Shakespeare's Troilus and Cressida Roger Apfelbaum, 2004 Theater history and bibliography exist on the fringes of dramatic criticism rarely influencing studies outside their fields and even less often combined with each other There is however much to be gained from a dialogue between theatrical choices and textual problems There are nearly five hundred substantive differences between the 1609 Quarto and 1623 Folio versions of Shakespeare's *Troilus and Cressida* and many more instances where editors rewrote the dialogue and stage directions This book studies a selection of variants and emendations in *Troilus and Cressida* with extensive reference to the theater history of the passages showing how production decisions can provide a valuable commentary on editorial questions

Paul Yachnin, Patricia Badir, 2017-05-15 Theatrical performance suggest the contributors to this volume can be an unpredictable individual experience as well as a communal institutional or cultural event The essays collected here use the tools of theatre history in their investigation into the phenomenology of the performance experience yet they are also careful to consider the social ideological and institutional contingencies that determine the production and reception of the living spectacle Thus contributors combine a formalist interest in the affective and aesthetic dimensions of language and spectacle with an investment in the material cultures that both produced and received Shakespeare's plays Six of the chapters focus on early modern cultures of performance looking specifically at such topics as the performance of rusticity the culture of credit contract and performance the cultivation of Englishness religious ritual and mourning and memory Building upon and interrelating with the preceding essays the last three chapters deal with Shakespeare and performance culture in modernity They focus on themes including literary and theatrical performance anxiety cultural iconicity and the performance of Shakespearean lateness This collection strives to bring better understanding to Shakespeare's imaginative investment in the relationship between theatrical production and the emotional intellectual and cultural effects of performance broadly defined in social terms

Hearing Knowing and Audiences Onstage and Off and Transhearing Hearing Whispering Overhearing and Eavesdropping in Film and Other Media Chapters by noted scholars explore the complex reactions and interactions of onstage and offstage audiences and show how Shakespearean stagecraft actualized on stage and adapted on screen revolves around various situations and conventions of hearing soliloquies asides eavesdropping overhearing and stage whispers In short Who Hears in Shakespeare enunciates Shakespeare's nuanced powerful stagecraft of hearing The volume ends with Stephen Booth's afterword his inspiring meditation on hearing that considers Shakespearean audiences and their responses to what they hear or don't hear in Shakespeare's plays Troilus and Cressida William Shakespeare,1976 This was John Barton's third production of Troilus and Cressida for the Company what came to be known as his signature play and one in which he sought to emphasise the play's ambiguities Barton's interpretation for the 1976 production was based on the key line Lechery lechery still wars and lechery spoken by Thersites in Act 5 Scene 2 The production was staged on the fixed wooden set designed by Chris Dyer and John Napier for the entire 1976 season at the Royal Shakespeare Theatre It consisted of a jutting hexagonal stage and vertical beams the bases of which in this production were sometimes decorated with large grotesque masks The costumes designed by Dyer were generally classical When Cressida arrived in the Greek camp she was dressed like a courtesan prostitute of the period Some of the warriors such as Hector wore elaborate plumed helmets although in the case of the Trojans very little else Fascinated by narrative sagas like the Trojan War Barton went on to direct a multi play cycle The Greeks for the RSC in 1980 The Prologue was spoken by only one of the listed actors at each performance
