Handler, 1995-01-01 Once again America is getting tough on welfare Democrats and Republicans at both the national and state levels seem to have agreed that paying public funds to the poor particularly to single mothers and their children perpetuates dependency and undermines self sufficiency and the work ethic In this book Joel Handler a national expert on welfare points out the fallacies in the current proposals for welfare reform arguing that they merely recycle old remedies that have not worked He analyzes the prejudice that has historically existed against the undeserving poor and shows that the stereotype of the inner city woman of color who has children in order to stay on welfare is untrue Most welfare mothers are in the labor market says Handler however the work that is available to them is most often low wage part time employment with no benefits Efforts to move large numbers of welfare recipients to full time employment are not likely to be successful especially since most of the welfare programs for single mothers are at the state and local levels and these governments are reluctant to spend the extra money needed to institute work or other reform programs Handler suggests that national reform efforts should focus less on welfare and blaming the victim and more on increasing labor markets and reducing poverty through legislation that promotes for example the Earned Income Tax Credit and universal health care benefits Welfare reform by itself does nothing to improve the job market and unless there are more jobs paying more income we will have done nothing to lessen poverty or reduce welfare **The "deserving Poor"** Joel F. Katz, 1997-04-02 There are places where history feels irrelevant and America's inner cities are among them acknowledges Michael Katz in expressing the tensions between activism and scholarship But this major historian of urban poverty realizes that the pain in these cities has its origins in the American past To understand contemporary poverty he looks particularly at an old attitude because many nineteenth century reformers traced extreme poverty to drink laziness and other forms of bad behavior they tried to use public policy and philanthropy to improve the character of poor people rather than to attack the structural causes of their misery Showing how this misdiagnosis has afflicted today's welfare and educational systems Katz draws on his own experiences to introduce each of four topics the welfare state the underclass debate urban school reform and the strategies of survival used by the urban poor Uniquely informed by his personal involvement each chapter also illustrates the interpretive power of history by focusing on a strand of social policy in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries social welfare from the poorhouse era through the New Deal ideas about urban poverty from the undeserving poor to the underclass and

the emergence of public education through the radical school reform movement now at work in Chicago Why have American governments proved unable to redesign a welfare system that will satisfy anyone Why has public policy proved unable to eradicate poverty and prevent the deterioration of major cities What strategies have helped poor people survive the poverty endemic to urban history How did urban schools become unresponsive bureaucracies that fail to educate most of their students Are there fresh constructive ways to think about welfare poverty and public education Throughout the book Katz shows how interpretations of the past grounded in analytic history can free us of comforting myths and help us to reframe discussions of these great public issues

FROM THE PREFACE by Randy Albelda and Ann Withhorn There has always been a storm of controversy regarding welfare in America and for that matter on a global level Who should qualify under what guidelines and how and in what form should compensation be delivered This issue of *The Annals* takes a long hard and sometimes hypercritical look at the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act PRWORA and the present state of welfare in America While not raising the banner for a return to the past there is presented the postulation that the present welfare situation is inefficiently attending to people in need particularly along gender and racial lines Under an ever widening gap between the haves and have nots in the United States and the world at large many world governments are bent to define as an integral remedy a globalized economy That concept is taken at issue as seriously flawed and the authors attempt to dissect the more salient problems in that poverty and any welfare system that supports it or the lack thereof is far more complex than can be solved merely by higher gross national product The many facets of poverty and its effect on class relationships race gender families single mothers children and individual rights are explored and examined

to capture an expanding range of critical issues and provide scholarly and crucial commentary to the quality of human existence as well as the political and global necessities that demand a second opinion as to whether we as a country and the world at large are doing the right thing for people in crisis

Stretched Thin Sandra Morgen, Joan Acker, Jill Weigt, 2013-09-30 When the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act became law in 1996 the architects of welfare reform celebrated what they called the new consensus on welfare that cash assistance should be temporary and contingent on recipients seeking and finding employment However assessments about the assumptions and consequences of this radical change to the nation's social safety net were actually far more varied and disputed than the label consensus suggests By examining the varied realities and accountings of welfare restructuring *Stretched Thin* looks back at a critical moment of policy change and suggests how welfare policy in the United States can be changed to better address the needs of poor families and the nation Using ethnographic observations in depth interviews with poor families and welfare workers survey data tracking more than 750 families over two years and documentary evidence Sandra Morgen Joan Acker and Jill Weigt question the validity of claims that welfare reform has been a success They show how poor families welfare workers and welfare administrators experienced and assessed welfare reform differently based on gender race class and their varying positions of power and control within the welfare state The authors document the ways that despite the dramatic drop in welfare rolls low wage jobs and inadequate social supports left many families struggling in poverty Revealing how the neoliberal principles of a drastically downsized welfare state and individual responsibility for economic survival were implemented through policies and practices of welfare provision and nonprovision the authors conclude with new recommendations for reforming welfare policy to reduce poverty promote economic security and foster shared prosperity

Faces of Poverty Jill Duerr Berrick, 1997-03-27 Most Americans are insulated from the poor it's hard to imagine the challenges of poverty the daily fears of crime and victimization the frustration of not being able to provide for a child Instead we are often exposed to the rhetoric and hyperbole about the excesses of the American welfare system These messages color our perception of the welfare problem in the United States and they close the American mind to a full understanding of the complexity of family poverty But who are these poor families What do we know about how they arrived in such desperate straits Is poverty their fate for a lifetime or for only a brief period In *Faces of Poverty* Jill Duerr Berrick answers these questions as she dispels the misconceptions and myths about welfare and the welfare population that have clouded the true picture of poverty in America Over the course of a year Berrick spent numerous hours as a participant observer with five women and their families documenting their daily activities thoughts and fears as they managed the strains of poverty We meet Ana Sandy Rebecca Darlene and Cora all of whom at some point have turned to welfare for support Each represents a

wider segment of the welfare population ranging from Ana who lost a business injured her back and temporarily lost her job all in a short period of time to Cora who was raised in poverty spent ten years in an abusive relationship and now struggles to raise six children in a drug infested neighborhood And as Berrick documents these women s experiences she also debunks many of the myths about welfare she reveals that welfare is not generous welfare families remain below the poverty line even with government assistance that the majority of women on welfare are not long term welfare dependents that welfare does not run in families that welfare mothers do not keep having children to increase their payments women on welfare have on average two children and that almost half of all women on welfare turned to it after a divorce At a time when welfare has become a hotly debated political issue Faces of Poverty gives us the facts The debate surrounding welfare will continue as each of the 50 states struggles to reform their welfare programs and this debate will turn on the public s perception of the welfare population Berrick offers insight into each of the reforms under consideration and starkly demonstrates their implications for poor women and children She provides a window into these women s lives brilliantly portraying their hopes and fears and their struggle to live with dignity

The Battle for Welfare Rights Felicia Ann Kornbluh, 2007 The Battle for Welfare Rights chronicles an American war on poverty fought first and foremost by poor people themselves It tells the fascinating story of the National Welfare Rights Organization the largest membership organization of low income people in U S history It sets that story in the context of its turbulent times the 1960s and early 1970s and shows how closely tied that story was to changes in mainstream politics both nationally and locally in New York City Welfare was one of the most hotly contested issues in postwar America Bolstered by the accomplishments of the civil rights movement NWRO members succeeded in focusing national attention on the needs of welfare recipients especially single mothers At its height the NWRO had over 20 000 members most of whom were African American women and Latinas organized into more than 500 local chapters These women transformed the agenda of the civil rights movement and forged new coalitions with middleclass and white allies To press their case for reform they used tactics that ranged from demonstrations sit ins and other forms of civil disobedience to legislative lobbying and lawsuits against government officials Historian Felicia Kornbluh illuminates the ideas of poor women and men as well as their actions One of the primary goals of the NWRO was a guaranteed income for every adult American In part because of

their advocacy this idea had a surprising range of supporters from conservative economist Milton Friedman to liberal presidential candidate George McGovern However by the middle 1970s as Kornbluh shows Republicans and conservative Democrats had turned the proposal and its proponents into laughingstocks The Battle for Welfare Rights offers new insight into women s activism poverty policy civil rights urban politics law consumerism social work and the rise of modern conservatism It tells for the first time the complete story of a movement that profoundly affected the meaning of citizenship and the social contract in the United States
