Mag nistas stands in contrast to the social and cultural redemption politics of the Idars who used the press to challenge a Jaime Crow world Also the family promoted the intellectual material and cultural uplift of la raza working to combat negative stereotypes of ethnic Mexicans Similar contrasts can be drawn between the labor activism of Emma Tenayuca and the Munguias whose struggle for rights employed a politics of respectability that encouraged ethnic pride and unity Finally maternal feminist approaches and the politics of citizenship serve as reminders that gendered and nationalist rhetoric and practices foment hierarchies within civil and human rights organizations Redeeming La Raza examines efforts of activists to create a dignified place for ethnic Mexicans in American society by challenging white supremacy and the segregated world it spawned

Monarchies and Nations Paul Dresch, James P. Piscatori, 2005-05-27
