Burg, Adolf Carlson, 2013-01-28 By the summer of 1995 it appeared possible that the wars in the former Yugoslavia had reached a climactic point During that summer Croatia's army revealed itself as a professional competent force and recaptured the Krajina territory lost to Serbia in 1991 Though this campaign led to thousands of Serb refugees neither the UN nor the West did anything and indeed it was clear that this offensive enjoyed tacit Western support In August 1995 immediately following this campaign the United States launched its own diplomatic offensive that combined its political standing Croatia's military prowess and NATO bombing of Bosnian Serb positions due to Serb shelling of Sarajevo and other safe havens While the outline of an accord was signed in Geneva on September 8 1995 stating that Bosnia would be a state within its internationally recognized borders and would contain a Serbian entity Republika Srpska that could have ties abroad the bombing continued as the Bosnian Serb military leadership refused to bow to NATO demands for withdrawal of its artillery from the exclusion zone around Sarajevo Thus although a peace accord or the outline of one exists the wars are hardly over and most if not all political issues remain to be settled This most recent turn of events described above reflects the fact that already by June 1995 United States and its allies stood at a dangerous fork in the road in confronting the wars in the former Yugoslavia The truce negotiated in December 1994 never was really effective and by April it had broken down totally In May Croatia launched a new offensive to regain Serbian inhabited territories lost when Serbia invaded in 1991 By doing this Zagreb further exposed the inadequacy of the United Nations Protection Force UNPROFOR the UN mission in Yugoslavia as a force for peacekeeping Since Croatia Bosnia and the Bosnian Serbs were all willing to go on fighting because they believed that they had more to gain from war than they did from any negotiation these events made the position of the UN's forces even more precarious These events by June had led to increased shelling by both sides in the vicinity of Sarajevo and other major Bosnian cities These truce violations further dramatized the helplessness of the UN's forces and once again revealed that they were ultimately hostages to the belligerents' intentions When General Rupert Smith of the United Kingdom UNPROFOR's CINC called for NATO air strikes on the Bosnian Serbs on May 25 26 1995 the Serbs retaliated by making hostages out of the UN soldiers Thus for the second time UNPROFOR found itself in danger of exposure as an ineffective military force Worse yet until the Croatian Army swung into action it seemed as if the Bosnian Serbs would be able to go on defying the world seizing cities conducting massacres and ethnic cleansing and so on with impunity *Yugoslavia's Wars: The Problem from Hell*, **The Prevention and Intervention of Genocide** Samuel Totten, 2017-09-08 Over the last twenty years the world has witnessed four major genocides There was the genocide in Iraq 1988 in Rwanda 1994 in Srebrenica 1995 and in Darfur 2003 and continuing Most observers agree there is an urgent need to assess the international community's efforts to prevent genocide and to intervene once a genocide is under way in an effective and timely manner

This volume the latest in a widely respected series on the subject of genocide provides an overview of a host of issues germane to this task. The book begins with a cogent discussion of the issues of prevention and intervention during the Cold War years. The second chapter discusses the abject failures and moderate though in some cases highly controversial successes at prevention and intervention carried out in the 1990s and early 2000s. Further chapters examine latest efforts to develop an effective genocide early warning system and examine the complexity of and barriers to prevention. The pros and cons of sanctions and the problems of enforcement and evaluation their effectiveness are then discussed. Conflicts between state sovereignty and the protection of threatened populations are examined both in historical context and by incorporating the latest thinking. Later chapters treat the issue of intervention why and how it has met with only limited success. Concentrating on Rwanda and Srebrenica chapter 8 discusses various peace operations that were abject failures and those that were moderately successful. The concept of an anti genocide regime is examined in terms of progress in developing such a regime as well as what the international community must do in order to implement it. Chapters discuss key issues related to post genocidal periods those that need to be addressed in order to establish stability in a wounded land and populace as well as to prevent future genocides. The final chapter asks whether bringing perpetrators to justice has any impact in breaking impunity ensuring deterrence and bringing about reconciliation. The contributors to the volume are all noted scholars some of whom specialize in the study of genocide and others who specialize in such areas as early warning peacekeeping and sanctions.

This volume is the first comprehensive scholarly analysis of the strategic reconfiguration of Central Asia as Russia has become more disengaged from the nations in the region and as these nations have developed new relations to the south east and west. The international implications are enormous because of the rich energy sources oil and natural gas located in the Caspian Sea area. The authors assess a variety of internal security policy challenges confronting these states for example the potential for conflict arising from such factors as a mixed ethnic population resource scarcity particularly in relation to water management and an Islamic revival. They also examine the security policy content of relations between the

Central Asian states and regional and international powers specifically the stakes interests and policies of Russia China Iran Turkey and the United States These internal challenges and the evolution of relations with external powers may result in new cooperative relationships but they may also lead to destabilizing rivalry and interstate enmity in Central Asia It is important to identify new patterns of relevance for future security cooperation in the region but the potential for a new security system or for new institutions to manage security in the region remains uncertain These issues are explored by a team of prominent specialists from Western Europe the United States Russia and China

Bjelic, 2016-05-23 Normalizing the Balkans argues that following the historical patterns of colonial psychoanalysis and psychiatry in British India and French Africa as well as Nazi psychoanalysis and psychiatry the psychoanalysis and psychiatry of the Balkans during the 1990s deployed the language of psychic normality to represent the space of the Other as insane geography and to justify its military or its symbolic takeover Freud s self analysis influenced by his journeys through the Balkans was a harbinger of orientalism as articulated by Said However whereas Said intended Orientalism to be a critique of the historical construction of the Orient by and in relation to the West for Freud it constituted a medical and psychic truth Freud s self orientalizing became the structural foundation of psychoanalytic language which had tragic consequences in the Balkans when a demonic conjunction developed between the ingrained self orientalizing structure of psychoanalysis and the Balkans own propensity for self orientalizing In the 1990s in the ex Yugoslav cultural space psychoanalytic language was used by the Serb psychiatrist politicians Drs Ra kovic and Karadzic as conceptual justification for inter ethnic violence Kristeva s discourse on abject geography and Zizek s conceptualization of the Balkans as the Real have done violence to the region in an intellectual register on behalf of universal subjectivity Following Gramsci s and Said s discourse geography Bjelic transmutes the psychoanalytic topos of the imaginary geography of the Balkans into the geopolitics inherent in psychoanalytic language itself and takes to task the practices of normalization that underpin the Balkans politics of madness

It closes the so-called post Cold War epoch that began with the fall of the Soviet empire and opens the way to a new stage in European and American history. The tendencies that are now pushing Europe towards greater integration have received a new injection of energy. NATO has not only proven itself the only truly effective security provider among European institutions it has also shown itself to be the moving force behind Europe's other security agencies particularly the European Union. EU After NATO decided to take in Hungary the Czech Republic and Poland at its Madrid Conference in July 1997 the European Union meeting at Amsterdam decided to begin accession talks with those three states Estonia Cyprus and Slovenia. Thus concurrent and coinciding waves of integration throughout the continent are going to transform Europe's security map and agenda beyond recognition. But this does not mean either that past history is now utterly irrelevant or that Europe has attained a kind of security Nirvana. The Bosnian crisis and to a lesser degree the Albanian crisis of 1997 as well as the recent problems in Kosovo show that many challenges confront Europe and that Europe is reluctant to confront them.

Saw Myat Sandy's study deals with theoretical and empirical analysis of the political transitions in former Yugoslavia and Burma the present day Myanmar. It covers the transition period of both states from the late 1980s until present. The author examines the democratic transition in both states where the process has been unsuccessfully accomplished i.e. after a very promising beginning sooner or later undermined by the challenges of the transition which threatened to reverse what was gained by democratisation. In this dissertation Saw Myat Sandy argues that the democratic transition in both states became an extended process of transition because of its multi-ethnic societies. The democratisation in former Yugoslavia led to disintegration and in Myanmar it is proving to be an intractable one and has become almost unresolvable to anyone's satisfaction. Myanmar today suffers from on going political instabilities that cause political and social fragmentations but does not demonstrate that it will fall into conventional Balkan scenarios. This dissertation analyses if Myanmar's political transition will follow the former Yugoslavian fate by using the transition theoretical framework and highlighting the empirical facts on the problems of ethnicity and other political factors that relate to these democratisation processes. The theoretical approaches are based on the democratic transition and consolidation theories argued by Juan J Linz Alfred Stepan and Samuel Huntington. As opposed to many
