in store for humans who refuse to be cowed **The Polyglots** William Gerhardie, 2013-01-29 The Anglo Russian author William Gerhardie was hailed by writers including Graham Greene Edith Wharton Evelyn Waugh and others as a genius and this his long out of print second novel is generally acclaimed as his comic masterpiece not to mention the most influential English novel of the twentieth century according to William Boyd It tells the unforgettable tale of an eccentric Belgian family living in the Far East during the turbulent years just after the First World War which displaced them and the
