counterparts to perform wedding and funeral services to conduct memorial services and to carry ritual ceremonies for the benefit of their congregations Although Zen was understood to be the meditation school of Buddhism meditation was viewed as an activity for monastics and clergy not for lay people McDaniel's book demonstrates how this tradition was transformed into a lay practice in the west He begins by examining the social and cultural factors in America which led to an initial theoretical interest in Zen during the 1940s and 50s after which he profiles the individuals who fostered that interest including D T Suzuki Alan Watts and the Beat Generation of writers Ironically during the 1960s when Zen was on the decline in Japan because the youth of that country viewed it as a remnant of the old feudal and the militaristic structures responsible for a the war that had ended so disastrously for the country youth culture in America came to look upon Zen as a way of escaping from the
