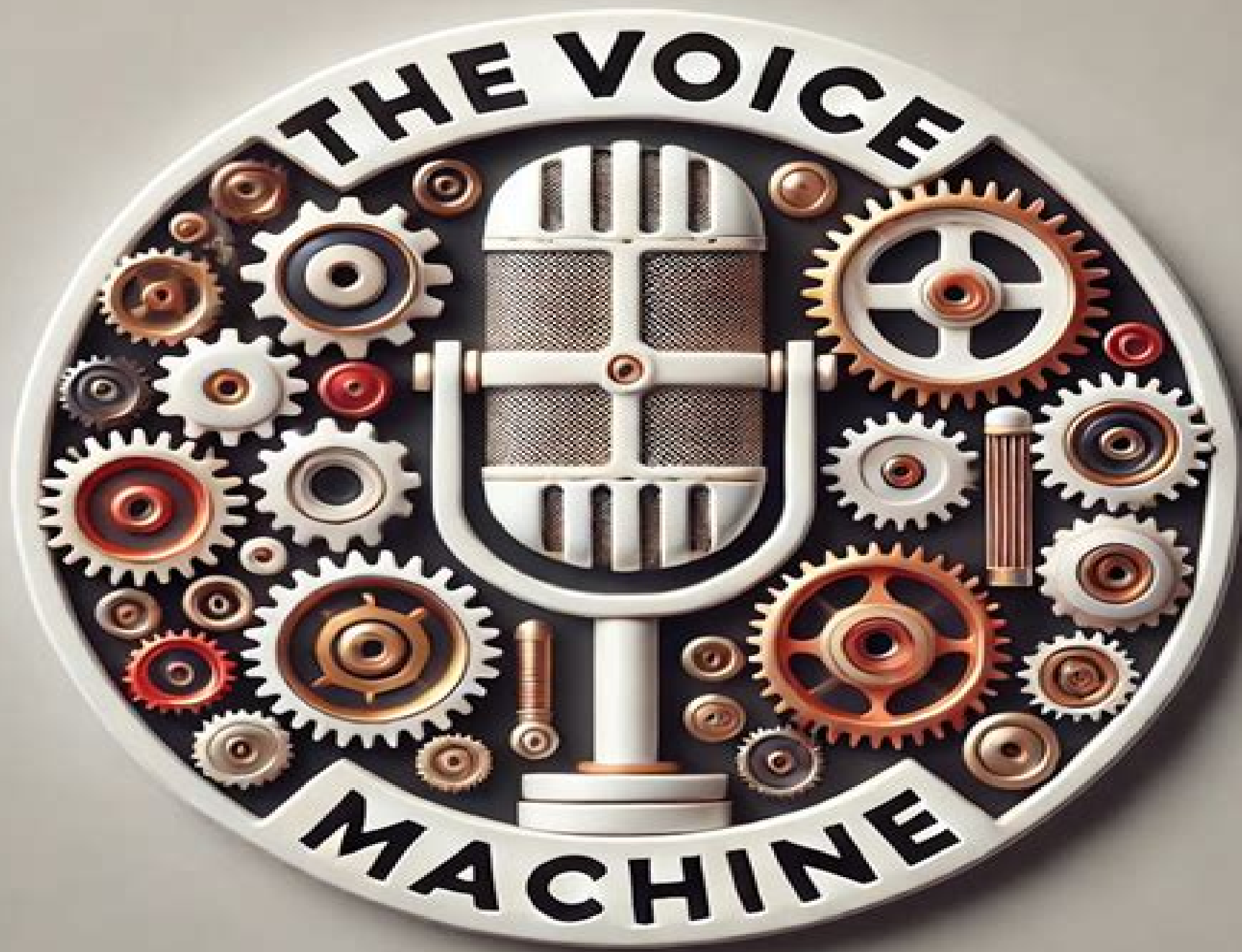

The Voice in the Machine Roberto Pieraccini, 2012-03-23 An examination of more than sixty years of successes and failures in developing technologies that allow computers to understand human spoken language Stanley Kubrick's 1968 film 2001 A Space Odyssey famously featured HAL a computer with the ability to hold lengthy conversations with his fellow space travelers More than forty years later we have advanced computer technology that Kubrick never imagined but we do not have computers that talk and understand speech as HAL did Is it a failure of our technology that we have not gotten much further than an automated voice that tells us to say or press 1 Or is there something fundamental in human language and speech that we do not yet understand deeply enough to be able to replicate in a computer In *The Voice in the Machine* Roberto Pieraccini examines six decades of work in science and technology to develop computers that can interact with humans using speech and the industry that has arisen around the quest for these technologies He shows that although the computers today that understand speech may not have HAL's capacity for conversation they have capabilities that make them usable in many applications today and are on a fast track of improvement and innovation Pieraccini describes the evolution of speech recognition and speech understanding processes from waveform methods to artificial intelligence approaches to statistical learning and modeling of human speech based on a rigorous mathematical model specifically Hidden Markov Models HMM He details the development of dialog systems the ability to produce speech and the process of bringing talking machines to the market Finally he asks a question that only the future can answer will we end up with HAL like computers or something completely unexpected

Postopera: Reinventing the Voice-Body Jelena Novak, 2016-03-09 Both in opera studies and in most operatic works the singing body is often taken for granted In Postopera Reinventing the Voice Body Jelena Novak reintroduces an awareness of the physicality of the singing body to opera studies Arguing that the voice body relationship itself is a producer of meaning she furthermore posits this relationship as one of the major driving forces in recent opera She takes as her focus six contemporary operas La Belle et la Bête Philip Glass Writing to Vermeer Louis Andriessen Peter Greenaway Three Tales Steve Reich Beryl Korot One Michel van der Aa Homeland Laurie Anderson and La Commedia Louis Andriessen Hal Hartley which she terms postoperas These pieces are sites for creative exploration where the boundaries of the opera world are stretched Central to this is the impact of new media a de synchronization between image and sound or a redefinition of body voice gender relationships Novak dissects the singing body as a set of rules protocols effects and strategies That dissection shows how the singing body acts within the world of opera what interventions it makes and how it constitutes opera's meanings Animal Narratology Joela Jacobs, 2020-12-15 Animal Narratology interrogates what it means to narrate to speak speak for on behalf of and to voice or represent life beyond the human which is in itself as different as insects bears and dogs are from each other and yet more as individual as a single mouse horse or puma The varied contributions to this interdisciplinary Special Issue highlight assumptions about the human perception of attitude toward and responsibility for the animals that are read and written about thus demonstrating that just as the animal does not exist neither does the human In their zoopoetic focus the analyses are aware that animal narratology ultimately always contains an approximation of an animal perspective in human terms and terminology yet they make clear that what matters is how the animal is approximated and that there is an effort to approach and encounter the non human in the first place Many of the analyses come to the conclusion that literary animals give readers the opportunity to expand their own points of view both on themselves and others by adopting another's perspective to the degree that such an endeavor is possible Ultimately the contributions call for a recognition of the many spaces moments and modes in which human lives are entangled with those of animals one of which
