El presente libro coordinado por Santiago Reyna profesor de la Universidad Politécnica de Valencia constituye gracias a la colaboración de numerosos investigadores y técnicos españoles y extranjeros especializados en temas trufícolas una amplia revisión de los conocimientos actuales en el conjunto de materias relacionadas con la truficultura. En total han colaborado 26 autores de 7 países pertenecientes a 15 universidades centros de investigación o empresas diferentes. La primera edición ya agotada fue galardonada en la XXXVI edición del premio al mejor libro agrario de la Fira Agrícola de Lleida. Único premio que se otorga para este tipo de publicaciones en España. La Truficultura es un cultivo que no resulta familiar para la mayor parte de los agricultores. En definitiva se trata de cultivar un hongo asociado a las raíces de un árbol y por lo tanto se produce una interrelación árbol-hongo-clima-suelo que se sale del ámbito de los cultivos habituales. Por ello es básico conocer su proceso para llevar a buen puerto un proyecto trufero. En el libro se exponen los fundamentos técnicos y científicos con amplitud procurando también un lenguaje que sin perder rigor sea comprensible. Se describen todas las técnicas para la realización de una plantación: elección de terreno, especies, preparación etc. así como técnicas posteriores de cultivo. La viverística y las técnicas forestales son capítulos con especial importancia. Se ha incluido la historia de ocho plantaciones españolas contada por sus propios dueños. La truficultura en Francia e Italia tienen sendos capítulos ya que son los países con más tradición que en la truficultura. También se ha incluido una visión en otros países como Hungría y zonas más lejanas donde la trufa es introducida en ambientes muy diferentes como Chile, Nueva Zelanda o Estados Unidos de América. No existe una sola truficultura por ello a través de toda esta información el emprendedor trufero deberá escoger las técnicas que más se acomoden a las condiciones ecológicas de su plantación. La trufa además de sus bien conocidos valores gastronómicos y económicos posee un valor ecológico indiscutible. A su vez los estadounidenses desarrollaron el conocimiento para la ejecución de quemas prescritas en los bosques para alcanzar determinadas metas selvícolas en la segunda mitad del siglo XX después del replanteamiento de la estrategia de exclusión total del fuego en sus extensos territorios. Por otra parte el efecto del fuego sobre la naturaleza se consideró negativo desde muchos enfoques en el pasado medio siglo y aún se considera así en la visión urbana popular.
