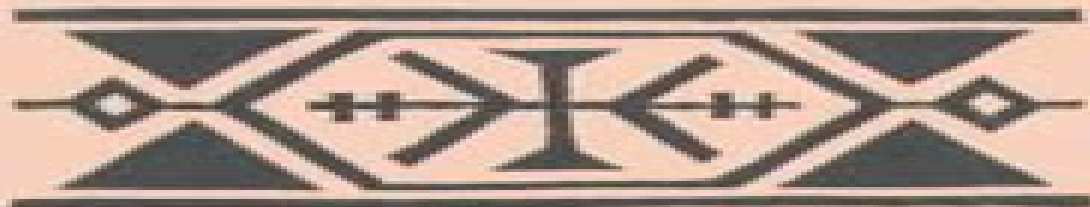

transformation of societies after the slave trade and slavery in a comparative intercontinental perspective It combines micro and macro historical approaches and looks at the agency of slaves missionaries abolitionists state officials seamen and soldiers

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
