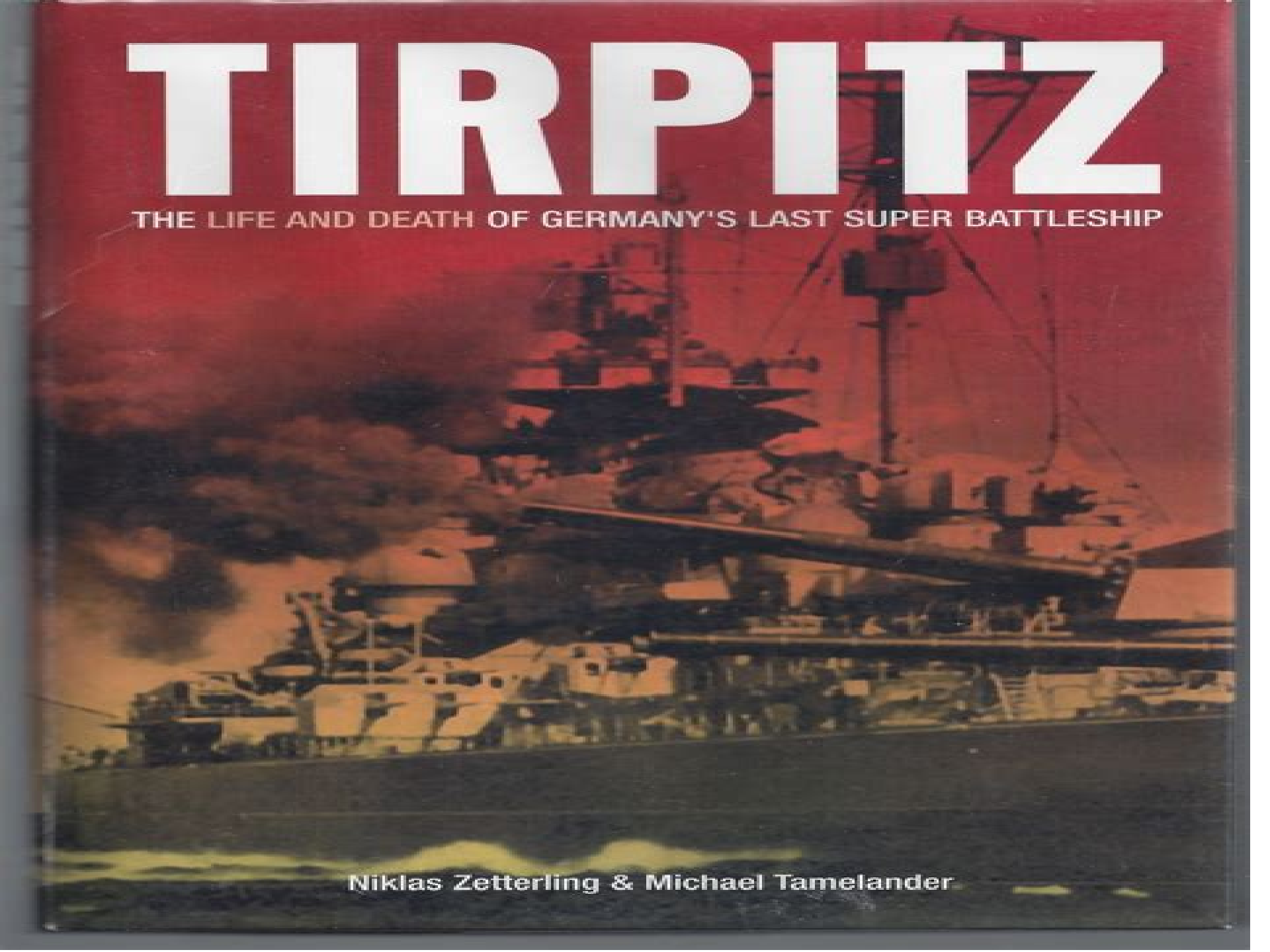

Tirpitz The Life And Death Of Germanys Last Super Battleship:

Tirpitz Niklas Zetterling,2009-12-01 The Germans for their part had learned not to pit their super battleships against the strength of the entire Home Fleet outside the range of protecting aircraft Thus they kept Tirpitz hidden within fjords along the Norwegian coast like a Damocles Sword hanging over the Allies maritime jugular forcing the British to assume the offensive This strategy paid dividends in July 1942 when the Tirpitz merely stirred from its berth compelling the Royal Navy to abandon a Murmansk bound convoy called PQ 17 in order to confront the leviathan The convoy was then ripped apart by the Luftwaffe and U boats while the Tirpitz returned to its fjord In 1943 the British launched a flotilla of midget submarines against the Tirpitz losing all six of the subs while only lightly damaging the battleship Aircraft attacked repeatedly from carriers and both British and Soviet bases suffering losses including an escort carrier while proving unable to completely knock out the mighty warship Trying an indirect approach the British launched one of the war s most daring commando raids at St Nazaire in order to knock out the last drydock in Europe capable of servicing the Tirpitz Of over 600 commandos and sailors in the raid more than half were lost during an all night battle that succeeded at least in knocking out the drydock It was not until November 1944 that the Tirpitz finally succumbed to British aircraft armed with 10 000 lb Tallboy bombs the ship capsizing at last with the loss of 1 000 sailors

Following the First World War the major naval powers entered into an agreement restricting the construction of capital ships and limiting the numbers that signatories were allowed to maintain so numerous ships were scrapped or disposed of and the majority of planned vessel were either cancelled whilst being built or never laid down By the late 1920s the Royal Navy s battle force comprised of the two Nelson class ships the battlecruisers Hood Renown and Repulse and Revenge and Queen Elizabeth class ships all designed before the First World War In 1928 the Royal Navy began planning a new class of battleships which was put on hold with the signing of the Treaty of London In 1935 realising its battle fleet was becoming dated as other nations laid down new classes of battleships the Royal Navy recommenced planning capital ships within treaty limitations The result was the King George V class battleships Regarded by some as the worst new generation battleships in the Second World War the King George V class were Britain s most modern battleships during the conflict and saw action in some of the most famous engagements from the sinking of the Bismarck in 1941 to the surrender of Japan in 1945 This book charts the story of the King George V class from its conception and design through to the operational history of the ships in the class **Why Germany Nearly Won** Steven D. hang on against the world's most powerful nations working in concert to engineer its defeat **Tirpitz** Daniel Knowles, 2018-04-17 The Ghost Ships of Archangel William Geroux, 2022-05-03 An extraordinary story of survival and alliance during World War II the icy journey of four Allied ships crossing the Arctic to deliver much needed supplies to the Soviet war effort On the fourth of July 1942 four Allied ships traversing the Arctic split from their decimated convoy to head further north into the ice field of the North Pole They were seeking safety from Nazi bombers and U boats in the perilous white maze of ice floes growlers and giant bergs Despite the many risks of their chosen route the four vessels had a better chance of reaching their destination than the rest of the remains of convoy PQ 17 The convoy had started as a fleet of thirty five cargo ships carrying 1 billion worth of war supplies to the Soviet port of Archangel the only help Roosevelt and Churchill had extended to Joseph Stalin to maintain their fragile alliance against Germany At the most dangerous point of the voyage the ships had received a startling order to scatter and had quickly become easy prey for the Nazis The crews of the four ships focused on their mission U S Navy Ensign Howard Carraway aboard the SS Troubadour was a farm boy from South Carolina and one of the many Americans for whom the convoy was a first taste of war from the Royal Navy Reserve Lt Leo Gradwell was given command of the HMT Ayrshire a British fishing trawler that had been converted into an antisubmarine vessel The twenty four hour Arctic daylight in midsummer gave them no respite from bombers or submarines and they all feared the giant German battleship Tirpitz nicknamed the Big Bad Wolf Icebergs were as dangerous as Nazis as the remnants of convoy PQ 17 tried to slip through the Arctic to deliver their cargo in one of the most dramatic escapes of World War II At Archangel they found a traumatized starving city and a disturbing preview of the Cold War ahead From The Battle of Britain to Bombing Hitler's Berchtesgaden James Bazin, 2023-06-30 It was Tuesday 17 October 1939 Britain had been at war with Germany for more than a month and for only the second time the Luftwaffe had dared to enter British airspace and at last James Jim Bazin's chance had come After joining the RAF in 1935 Jim was an experienced pilot when war broke out and he was eager to test his skills against the enemy This first combat was the start of a career which saw Wing Commander Bazin as he was to become being posted to France with 607 County of Durham Squadron He fought there until the last days of the Battle of France In the course of the campaign Bazin had battled his way to becoming an ace He was also shot down behind enemy lines but successfully evaded capture to return to his squadron and resume the fight There was no respite for Bazin as he was once again in the air defending Britain's skies in his trusty Hurricane as the Luftwaffe sort to destroy Fighter Command in the summer of 1940 With ten kills to his name Jim Bazin was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross in October that year But merely driving off the Luftwaffe was not enough for him He was posted to Inverness where he served as a Controller in 14 Group's Operations Room which gave him a taste for offensive operations In time Bazin volunteered to move to Bomber Command He duly undertook a conversion course in 1943 eventually joining 49 Squadron as a Lancaster pilot to take the war to the very heart of the enemy After commanding 49 Squadron including taking part in Bomber Command's

support of the D Day landings Bazin was promoted to Wing Commander leading 9 Squadron on many attacks on special targets such as U boat pens viaducts refineries and most notably operating with the famous Dambusters against Hitler's great battleship Tirpitz Unrelenting in his efforts against the enemy Jim Bazin was involved in operations against targets in Poland and Germany right up until the end of the war This culminated in the last major RAF operation of the Second World War when on 25 April 1945 Bomber Command attacked the Berghof Hitler's Alpine retreat and other targets in Berchtesgaden Jim Bazin was awarded the DSO in September 1945 rightful recognition for a man who had done so much to bring about the defeat of the enemy

Sink the Tirpitz 1942-44 Angus Konstam, 2018-10-18 When Germany invaded the Soviet Union in

the summer of 1941 Stalin requested help from the Western Allies The result was the Arctic Convoys the opening of a sea route from Britain to Northern Russia used to supply the Soviets with vitally needed war materials This route passed close to German occupied Norway and so in January 1942 the newly completed battleship Tirpitz sister of the Bismarck was sent there to form the core of the naval force stationed in Northern Norway to intercept these convoys For more than two years Tirpitz remained a latent threat to the Allies and despite fuel shortages her occasional sorties posed a grave threat to Allied shipping So the sinking of the battleship became a major priority for the British The fjords where she lurked were strongly defended rendering naval attack virtually impossible So unless she could be caught at sea she had to be destroyed by other means In the spring of 1942 the Royal Air Force launched three heavy bombing raids on the battleship's anchorage but no hits were scored The following autumn she was damaged during a midget submarine attack and moved to a more secure anchorage A lack of bombers caused a hiatus in these air attacks but they were resumed in 1944 by which time the Fleet Air Arm had the resources to join in the air campaign The most sustained of these naval air operations was Operation Goodwood but like the others its results were disappointing It was now clear that only heavy bombers dropping especially heavy bombs could do the job So that autumn the RAF launched the first of three large scale attacks using Lancaster bombers armed with enormous Tallboy bombs In the first codenamed Operation Parvane the Tirpitz was badly damaged In the third air attack carried out in November 1944 the battleship was hit three times and she capsized and sank taking most of her crew down with her Her passing broke German naval power in Arctic waters which in turn allowed the Allies to divert their naval resources to the Pacific where the ocean wide campaign was reaching its climax The air campaign against the Tirpitz was one of vital strategic importance and while low key compared to air operations over mainland Europe it was one where a single bomb could dramatically influence the course of the war These British airmen faced tough opposition from the weather terrain ground defences the Luftwaffe and from the well armed battleship herself which while rendering it tough for them make this a dramatic story of air power's triumph against the odds Technically the 1944 air campaign was a test bed for a new generation of super bomb The Tallboy designed by Barnes Wallis of Dambuster fame was a five ton seismic bomb capable of destroying the battleship when other more conventional ordnance had failed These ground breaking bombs were the forerunners of the devastating bunker busting weaponry of the post war era
