Icons and Saints of the Eastern Orthodox Church Alfredo Tradigo, 2006 An icon from the Greek word eikon image is a wooden panel painting of a holy person or scene from Orthodox Christianity the religion of the Byzantine Empire that is practiced today mainly in Greece and Russia It was believed that these works acted as intermediaries between worshipers and the holy personages they depicted Their pictorial language is stylized and primarily symbolic rather than literal and narrative Indeed every attitude pose and color depicted in an icon has a precise meaning and their painters usually monks followed prescribed models from iconographic manuals The goal of this book is to catalogue the vast heritage of images according to iconographic type and subject from the most ancient at the Monastery of Saint Catherine in the Sinai to those from Greece Constantinople and Russia Chapters focus on the role of icons in the Orthodox liturgy and on common iconic subjects including the fathers and saints of the Eastern Church and the life of Jesus and his followers As with other volumes in the Guide to Imagery series this book includes a wealth of color illustrations in which details are called out for discussion

The Composer Embalmed Abigail Fine, 2025-06-05 The first granular study of nineteenth century composer devotion a network of devotees who preserved tangible traces of composers through relics rituals pilgrimage exhumation and embalming During the nineteenth century music institutions promoted artworks they deemed timeless and made composers into figureheads of a lasting Western canon Alongside this institutional face of the canon was a more intimate impulse to preserve touch and embrace the residues of the dead In Germany and Austria between 1870 and 1930 music lovers venerated the bodies houses and belongings of composers as relics shrines and talismans In *The Composer Embalmed* Abigail Fine documents the vernacular and eccentric ways that composers have been remembered Fine navigates a wealth of unknown archival material to recover the stories of devotees from pilgrims who felt time stop in historic houses to music loving doctors who made skulls into sacred specimens dilettantes who displayed Beethoven's mask as a relic of the beautiful death and interwar critics of those dilettantes who disparaged piety as a false religion a kitsch replica In isolation these

practices may look like simple acts of affection But in the aggregate Fine asserts acts of devotion constituted what we might broadly understand as relic culture a culture that sought to possess the body of the departed genius and that superimposed habits of anthropological collecting onto artifacts of Austro German heritage By excavating objects ephemera amateur lyric visitors books letters and travelogues *The Composer Embalmed* reveals the underbelly of the canon where guilty pleasures blur the boundary between sanctity and desecration

The Icon and the Square Maria Taroutina, 2018-11-26 In *The Icon and the Square* Maria Taroutina examines how the traditional interests of institutions such as the crown the church and the Imperial Academy of Arts temporarily aligned with the radical leftist and revolutionary avant garde at the turn of the twentieth century through a shared interest in the Byzantine past offering a counternarrative to prevailing notions of Russian modernism Focusing on the works of four different artists Mikhail Vrubel Vasily Kandinsky Kazimir Malevich and Vladimir Tatlin Taroutina shows how engagement with medieval pictorial traditions drove each artist to transform his own practice pushing beyond the established boundaries of his respective artistic and intellectual milieu She also contextualizes and complements her study of the work of these artists with an examination of the activities of a number of important cultural associations and institutions over the course of several decades As a result *The Icon and the Square* gives a more complete picture of Russian modernism one that attends to the dialogue between generations of artists curators collectors critics and theorists *The Icon and the Square* retrieves a neglected but vital history that was deliberately suppressed by the atheist Soviet regime and subsequently ignored in favor of the secular formalism of mainstream modernist criticism Taroutina's timely study which coincides with the centennial reassessments of Russian and Soviet modernism is sure to invigorate conversation among scholars of art history modernism and Russian culture

[Resurrection in the New Testament](#) Jan Lambrecht, 2002 Resurrection in the New Testament is a Festschrift offered to J Lambrecht on the occasion of his seventy fifth birthday Among the many scholarly interests of Professor Lambrecht the theme of the resurrection seemed best suited to honour his academic achievement The 27 contributions cover many of the books of the New Testament The first two articles in this

volume discuss influences on the New Testament treatment of resurrection from the Greco Roman Dieter Zeller and Jewish Daniel J Harrington backgrounds H J de Jonge considers visionary experiences of the Old Testament as an interpretive clue for understanding New Testament references to appearances The articles by Martin Rese Benoit Standaert Otfried Hofius and Gergely Juhasz deal with interpretive questions that range through several books of the New Testament and to varying degrees again bring into discussion previously debated issues From this point with the exception of the final two the articles appear in canonical order Adelbert Denaux and Wim J C Weren treat issues in Matthew John Gillman in Luke Acts Maarten J J Menken and Thomas Soding in John John J Kilgallen and Florence Morgan Gillman in Acts Veronica Koperski Margaret E Thrall and Johan S Vos in the Pauline letters in general Morna D Hooker and Eduard Lohse in Romans Joel Delobel and Peter J Tomson in 1 Corinthians Frank J Matera in 2 Corinthians John Reumann in Philippians Raymond F Collins in the Pastoral Epistles and Jacques Schlosser in 1 Peter Joseph Verheyden discusses the witness of Mary Magdalene and the Women at the tomb in the extra canonical Gospel of Peter Finally Barbara Baert contributes a discussion on how the Resurrection was portrayed in visual art during the Middle Ages with striking illustrative examples

Nonfictional Romantic Prose Steven P.
