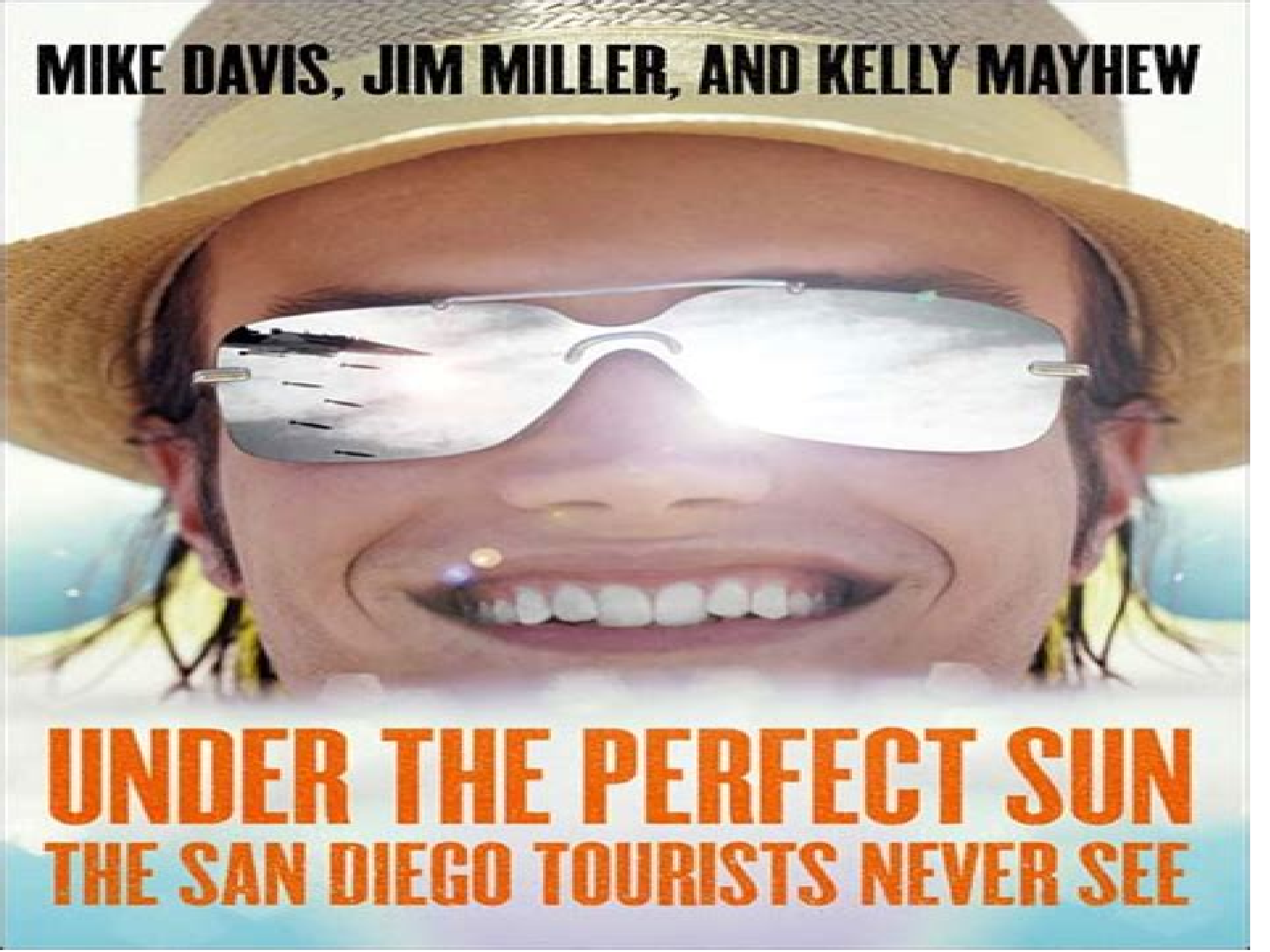

**San Diego's Hybrid Urban Borderlands** Albert Rossmeier, 2023-08-29 This study aims for a wider understanding of the redevelopment processes that emerged several decades ago in downtown San Diego and now gradually spread over the downtown edges into the inner ring Perspectively situated in the fields of urban landscape and urban border studies the research project outlines how the eastward redevelopment wave in San Diego contests socialized neighborhood boundary perceptions by transforming the former first tier suburbs from disinvested communities into urban villages and trendy places to be The study shows how the redevelopment perforates dissolves and shifts socialized linear neighborhood boundaries into areas that are simultaneously part of the one and the other neighborhood In the present work the resulting rather undefined or stretched border areas have been referred to as hybrid urban borderlands This notion is a novel conceptual approach that can be deemed a promising lens for future studies on neighborhood change urban redevelopment and socio spatial re interpretation beyond the context of San Diego

**Raza Sí, Migra No** Jimmy Patiño, 2017-10-18 As immigration from Mexico to the United States grew through the 1970s and 1980s the Border Patrol police and other state agents exerted increasing violence against ethnic Mexicans in San Diego's volatile border region In response many San Diego activists rallied around the leadership of the small scale print shop owner Herman Baca in the Chicano movement to empower Mexican Americans through Chicano self determination The combination of increasing repression and Chicano activism gradually produced a new conception of ethnic and racial community that included both established Mexican Americans and new Mexican immigrants Here Jimmy Patiño narrates the rise of this Chicano Mexicano consciousness and the dawning awareness that Mexican Americans and Mexicans would have to work together to fight border enforcement policies that subjected Latinos of all statuses to legal violence By placing the Chicano and Latino civil rights struggle on explicitly transnational terrain Patiño fundamentally reorients the

**Urban Reinventions** Lynne Horiuchi, Tanu Sankalia, 2017-09-30 When it was built in 1937 Treasure Island was considered to be one of the largest man made islands in the world Located in the middle of San Francisco Bay the 400 acre island was constructed out of dredged bay mud in a remarkable feat of Depression era civil engineering by the US Army Corps of Engineers Its alluring name is an allusion to the fabled remnants of the California Gold Rush found in the ocean sediment that formed the island This collection of essays tells the story of San Francisco's Treasure Island an artificial disconnected island that has paradoxically been central to the city's urban ambitions Conceived as a site for San Francisco's first airport in an age of automobile and air transport Treasure Island hosted the Golden Gate International Exposition GGIE in 1939 and 1940 celebrating the completion of the Golden Gate and the San Francisco Oakland Bay Bridges With particular focus on Asia and Latin America the GGIE promoted peace harmony and commerce in the Pacific Treasure Island's planned use as an airport was scuttled when World War II abruptly reversed the exposition's message of Pacific unity and the US government developed Treasure Island and the adjacent Yerba Buena Island into a naval training and transfer station which processed 4 500 000 military personnel on their way to the Pacific theater In the midst of a twenty first century high tech

boom and in one of the most expensive real estate markets in the world the city of San Francisco and its developers have proposed an ambitious model of military base reuse and green urbanism a new eco city of about 19 000 residents on Treasure Island and Yerba Buena Island The project is synonymous with a growing global trend toward large scale capital intensive land developments envisioned around ideas of sustainability and spectacular place making Seen against the successive history of development future visions for Treasure Island are part of a process of building and erasure that Horiuchi and Sankalia call urban reinventions This is a process of radical change in which artificial detached and delimited sites such as Treasure Island provide an ideal plane for tabula rasa planning driven by property capital and state control With essays by contributors well known for their interdisciplinary work *Urban Reinventions* demonstrates how a single site may be interpreted in multiple ways as an artificial island world s fair site military installation a semi derelict relic of past lives a toxic site of nuclear waste and a future eco city and major real estate development The volume offers a wide spectrum of critiques of race imperialism gendered Orientalism military land use property capital exchange new eco cities sustainability and waste as a byproduct of development The book will be of interest to general readers as well as teachers scholars and practitioners in the fields of geography architecture city planning urban design history environmental studies American studies Asian studies and military history among others

post Cold War years Checa Gismero examines the early iterations of three well known biennials at the borders of North Atlantic liberalism the Bienal de La Habana inSITE and Manifesta She draws on archival and oral history fieldwork in Cuba Mexico the US Mexico borderlands and the Netherlands showing how these biennials reflected a post Cold War optimism for a pacified world by which artistic and knowledge production would help mend social political and cultural divisions Checa Gismero argues that in reflecting this optimism biennials facilitated the conversion of subaltern aesthetic genealogies into forms that were legible to a nascent cosmopolitan global elite all under the pretense of cultural exchange By outlining how early biennials set the basis for what is now recognized as global contemporary art Checa Gismero intervenes in previous accounts of the contemporary art world in order to better understand how it became the exclusionary rarified institution of today

**Watchful Lives in the U.S.-Mexico Borderlands** Catherine Whittaker, Eveline Dürr, Jonathan Alderman, Carolin Luiprecht, 2023-04-03 Watchfulness shapes many Chicanxs and other People of Color s everyday lives in San Diego Experiencing racist discrimination can lead to becoming vigilant which frames their subjectivity Focusing particularly on Chicanxs we show how they seek to intervene against structural inequalities and threats in their lives such as by re claiming space consciousness raising participating in protests and healing practices We argue that contestations surrounding belonging create particularly watchful selves and that this is a significant aspect of borderland lifeworlds more broadly The book advances the Anthropology of borders coloniality subjectivity and race as well as contributing to Chicano and Latino Studies and Urban Studies Pushing the boundaries of conventional approaches this book is methodologically innovative by including team fieldwork digital ethnography and illustrative work by a local artist It fills a gap in Security Studies by examining peer to peer vigilance beyond top down surveillance and bottom up sousveillance and expanding previous understandings of watchfulness as an ambivalent practice that can also express care and contribute to community building as well as representing a way of life
