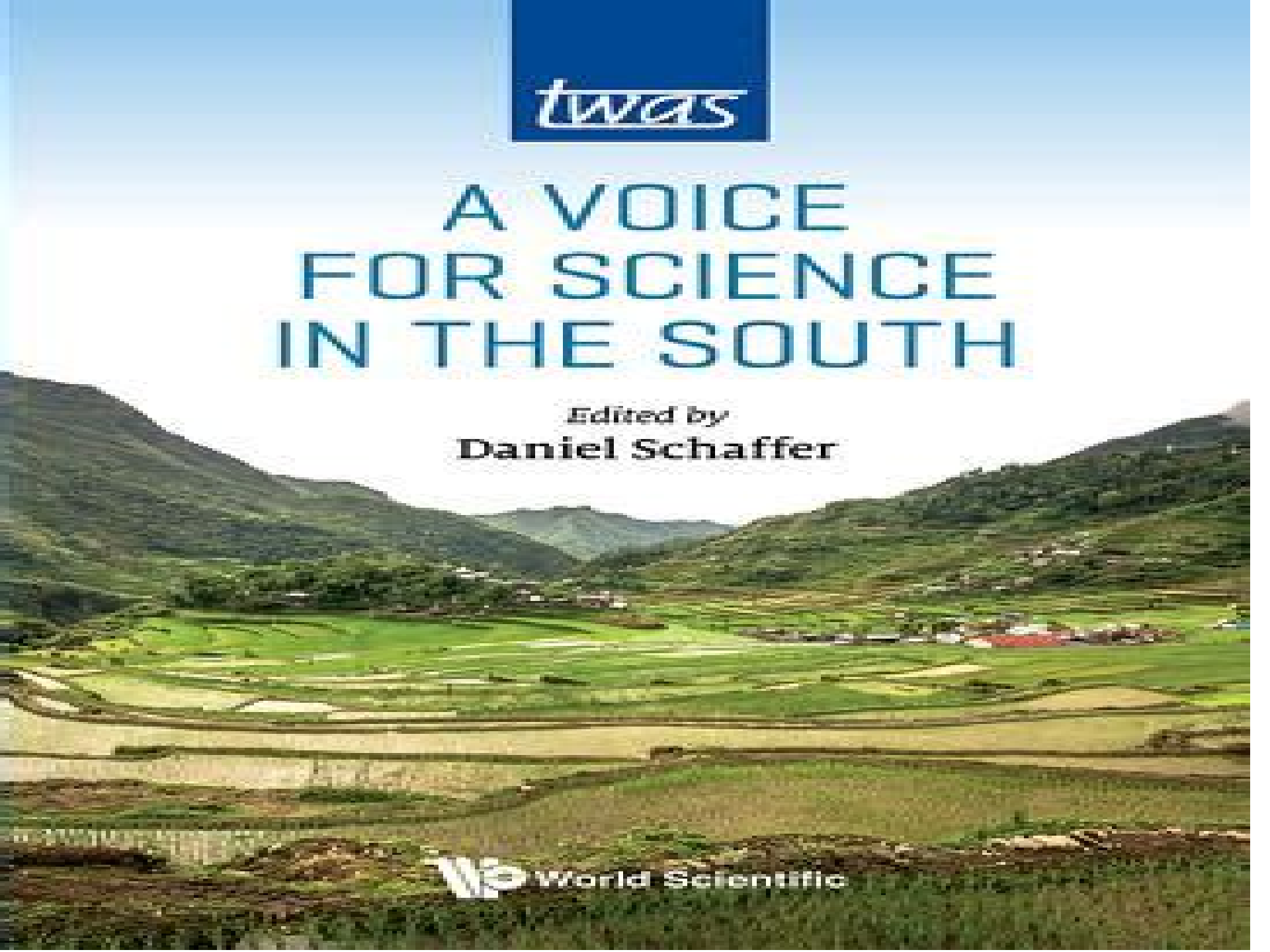

Framing Monsters Joshua David Bellin, 2005 Beginning with celebrated classics the author locates King Kong 1933 within the era of lynching to evince how the film protects whiteness against supposed aggressions of a black predator and reviews The Wizard of Oz 1939 as a product of the Depression's economic anxieties From there the study moves to the cult classic animated Sinbad Trilogy 1958 1977 of Ray Harryhausen films rampant with xenophobic fears of the Middle East as relevant today as when the series was originally produced Advancing to more recent subjects the author focuses on the image of the monstrous woman and the threat of reproductive freedom found in Aliens 1986 Jurassic Park 1993 and Species 1995 and on depictions of the mentally ill as dangerous deviants in 12 Monkeys 1996 and The Cell 2000 An investigation into physical freakishness guides his approach to Edward Scissorhands 1990 and Beauty and the Beast 1991

Sound Authorities Edward J. Gillin, 2022-02-11 Sound Authorities shows how experiences of music and sound played

a crucial role in nineteenth century scientific inquiry in Britain In *Sound Authorities* Edward J Gillin focuses on hearing and aurality in Victorian Britain claiming that the development of the natural sciences in this era cannot be understood without attending to the study of sound and music During this time scientific practitioners attempted to fashion themselves as authorities on sonorous phenomena coming into conflict with traditional musical elites as well as religious bodies Gillin pays attention to sound in both musical and nonmusical contexts specifically the cacophony of British industrialization *Sound Authorities* begins with the place of acoustics in early nineteenth century London examining scientific exhibitions lectures spectacles workshops laboratories and showrooms He goes on to explore how mathematicians mobilized sound in their understanding of natural laws and their vision of a harmonious ordered universe In closing Gillin delves into the era s religious and metaphysical debates over the place of music and humanity in nature the relationship between music and the divine and the tensions between spiritualist understandings of sound and scientific ones

Sound Knowledge J. Q. Davies, Ellen Lockhart, 2017-01-30 What does it mean to hear scientifically What does it mean to see musically This volume uncovers a new side to the long nineteenth century in London a hidden history in which virtuosic musical entertainment and scientific discovery intersected in remarkable ways *Sound Knowledge* examines how scientific truth was accrued by means of visual and aural experience and in turn how musical knowledge was located in relation to empirical scientific practice James Q Davies and Ellen Lockhart gather work by leading scholars to explore a crucial sixty year period beginning with Charles Burney s ambitious *General History of Music* a four volume study of music around the globe and extending to the Great Exhibition of 1851 where musical instruments were assembled alongside the technologies of science and industry in the immense glass encased collections of the Crystal Palace Importantly as the contributions show both the power of science and the power of music relied on performance spectacle and experiment Ultimately this volume sets the stage for a new picture of modern disciplinarity shining light on an era before the division of aural and visual knowledge

Tate, 2019-06-12 This book explores the many facets of black urban life from its genesis in the 18th century to the present time With some historical background the volume is primarily a contemporary critique focusing on the major themes which have arisen and the challenges the confront African Americans as they create communities political economy religion and spirituality health care education protest and popular culture The essays all examine the interplay between culture and politics and the ways in which forms of cultural expression and political participation have changed over the past century to serve the needs of the black urban community The collection closes with analysis of current struggles these communities face joblessness political discontent frustrations with health care and urban schools and the ways in which communities are responding to these challenges

Gaining Voice Christopher J. Clark, 2019-02-25 Scholars studying the causes and consequences of political representation particularly in terms of gender and race often turn to a concept called descriptive representation Descriptive representation tells us the degree to which elected officials resemble their

constituents and whether such a resemblance has a bearing on the way they legislate. In other words, do people vote for candidates of their same racial/ethnic background or gender? If they do, does this affect the type of policies an elected official pursues? Further, if citizens see people who look like them in office, does it have an effect on their political attitudes and participation? In this book, Christopher J. Clark argues that descriptive representation is a more multifaceted phenomenon than previously shown, particularly when observed at the state level. He contends that black political involvement, political attitudes, and public opinion are contingent on more than being represented by a single black elected official. Rather, they hinge on the proportion of African Americans making up a state legislature, what Clark terms black seat share, as well as the degree to which that proportion reflects the demographic makeup of the state. As well, Clark pinpoints the critical mass of African American legislators necessary to initiate the creation of black caucuses, an important institution for minority representation. Clark bases his study on an examination of black representation in state legislatures between 1966 and 2010, looking particularly at black political opinion and involvement in the development of welfare and education policy.

Founded during World War II, Oak Ridge, Tennessee, was a vital link in the U.S. military's atomic bomb assembly line, the site where scientists worked at a breakneck pace to turn tons of uranium into a few grams of the artificial element plutonium. To construct and operate the plants needed for this effort, thousands of workers, both skilled and unskilled, converged on the city behind a fence tucked between two ridges of sparsely populated farmland in the Tennessee hills. *At Work in the Atomic City* explores the world of those workers and their efforts to form unions, create a community, and gain political rights over their city. It follows them from their arrival at Oak Ridge to the places where they lived and to their experiences in a dangerous and secretive workplace. Lured by promises of housing, plentiful work, and schooling for their children, they were often exposed to

dangerous levels of radioactivity harmful chemicals and other hazards Although scientists and doctors intended to protect workers the pressure to produce materials for the bomb often overrode safety considerations After the war as the military sought to reduce services and jobs in Oak Ridge workers organized unions at two plants to demand higher wages and job security However the new Taft Hartley Act limited defense workers ability to strike and thus curbed union influence The book examines the ongoing debates over workers rights at Oak Ridge notably the controversy surrounding the new federal program intended to compensate workers and their families for injuries sustained on the job Because of faulty record keeping at the facilities and confusion over exposure levels many have been denied payment to this day Drawing on extensive research into oral history collections transcripts of government proceedings and other primary sources *At Work in the Atomic City* is the first detailed account of the workers who built and labored in the facilities that helped ensure the success of the Manhattan Project a story known heretofore only in broad outline Russell Olwell an assistant professor of history at Eastern Michigan University has published articles in *ISIS Tennessee Historical Quarterly* and *Technology and Culture* *Current Bibliographies in Medicine* ,1988 **Audiovisuals in Dermatology** Dale T.
