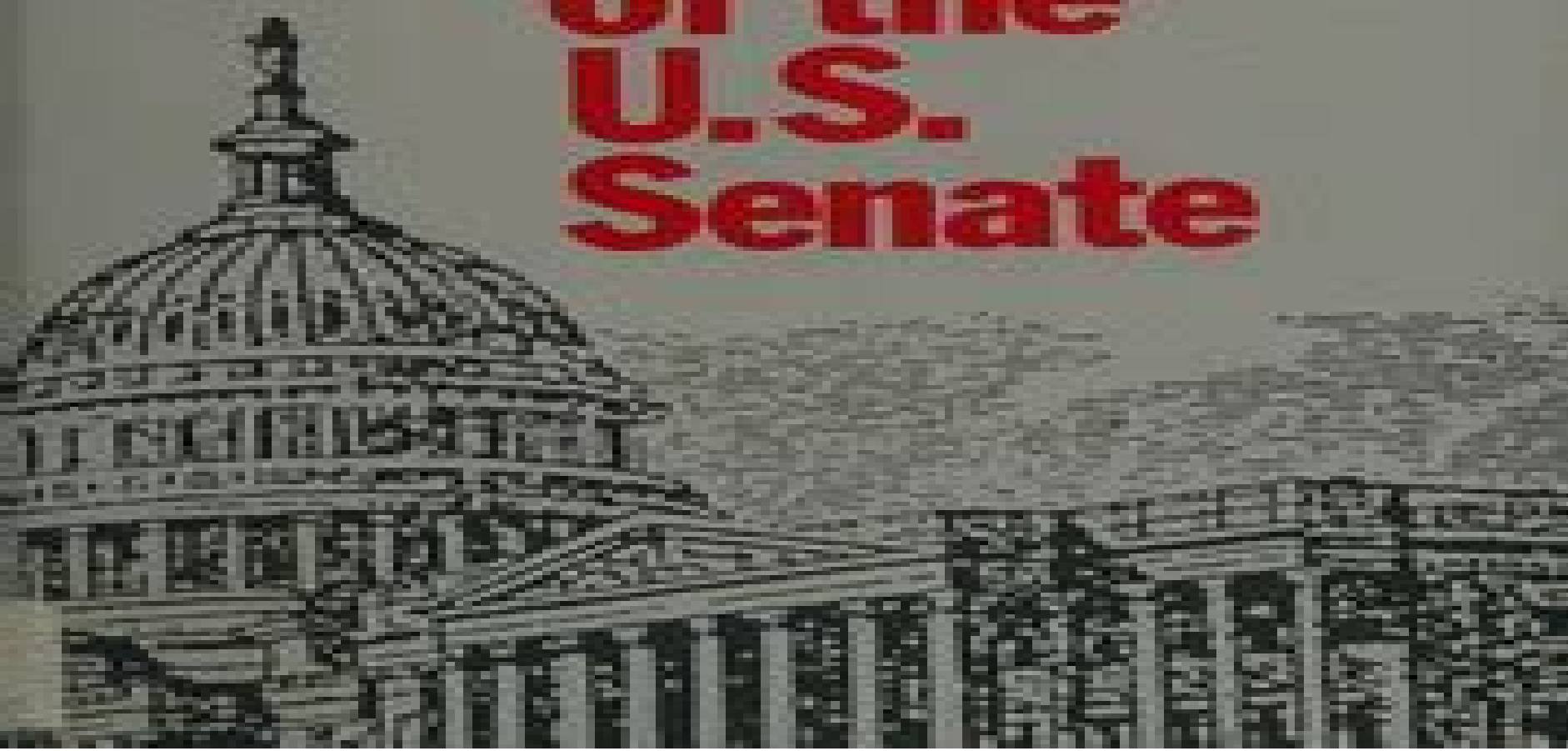

New coverage includes analysis of the tug of war between House Democrats and the George W Bush administration on Iraq war withdrawal; timetables; updates on criminal investigations of House members including William J Jefferson of Louisiana and Charles Rangel of New York; and analysis of the Tea Party Movement and new Republican majority. Powers of Congress including powers to tax, spend and borrow to conduct foreign policy and investigations to confirm and impeach to regulate commerce to amend the Constitution and to select the president. Updated material includes analysis of the George W Bush administration's use of immunity from questioning by congressional committees; analysis of the signing of the new START treaty with Russia marking a cornerstone of U S relations with the country; coverage of the War on Terror including the killing of bin Laden in a U S raid in Pakistan and perspective on the negotiations to raise the federal debt ceiling in 2011. Congressional Procedures detailing the party and leadership structures, rules and the legislative process, the committee system, assignment and procedures and congressional staff. Revised coverage profiles the methods, styles and legislative successes and defeats of House Speakers Pelosi and Boehner and Senate majority leader Reid. Unlikely Environmentalists Paul Charles Milazzo, 2016-02-08 Environmental activism has most often been credited to grassroots protesters but much early progress in environmental protection originated in the halls of Congress As Paul Milazzo shows a coterie of unlikely environmentalists placed water quality issues on the national agenda as early as the 1950s and continued to shape governmental policy through the early 1970s both outpacing public concern and predating the environmental movement Milazzo examines a two decade crusade to clean up the nation s water supply led by development boosters pork barrel politicians and the Army Corps of Engineers all of whom framed threats to the water supply as an economic rather than environmental problem and saw pollution as an inhibitor of regional growth Showing how the legislative branch acted more assertively than the executive the book weaves the history of the federal water pollution control program into a broader narrative of political and institutional development covering all major clean water legislation as well as many other landmark environmental laws Milazzo explains how the evolution of Congress s internal structure after World War II with its standing committees and powerful chairmen ultimately shaped the scope and substance of important legislative policies He reveals how Representative John Blatnik of Minnesota chairman of the House Subcommittee on Rivers and Harbors shepherded the first permanent water pollution control legislation through Congress in 1956 how Senator Robert Kerr of Oklahoma embraced pollution control to deflect criticism of the public works budget and how Senator Edmund Muskie of Maine used an unwanted pollution subcommittee chairmanship to create a more viable federal water quality program at a time when few Americans demanded one By showing that a much more diverse set of people and interests shaped environmental politics than has generally been supposed Milazzo deepens our understanding of how

Congress took the lead in addressing environmental concerns like water quality that ultimately contributed to the expansion of government. His book demonstrates that the rise of the environmental regulatory state ranks as one of the most far reaching transformations in American government in the modern era.

Clayton, 1999 For decades political scientists studying the Court have adopted behavioral approaches and focused on the relatively narrow question of how the justices' policy preferences influence their voting behavior. This emphasis has illuminated important aspects of Supreme Court politics but it has also left unaddressed many other important questions about this unique and fascinating institution. Drawing on the new institutionalism in the social sciences, the distinguished contributors to this volume attempt to fill this gap by exploring a variety of topics including the Court's institutional development and its relationship to broader political contexts such as party regimes, electoral systems, social movements, social change, legal precedents, political identities, and historically evolving economic structures. Seeking Justices Michael Comiskey, 2004 In the long shadows cast by the Robert Bork and Clarence Thomas nominations, Supreme Court confirmations remain highly contentious and controversial. This is due in part to the Senate's increasing reliance upon a much lengthier, much more public and occasionally raucous confirmation process in an effort to curb the potential excesses of executive power created by presidents seeking greater control over the Court's ideological composition. Michael Comiskey offers the most comprehensive, systematic, and optimistic analysis of that process to date. Arguing that the process works well and therefore should not be significantly altered, Comiskey convincingly counters those critics who view highly contentious confirmation proceedings as the norm. Senators have every right and a real obligation, he contends, to scrutinize the nominees' constitutional philosophies. He further argues that the media coverage of the Senate's deliberations has worked to improve

the level of such scrutiny and that recent presidents have neither exerted excessive influence on the appointment process nor created a politically extreme Court He also examines the ongoing concern over presidential efforts to pack the court concluding that stacking the ideological deck is unlikely As an exception to the rule Comiskey analyzes in depth the Thomas confirmation to explain why it was an aberration offering the most detailed account yet of Thomas s pre judicial professional and political activities He argues that the Senate Judiciary Committee abdicated its responsibilities out of deference to Thomas s race Another of the book s unique features is Comiskey s reassessment of the reputations of twentieth century Supreme Court justices Based on a survey of nearly 300 scholars in constitutional law and politics it shows that the modern confirmation process continues to fill Court vacancies with jurists as capable as those of earlier eras We have now seen the longest period without a turnover on the Court since the early nineteenth century making inevitable the appointment of several new justices following the 2004 presidential election Thus the timing of the publication of *Seeking Justices* could not be more propitious

Responsible Partisanship? John Clifford Green, Paul S.
