No Straight Path Elizabeth Jacoway, 2019-09-04 No Straight Path tells the stories of ten successful female historians who came of age in an era when it was unusual for women to pursue careers in academia especially in the field of history These first person accounts illuminate the experiences women of the post World War II generation encountered when they chose to enter this male dominated professional world None of the contributors took a straight path into the profession most first opted instead for the more conventional pursuits of college public school teaching marriage and motherhood Despite these commonalities their stories are individually unique one rose from poverty in Arkansas to attend graduate school at Rutgers before earning the chairmanship of the history department at the University of Memphis another pursued an archaeology degree studied social work and served as a college administrator before becoming a history professor at Tulane University a third was a lobbyist who attended seminary then taught high school entered the history graduate program at Indiana University and helped

develop two honors colleges before entering academia and yet another grew up in segregated Memphis and then worked in public schools in New Jersey before earning a graduate degree in history at the University of Memphis where she now teaches. The experiences of the other historians featured in this collection are equally varied and distinctive. Several themes emerge in their collective stories. Most assumed they would become teachers, nurses, secretaries, or society ladies, the only respectable choices available to women at the time. The obligations of marriage and family they believed would far outweigh their careers outside the home. Upon making the unusual decision at the time to move beyond high school teaching and attend graduate school, few grasped the extent to which men dominated the field of history or that they would be perceived by many as little more than objects of sexual desire. The work-home balance proved problematic for them throughout their careers as they struggled to combine the needs and demands of their families with the expectations of the profession. These women had no road maps to follow. The giants who preceded them—Gerda Lerner, Anne Firor Scott, Linda K. Kerber, Joan Wallach Scott, A. Elizabeth Taylor, and others—had breached the gates but only with great drive and determination. Few of the contributors to *No Straight Path* expected to undertake such heroics or to rise to that level of accomplishment. They may have had modest expectations when entering the field, but with the help of female scholars past and present, they kept climbing and reached a level of success within the profession that holds great promise for the women who follow.

Marcia Chatelain, 2015-04-19. In *South Side Girls*, Marcia Chatelain recasts Chicago's Great Migration through the lens of black girls. Focusing on the years between 1910 and 1940, when Chicago's black population quintupled, Chatelain describes how Chicago's black social scientists, urban reformers, journalists, and activists formulated a vulnerable image of urban black girlhood that needed protecting. She argues that the construction and meaning of black girlhood shifted in response to major economic, social, and cultural changes and crises, and that it reflected parents' and community leaders' anxieties about urbanization and its meaning for racial progress. Girls shouldered much of the burden of black aspiration as adults often scrutinized their choices and behavior, and their well-being symbolized the community's moral health. Yet these adults were not alone in thinking about the Great Migration as girls expressed their views as well. Referencing girls' letters and interviews, Chatelain uses their powerful stories of hope, anticipation, and disappointment to highlight their feelings and thoughts, and in so doing, she helps restore the experiences of an understudied population to the Great Migration's complex narrative.

Black Boys Burning Grif Stockley, 2017-07-28 On the morning of March 5 1959 Luvenia Long was listening to gospel music when a news bulletin interrupted her radio program Fire had engulfed the Arkansas Negro Boys Industrial School in Wrightsville thirteen miles outside of Little Rock Her son Lindsey had been confined there since January 14 after a judge for juveniles found him guilty of stealing from a neighborhood store owner To her horror Lindsey was not among the forty eight boys who had clawed their way through the windows of the dormitory to safety Instead he was among the twenty one boys between the ages of thirteen and seventeen who burned to death *Black Boys Burning* presents a focused explanation of how systemic poverty perpetuated by white supremacy sealed the fate of those students A careful telling of the history of the school and fire the book provides readers a fresh understanding of the broad implications of white supremacy Grif Stockley s research adds to an evolving understanding of the Jim Crow South Arkansas s history the lawyers who capitalized on this tragedy and the African American victims In hindsight the disaster at Wrightsville could have been predicted Immediately after the fire an unsigned editorial in the Arkansas Democrat noted long term deterioration including the wiring of the buildings After the Central High School desegregation crisis in 1957 the boys deaths eighteen months later were once again an embarrassment to Arkansas The fire and its circumstances should have provoked southerners to investigate the realities of their separate but equal institutions However white supremacy ruled the investigations and the grand jury declared the event to be an anomaly

Mothers of Massive Resistance Elizabeth Gillespie McRae, 2018-01-02 Why do white supremacist politics in America remain so powerful Elizabeth Gillespie McRae argues that the answer lies with white women Examining racial segregation from 1920s to the 1970s Mothers of Massive Resistance explores the grassroots workers who maintained the system of racial segregation and Jim Crow For decades in rural communities in university towns and in New South cities white women performed myriad duties that upheld white over black censoring textbooks denying marriage certificates deciding on the racial identity of their neighbors celebrating school choice canvassing communities for votes and lobbying elected officials They instilled beliefs in racial hierarchies in their children built national networks and experimented with a color blind political discourse Without these mundane everyday acts white supremacist politics could not have shaped local regional and national politics the way it did or lasted as long as it has With white women at the center of the story the rise of postwar conservatism looks very different than the male dominated narratives of the resistance to Civil Rights Women like Nell Battle Lewis Florence Sillers Ogden Mary Dawson Cain and Cornelia Dabney Tucker publicized threats to their Jim Crow world through political organizing private correspondence and journalism Their efforts began before World War II and the Brown decision and persisted past the 1964 Civil Rights Act and anti busing protests White women s segregationist politics stretched across the nation overlapping with and shaping the rise of the New Right Mothers of Massive Resistance reveals the diverse ways white women sustained white supremacist politics and thought well beyond the federal legislation that overturned legal segregation

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
