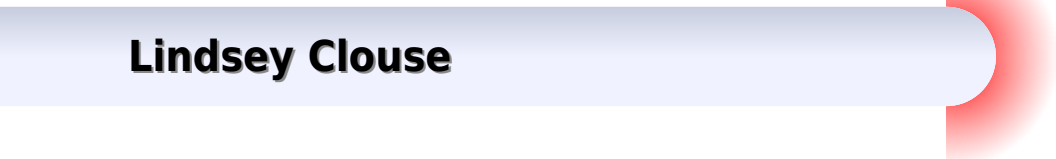

Uptalk Paul Warren, 2016-01-07 In this first comprehensive analysis of uptalk Paul Warren examines the phenomenon's historical origins, geographical spread, and social influences.

Stigmatized on Screen Lindsey Clouse, 2022-06-27 This book reveals how marginalized communities and women are underrepresented on our screens and too often depicted in stereotypical ways. This is doubly true for marginalized speakers: those who speak traditionally nonstandard dialects. Lindsey Clouse examines the origins of linguistic prejudice and how our public schools perpetuate the myth of bad English. By dissecting the 500 top-grossing films of the last 20 years, Clouse exposes how speakers of Black English, Southern U.S. English, Spanish-influenced English, and gendered speech patterns are represented, underrepresented, misrepresented, and mocked. Clouse analyzes hundreds of films and characters to reveal how filmmakers and audiences work together to reinforce negative beliefs about stigmatized dialects and the people who speak them, and reveals how those beliefs stack up against decades of linguistic research. She concludes by showing that these portrayals translate to real-life linguistic discrimination and discusses the ways in which we can combat this often-hidden prejudice. Scholars of introductory sociolinguistics, American dialect studies, and media studies will find this book of particular interest.

Prosodic Theory and Practice Jonathan Barnes, Stefanie Shattuck-Hufnagel, 2022-02-08 An introduction to the range of current theoretical approaches to the prosody of spoken utterances with practical applications of those theories. Prosody is an extremely dynamic field with a rapid pace of theoretical development and a steady expansion of its influence beyond linguistics into such areas as cognitive psychology, neuroscience, computer science, speech technology, and even the medical profession. This book provides a set of concise and accessible introductions to each major theoretical approach to prosody, describing its structure and implementation and its central goals and assumptions, as well as its strengths and weaknesses. Most surveys of basic questions in prosody are written from the perspective of a single theoretical framework. This volume offers the only summary of the full range of current theoretical approaches with practical applications of each theory and critical commentary on selected chapters. Helen of Troy in Hollywood Ruby Blondell, 2023-08 This book explores the representation of Helen of Troy in Hollywood film and television with a particular focus on her defining features transcendent beauty and transgressive erotic agency The first chapter on early Hollywood sets the scene by explaining the importance of ideas about Greek beauty at the beginning of cinema and highlighting some of the problems that continue to bedevil this topic especially realism and the representation of supreme beauty Blondell argues that the problem of Helen is baked into Hollywood from the start In subsequent chapters Blondell examines specific screen adaptations in which Helen is featured Each of these case studies locates a particular work in its historical cultural and generic context as a framework for addressing the ways in which it approaches a range of interlocking questions about beauty its representation and the cinematic uses of myth The second chapter is devoted to the sole Hellenic feature film of the silent period Alexander Korda's *Private Life of Helen of Troy* 1927 Part II moves to the big screen epic pairing one film from each of the two great waves of ancient world epic spanning the latter half of the 20th century Robert Wise's 1956 epic *Helen of Troy* and Wolfgang Petersen's more recent extravaganza *Troy* 2004 In Part III she turns to television with a chapter on episodic telefantasy followed by a study of the 2003 miniseries *Helen of Troy* In some of these works Helen is the central character or hero in others she is at the periphery of a masculine adventure But in all of them she represents the threat of superhuman beauty as an inheritance from classical Greece

Adverbs Across Domains Amanda Payne, 2023-09-07 This text identifies grammatical constraints on adverbs in multiple areas of language from morpho-syntax to prosody to semantics A novel syntactic adverb hierarchy is proposed to explain the distribution of multi-adverb constructions one which has just five distinct classes The status of adverb as a unique lexical category is also investigated Readers will learn that unlike adjectives adverb ordering restrictions are not predictable based on a single conceptual factor like subjectivity This book also connects the ordering preferences of adverbs to the meaning and usage of each class of adverbs as well speaker variation relating to adverb form and pronunciation Although the book focuses primarily on data from the English language its findings are predicted to hold cross-linguistically and would be useful to any linguistic researcher studying adverb distribution

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
