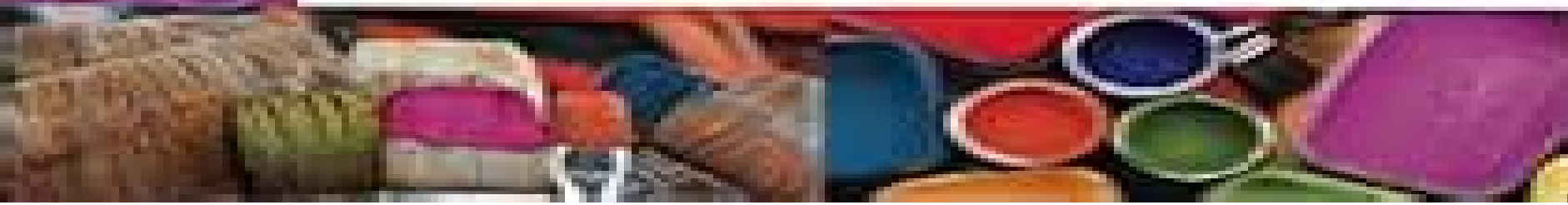

Working Woman ,1983 **From San Francisco Eastward** Carolyn Grattan Eichin, 2020-02-12 Finalist for the 2021 Willa Literary Award in Scholarly Non Fiction Finalist for the 2021 Will Rogers Medallion Award in Western Non Fiction Carolyn Grattan Eichin s *From San Francisco Eastward* explores the dynamics and influence of theater in the West during the Victorian era San Francisco Eichin argues served as the nucleus of the western theatrical world having attained prominence behind only New York and Boston as the nation s most important

theatrical center by 1870 By focusing on the West's hinterland communities theater as a capitalist venture driven by the sale of cultural forms is illuminated against the backdrop of urbanization Using the vagaries of the West's notorious boom bust economic cycles Eichin traces the fiscal demographic and geographic influences that shaped western theater With an emphasis on the 1860s and 70s this thoroughly researched work uses distinct notions of ethnicity class and gender to examine a cultural institution driven by a market economy From San Francisco Eastward is a thorough analysis of the ever changing theatrical personalities and strategies that shaped Victorian theater in the West and the ways in which theater as a business transformed the values of a region

Reading on the Middle Border Christine Pawley, 2010-01-20 Reading is an everyday activity so taken for granted that it seems virtually invisible In spite of its ubiquity in modern life or perhaps because of its familiarity scholars have only recently begun paying attention to its development as a social practice During the nineteenth century an evolving print culture made reading an essential part of Americans daily routines To date the history of American reading practices has tended to focus on middle class white people living in northeastern cities before 1876 Reading on the Middle Border shifts the focus to the Midwest and broadens the base of economic classes studied Christine Pawley investigates the use of print by ordinary Americans in the small rural community of Osage Iowa the town that shaped Hamlin Garland analyzing primary source material on education religious life a reading club and business affairs A major section of her study focuses on the public library an institution that provides a valuable window into the reading practices of men and women of various ages classes ethnicities and religions An extensive database of library circulation and accessions information combined with federal and state census data sheds light on the elusive issue of Who read what Pawley explores the ways print confirmed or challenged people's economic social and religious world and asks what values print expressed or confronted She also raises questions relating to modes and contexts of reading distinguishing between groups and individuals The picture of print in Osage is complex and defies reduction but by placing print in a community context and viewing printed materials as an expression of activities not mere artifacts Pawley enhances our understanding of the role of reading in American culture

Medical Women and Victorian Fiction Kristine Swenson, 2005 In Medical Women and Victorian Fiction Kristine Swenson explores the cultural intersections of fiction feminism and medicine during the second half of the nineteenth century in Britain and her colonies by looking at the complex and reciprocal relationship between women and medicine in Victorian culture Her examination centers around two distinct though related figures the Nightingale nurse and the New Woman doctor The medical women in the fiction of Elizabeth Gaskell Ruth Wilkie Collins The Woman in White Dr Margaret Todd Mona McLean Medical Student Hilda Gregg Peace with Honour and others are analyzed in relation to nonfictional discussions of nurses and women doctors in medical publications nursing tracts feminist histories and newspapers Victorian anxieties over sexuality disease and moral corruption came together most persistently around the figure of a prostitute However Swenson takes as her focus for this volume an opposing figure the medical woman whom

Victorians deployed to combat these social ills As symbols of traditional female morality informed and transformed by the new social and medical sciences representations of medical women influenced public debate surrounding women s education and employment the Contagious Diseases Acts and the health of the empire At the same time the presence of these educated independent women who received payment for performing tasks traditionally assigned to domestic women or servants inevitably altered the meaning of womanhood and the positions of other women in Victorian culture Swenson challenges more conventional histories of the rise of the actual nurse and the woman doctor by treating as equally important the development of cultural representations of these figures

Twain, Alcott, and the Birth of the Adolescent Reform Novel Roberta S. Trites,2009-11 Trites argues that Twain and Alcott wrote on similar topics because they were so deeply affected by the Civil War by cataclysmic emotional and financial losses in their families by their cultural immersion in the tenets of Protestant philosophy and by sexual tensions that may have stimulated their interest in writing for adolescents Trites demonstrates how the authors participated in a cultural dynamic that marked the changing nature of adolescence in America provoking a literary sentiment that continues to inform young adult literature Both intuited that the transitory nature of adolescence makes it ripe for expression about human potential for change and reform
