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9 Youth in post-conflict reconstruction

The case of the Gaza Strip

Introduction

Youth participation is seen as the active involvement of young people in their societies throughout all levels of political, social, and economic life, in a manner that enables them to achieve their aspirations, improve their standard of life, and influence decision-making circles (Chickony and Gutierrez, 2008, p. 1). Those young people are considered as a vital component for development, social change, economic growth, and technological innovation (Campbell and Firshein, 2012, p. 69). In conflict zones, there is a lack of youth participation in peacebuilding processes, reconciliation programmes, and post-conflict reconstruction initiatives, leading to a state of desperation among youth and the desire to leave their societies, as is the case in the Gaza Strip (Interpeace and United Nations, 2017, p. 5).

Following the Israeli military invasion against Gaza in 2014, the reconstruction of Gaza catapulted to the international headlines when more than 50 states pledged to provide funds of US\$5.082 billion for rebuilding the coastal enclave, in “an international conference [was] held in Cairo in October 2014” (Zureik, 2018, p. 4). After several months, the reconstruction process was started without paying attention to the role of youth, and they were excluded from the process entirely (Abumudin, 2020). Over the past decades, Palestinian youth have played a major role in their societies through the active involvement in peacebuilding initiatives at both national and international levels. However, this role was undermined because of several factors: the ongoing Israeli occupation and the Palestinian political rift between Hamas – the de facto government in Gaza – and the Fatah-led Palestinian Authority (PA) in the West Bank (Swart, 2019). These factors have severely contributed to reducing the possibility of engaging a youth component in the reconstruction efforts in the aftermath of the 2014 war against the Gaza Strip.

The Case for the Empowerment of Youth in Post-Conflict Societies Jannike Riesch,2019-04-05 Essay from the year 2017 in the subject Politics Topic Peace and Conflict Security grade 1 0 Charles University in Prague Political Science course Justice and Reconciliation in Post Conflict Societies language English abstract Within this essay I will answer the question as to why it is important to empower youth in post conflict societies In order to do so I will first engage in the theoretical framework for example the definitions of youth and peacebuilding After that I will make the case in favor of the empowerment of youth by looking at 1 the very nature and characteristics of the social category that is youth and 2 the practical considerations that speak for empowering youth In order to illustrate my argument I will then point out why it is important to focus on youth in the exemplary case of post conflict Bosnia and Herzegovina BiH Lastly in the concluding remarks I will consider what implications the findings might or should have for the future of youth in post conflict societies On the 9th of December 2015 the United Nations Security Council UNSC unanimously adopted a resolution With that the UNSC did not only acknowledge the potential of young people as active and positive contributors to peace and stability it also tried to open up more possibilities in order to further empower youth to take part in the political processes within their respective countries While so far young people have often been marginalized in post conflict settings and their potential to contribute to the creating or maintaining of peace has mostly been overlooked Resolution 2550 sets a new focus and thus seems to mark a shift in the perception of youth Youth s potential in becoming active and positive agents of building peace remains untapped if they are marginalized both in the academic and political context Thus the main aim of this essay is to show why it is of crucial importance to change the perception of youth in post conflict societies and empower them to make a difference

International Development Committee, 2014 Sierra Leone and Liberia have made remarkable recoveries since their civil wars Ban Ki Moon was in Freetown this month to bring an end to the UN Security mission and set the UN presence on a conventional development footing from 1st April 2014 In Liberia there has been a gradual drawdown of the peacekeeping mission which will approximately halve the UN military presence by 2015 However both countries remain fragile with high unemployment and concerns about corruption The devastating Ebola outbreak in Sierra Leone and Liberia demonstrates the dangers of ignoring the least developed countries in the world The weak state of the health system in both countries has greatly reduced the effectiveness of the response to Ebola There is an alarming lack of capacity in the health system including a shortage of skilled clinicians The Committee have determined that the scale of the Ebola crisis now unfolding in Sierra Leone and Liberia may well be connected to declining levels of international support for health system improvements in what remain two of the poorest and least developed countries in the world
