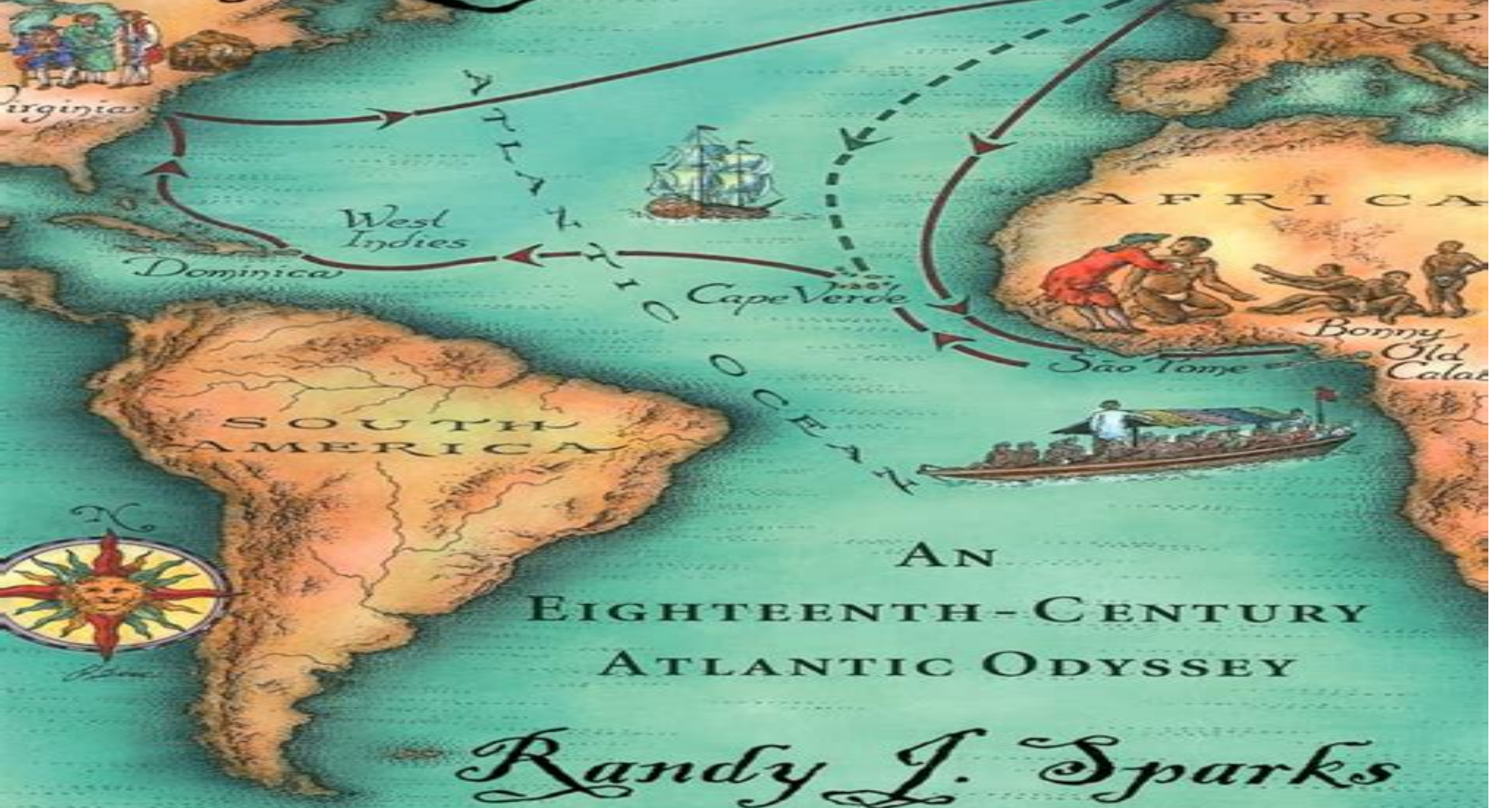

Sparks, 2009-02-28 In 1767 two princes of a ruling family in Old Calabar on the slave coast of Africa were captured by English slavers The princes were themselves slavers betrayed by African competitors and so began their own odyssey of enslavement Their story written in their own hand survives as a rare firsthand account of the Atlantic slave experience

The Diary of Antera Duke, an Eighteenth-Century African Slave Trader Stephen D. Behrendt, A.J.H. Latham, David Northrup, 2010-03-08 In his diary Antera Duke ca 1735 ca 1809 wrote the only surviving eyewitness account of the slave trade by an African merchant A leader in late eighteenth century Old Calabar a cluster of Efik speaking communities in the Cross River region he resided in Duke Town forty five miles from the Atlantic Ocean in what is now southeast Nigeria His diary written in trade English from 1785 to 1788 is a candid account of daily life in an African community at the height of Calabar's overseas commerce It provides valuable information on Old Calabar's economic activity both with other African businessmen and with European ship captains who arrived to trade for slaves produce and provisions This new edition of Antera's diary the first in fifty years draws on the latest scholarship to place the diary in its historical context Introductory essays set the stage for the Old Calabar of Antera Duke's lifetime explore the range of trades from slaves to produce in which he rose to prominence and follow Antera on trading missions across an extensive commercial hinterland The essays trace the settlement and development of the towns that comprised Old Calabar and survey the community's social and political structure rivalries among families sacrifices of slaves and witchcraft ordeals This edition reproduces Antera's original trade English diary with a translation into standard English on facing pages along with extensive annotation The Diary of Antera Duke furnishes a uniquely valuable source for the history of precolonial Nigeria and the Atlantic slave trade and this new edition enriches our understanding of it

The Two Princes of Mpfumo Lindsay O'Neill, 2025-02-13 A fascinating account of two eighteenth century princes from East Africa their travels and their encounters with the British Empire and slavery In 1716 two princes from Mpfumo what is today Maputo the capital of Mozambique boarded a ship licensed by the East India Company bound for England Instead their perfidious captain sold them into slavery in Jamaica After two years of pleading their case the princes known in the historical record as Prince James and Prince John convinced a lawyer to purchase them free them and travel with them to London The lawyer perished when a hurricane wrecked their ship but the princes survived and arrived in England in 1720 Even though the East India Company had initially thought that the princes might assist in their aspirations to develop a trade for gold in East Africa and for enslaved labor in Madagascar its interest waned The princes would need to look elsewhere to return home It was at this point that members of the Royal African Company and the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge took up their cause in the hope that profit and perhaps Christian souls would follow John would make it home but tragically James would end his own life just before the ship sailed for Africa In *The Two Princes of Mpfumo* Lindsay O'Neill brings to life individuals caught

up in the eighteenth century slave trade O'Neill also shows how the prince's experiences reflect the fragmented chaotic and often deadly realities of the early British empire A fascinating and deeply researched historical narrative *The Two Princes of Mpumfu* blurs the boundaries between the Atlantic and Indian ocean worlds reveals the intertwined networks powerful individuals and unstable knowledge that guided British attempts at imperial expansion and illuminates the power of African politics which decided who lived and who died on their coasts

Littlefield, Joan Marie Johnson, 2009-05-01 Volume Two The biographical essays in this volume provide new insights into the various ways that South Carolina women asserted themselves in their state and illuminate the tension between tradition and change that defined the South from the Civil War through the Progressive Era As old rules including gender conventions that severely constrained southern women were dramatically bent if not broken these women carved out new roles for themselves and others The volume begins with a profile of Laura Towne and Ellen Murray who founded the Penn School on St Helena Island for former slaves Subsequent essays look at such women as the five Rollin sisters members of a prominent black family who became passionate advocates for women's rights during Reconstruction writer Josephine Pinckney who helped preserve African American spirituals and explored conflicts between the New and Old South in her essays and novels and Dr Matilda Evans the first African American woman licensed to practice medicine in the state Intractable racial attitudes often caused women to follow separate but parallel paths as with Louisa B Poppenheim and Marion B Wilkinson Poppenheim who was white and Wilkinson who was black were both driving forces in the women's club movement Both saw clubs as a way not only to help women and children but also to showcase these positive changes to the wider nation Yet the two women worked separately as did the white and black state federations of women's clubs Often mixing deference with daring these women helped shape their society through such avenues as education religion politics community organizing history the arts science and medicine Women in the mid and late twentieth century would build on their accomplishments
