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A History of Women's Lives in Oxford Nell Darby,2021-08-30 Underneath the dreaming spires of Oxford s world famous university generations of women have lived their lives fighting for the right to study there and for a role within the city s educational political and social spheres Although a few of these women s names have been recorded for posterity they have been largely because of their association with worthy or famous men in this book though their own lives are detailed along with those who have been largely omitted from history Women s lives have always been less recorded than those of men where a woman helped her husband with his business this help may not have been formally recorded in the census returns and the details of jobs recorded there might not reflect the full scale of women s work and responsibilities So here learn about the variety of work women undertook their education their social lives and their attempts to carve out a valuable role for themselves Learn too of the problems they faced in living their lives poverty prison suicide or even murder This is no pretty picture of Oxford life designed for tourist brochures instead it aims to take a snapshot of the varied experiences of the city s female population over the course of a century

Eleanor Rathbone and the Politics of Conscience Susan Pedersen, 2004-01-01 When British women demanded the vote in the years before the First World War they promised to use political rights to remake their country and their world This is the story of Eleanor Rathbone the woman who best fulfilled that pledge Rathbone cut her political teeth in the suffrage movement in Liverpool spent two decades crafting social reforms for poor women and children and was for seventeen years their advocate in the House of Commons She also played a critical role in imperial policymaking and in the opposition to appeasement In the last decade of her life she sought to rescue Spanish republicans and Jews threatened by Hitler's rise to power In this important book Susan Pedersen illuminates both the public and private sides of Rathbone's life while restoring her to her rightful place as the most sophisticated feminist thinker and most effective British woman politician of the first half of the twentieth century

Higher Education and the Gendering of Space in England and Wales, 1869-1909 Georgia Oman, 2023-06-07 This book offers a spatial history of the decades in which women entered the universities as students for the first time Through focusing on several different types of spaces such as learning spaces leisure spaces and commuting spaces it argues that the nuances and realities of everyday life for both men and women students during this period can be found in the physical environments in which this education took place as declaring women eligible for admittance and degrees did not automatically usher in coeducation on equal terms It posits that the intersection of gender and space played an integral role in shaping the physical and social landscape of higher education in England and Wales in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries whether explicitly as epitomised by the building of single sex colleges or implicitly through assumed behavioural norms and practices

Writing Women's History Since the Renaissance Mary Spongberg, 2017-03-08 The complaint of Catherine Morland in Jane Austen's *Northanger Abbey* that history has hardly any women at all is not an uncommon one Yet there is evidence to suggest that women have engaged in historical writing since ancient times This study traces the history of women's historical writing reclaiming the lives of individual women historians recovering women's historical writings from the past and focusing on how gender has shaped the genre of history Mary Spongberg brings together for the first time an extensive survey of the progress of women's historical writing from the Renaissance to the present demonstrating the continuities between women's historical writings in the past and the development of a distinctly woman centred historiography *Writing Women's History since the Renaissance*

Whether feminist or anti feminist women who have had their historical writings published have served as role models for women seeking a voice in the public sphere and have been instrumental in encouraging the growth of a feminist discourse.

Names and Stories Kali Israel, 2002-09-26 Emilia Dilke 1840-1904 was christened Emily Francis Strong and known by her middle name throughout her childhood as the daughter of an army officer cum bank manager in Iffley England near Oxford and her days as an art student in London. During her first marriage she was Francis Pattison or Mrs Mark Pattison while her published works of art history and criticism were neutrally signed E F S Pattison. Later in the 1870s she privately changed her first name to Emilia a switch made public when she remarried in 1885. By this second nuptial union she became Lady Dilke the famous intellectual feminist art critic author and eventually the active and popular President of the Women's Trade Union League for nearly twenty years. A rich work of biography literary criticism aesthetic history and sociocultural inquiry *Names and Stories* traces the life of this fascinating and remarkable woman as it was lived under many different appellations and guises. In doing so the book investigates the full spectrum of nineteenth century British thought and custom. By studying not only an individual life but the many stories that informed determined and challenged that life author Kali Israel considers Dilke as both subject and object author and character player and pawn in the Victorian world of which she was a part. As they are chronicled explained and contextualized in this book these stories however they were created told or interpreted move through realms both historical and fictional. Israel's central character experienced not one but two highly visible marriages marked by rampant gossip high profile sex scandals and inconclusive courtroom battles was considered by some to be the model for the character of Dorothea in Eliot's *Middlemarch* and similarly appeared in many other novels plays and even poems in her own time and up through the mid twentieth century. *Names and Stories* is not a conventional life and times book even though it recounts a birth to death adventure that is both unique and epochal. Rather the work utilizes Dilke's myriad narratives as the means to broader critical historical and theoretical engagements. Debating the very nature of life study and biography writing Israel employs a wide array of published and primary sources to argue that the names and stories of Emilia Dilke can help us understand key conflicts and tensions within Victorian Britain as well as ongoing cultural arguments. This book thus examines several nineteenth century pressure points in this light among them gender representation authority authorship knowledge and political thought. Israel's contemporary and cross disciplinary study also illuminates such broader themes as the family the body narrative figuration and historical writing and reading. **University Women** Sara Z. Macdonald, 2021-11-15 Bessie Scott nearing the end of her first year at university in the spring of 1890 recorded in her diary: "Wore my gown for first time. It didn't seem at all strange to do so. Often deemed a cumbersome tradition by men the cap and gown were dearly prized by women as an outward sign of their hard won admission to the rank of undergraduates. For the

first generations of university women higher education was an exhilarating and transformative experience but these opportunities would narrow in the decades that followed In *University Women* Sara MacDonald explores the processes of integration and separation that marked women's contested entrance into higher education Examining the period between 1870 and 1930 this book is the first to provide a comparative study of women at universities across Canada MacDonald concludes that women's higher education cannot be seen as a progressive narrative a triumphant story of trailblazers and firsts of doors being thrown open and staying open The early promise of equal education was not fulfilled in the longer term as a backlash against the growing presence of women on campuses resulted in separate academic programs closer moral regulation and barriers that restricted their admission into the burgeoning fields of science technology engineering and mathematics The modernization of higher education ultimately marginalized women students researchers and faculty within the diversified universities of the twentieth century *University Women* uncovers the systemic inequalities based on gender race and class that have shaped Canadian higher education It is indispensable reading for those concerned with the underrepresentation of girls and women in STEM and current initiatives to address issues of access and equity within our academic institutions
