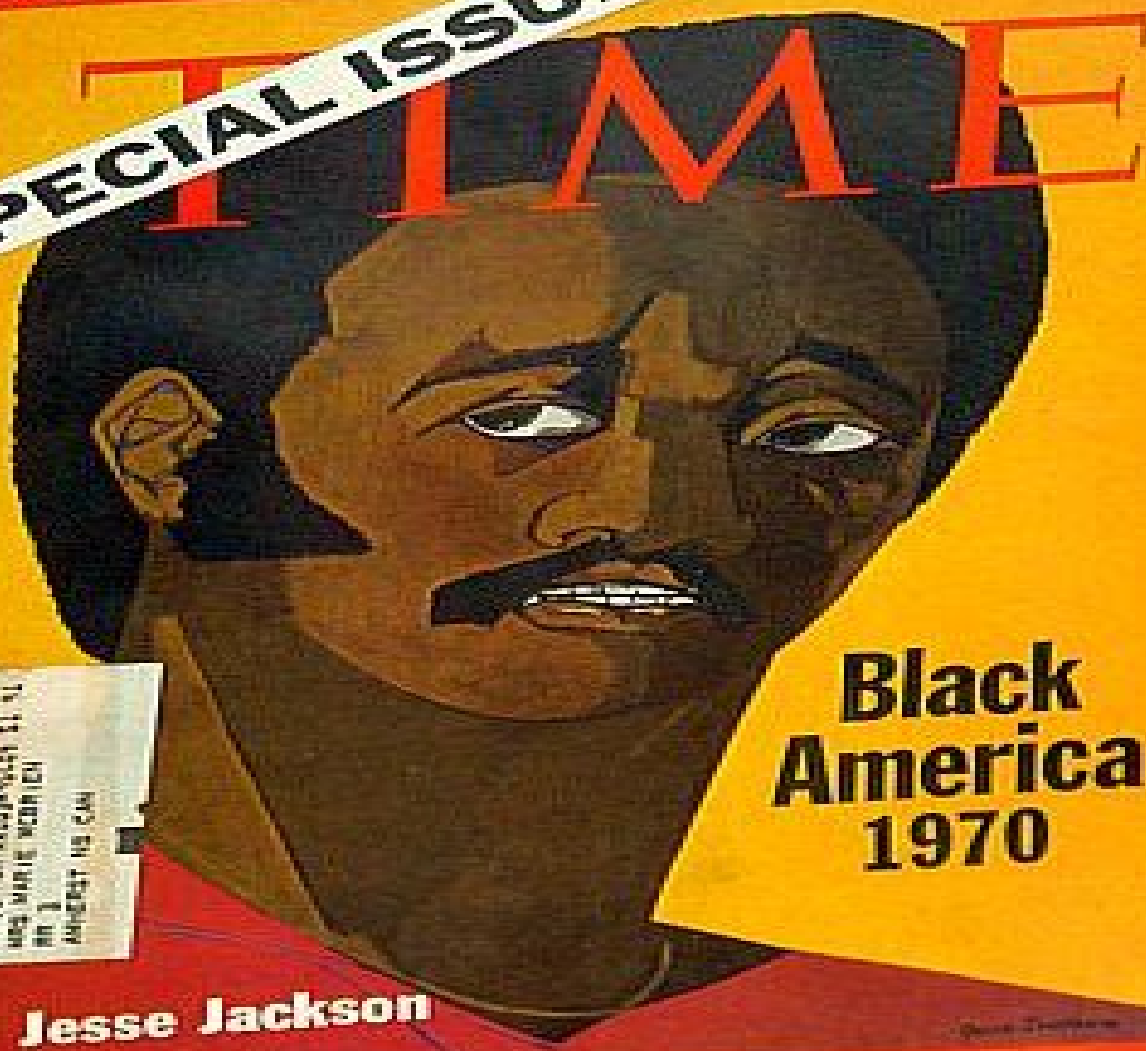

**1971** Darby English, 2016-12-20 In this book art historian Darby English explores the year 1971 when two exhibitions opened that brought modernist painting and sculpture into the burning heart of United States cultural politics Contemporary Black Artists in America at the Whitney Museum of American Art and The DeLuxe Show a racially integrated abstract art exhibition presented in a renovated movie theater in a Houston ghetto 1971 A Year in the Life of Color looks at many black artists desire to gain freedom from overt racial representation as well as their efforts and those of their advocates to further that aim through public exhibition Amid calls to define a black aesthetic these experiments with modernist art prioritized cultural interaction and instability Contemporary Black Artists in America highlighted abstraction as a stance against normative approaches while The DeLuxe Show positioned abstraction in a center of urban blight The importance of these experiments English argues came partly from color's special status as a cultural symbol and partly from investigations of color already under way in late modern art and criticism With their supporters black modernists among them Peter Bradley Frederick Eversley Alvin Loving Raymond Saunders and Alma Thomas rose above the demand to represent or be represented compromising nothing in their appeals for interracial collaboration and above all responding with optimism rather than cynicism to the surrounding culture's preoccupation with color

*The Seventies* Bruce J. For a quarter century filmmakers, musicians, and historians have returned to the era to explore the legacy of Watergate, stagflation, and Saturday Night Fever, uncovering the unique confluence of political and economic phenomena that make the period such a baffling time. Literary historians have never shown much interest in the era, however, a remarkable omission considering writers as diverse as Toni Morrison, Thomas Pynchon, Marilyn French, Adrienne Rich, Gay Talese, Norman Mailer, Alice Walker, and Octavia E. Butler were active. While the achievements of such individuals as Barack Obama, Toni Morrison, and Thurgood Marshall are well known, many accomplished African Americans have been largely forgotten or deliberately erased from the historical record in America. to be played out on televisions in living rooms throughout the country Whether it was the boom of environmentalism or the bust of the Nixon administration and public life as we knew it the era represented a profound shift in American society and culture     *Broadside Authors and Artists* Leanead Pack Bailey,1974     *After Cooling* Eric Dean Wilson,2022-07-19 This ambitious and delightful The New York Times work of literary nonfiction interweaves the science and history of the powerful refrigerant and dangerous greenhouse gas Freon with a haunting meditation on how to live meaningfully and morally in a rapidly heating world In *After Cooling* Eric Dean Wilson braids together air conditioning history climate science road trips and philosophy to tell the story of the birth life and afterlife of Freon the refrigerant that ripped a hole larger than the continental United States in the ozone layer As he traces the refrigerant s life span from its invention in the 1920s when it was hailed as a miracle of scientific progress to efforts in the 1980s to ban the chemical and the resulting political backlash Wilson finds himself on a journey through the American heartland trailing a man who buys up old tanks of Freon stockpiled in attics and basements to destroy what remains of the chemical before it can do further harm Wilson is at heart an essayist looking far and wide to tease out what particular forces in American culture in capitalism in systemic racism in our values combined to lead us into the Freon crisis and then out Meticulously researched and engagingly written Amitav Ghosh this knockout debut New York Journal of Books offers a rare glimpse of environmental hope suggesting that maybe the vast and terrifying problem of global warming is not beyond our grasp to face

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
