**Mayors and the Challenge of Urban Leadership** Richard Michael Flanagan, 2004 Big city mayors rank among the most powerful and colorful politicians in America Yet few books focus on the leadership challenges the occupants of the office face Mayors and the Challenge of Urban Leadership examines twelve case studies of mayoral leadership in seven cities from the New Deal era to the beginning of the 21st century The prospects for mayoral success or failure are driven by how mayors manage the fit between political commitments and the broader patterns of political competition City Hall powerhouses like Richard J Daley of Chicago 1954 76 David Lawrence of Pittsburgh 1946 58 Tom Bradley of Los Angeles 1973 83 and Robert F Wagner of New York 1954 65 came to power in times of political crisis They realigned politics in their cities to reinvigorate municipal government and bolster their power In contrast mayors with less redoubtable reputations like Mayors Sam Yorty of Los Angeles 1961 73 Dennis Kucinich of Cleveland 1977 79 Jane Byrne of Chicago 1979 83 and Frank Rizzo of Philadelphia 1972 1980 were outsiders who lost their battles to challenge powerful political coalitions in their cities The new breed mayors of the 1990s among them Rudy Giuliani of New York Dennis Archer of Detroit and Ed Rendell of Philadelphia used modern campaign and governing techniques and scored surprising policy and political victories as a result Mayors and the Challenge of Urban Leadership concludes with a discussion of Mayor Michael Bloomberg of New York elected in the aftermath of the 9 11 attacks as an exemplar of the modern style of governing big cities in the 21st century

Johnson, 2008 A collection of thirteen essays considered classics in the field of urban politics from leading scholar Clarence Stone with new essays by the editors and by Stone himself that contextualize the impact of his previous works and suggest new directions for researchers      **The Ungovernable City** Douglas Yates, 1978 We confront an urban wilderness more formidable and resistant and in some ways more frightening than the wilderness faced by the pilgrims or the pioneers What Robert Kennedy warned in 1966 is ten years later more starkly true than ever As controversies about American cities rage this critique takes a hard unflattering look at the urban plight Those who expect facile answers utopian visions or panaceas should however be cautioned the book offers none What it does offer is an interior view of urban policy making and an example of the most astute kind of policy study Professor Yates argues that the urban policy making system is no longer capable of producing coherent decisions developing effective policies or implementing programs lack of money is not the underlying cause The real culprit has to do with contradictions fundamental to cities as political and social entities Historically cities evolved as melting pots developing haphazardly into loose structures composed of numerous antagonistic interests and forces Urban management has largely consisted of hasty responses to crisis situations rather than long range planning City governments are at once too decentralized for overall policy making and too centralized to be truly responsive to its citizenry By the same token they are both too independent of and too dependent on higher level government state federal for assistance The basic function and distinctive feature of urban government is its service delivery But here the system breaks down for the mayor does not entirely control the administrators and administrators cannot control the street level employees policemen firemen public school teachers Fragmentation instability these are the result The remedies are not simple and obvious as Yates repeatedly makes clear But if penetrating to the core of the problem is at all beneficial The Ungovernable City is a step in the right direction      **The City Builders** Susan S. Fainstein, 2001 This revised edition examines major redevelopment efforts in New York and London to uncover the forces behind these investment cycles and the role that public policy can play in moderating market instability It chronicles the progress of three development projects in New York and three in London      **Regime Politics** Clarence Nathan Stone, 1989 From the end of Georgia's white primary in 1946 to the present Atlanta has been a community of growing black electoral strength and stable white economic power Yet the ballot box and investment money never became opposing weapons in a battle for domination Instead Atlanta experienced the emergence and evolution of a biracial coalition Although beset by changing conditions and significant cost pressures this coalition has remained intact At critical junctures forces of cooperation overcame antagonisms of race and ideology While retaining a critical distance from rational choice theory author Clarence Stone finds the problem of collective action to be centrally important The urban condition in America is one of weak and diffuse authority and this situation favors any group that can act cohesively and control a substantial body of resources Those endowed with a capacity

to promote cooperation can attract allies and overcome oppositional forces On the negative side of the political ledger Atlanta's style of civic cooperation is achieved at a cost Despite an ambitious program of physical redevelopment the city is second only to Newark New Jersey in the poverty rate Social problems conflict of interest issues and inattention to the production potential of a large lower class bespeak a regime unable to address a wide range of human needs No simple matter of elite domination it is a matter of governing arrangements built out of selective incentives and inside deal making such arrangements can serve only limited purposes The capacity of urban regimes to bring about elaborate forms of physical redevelopment should not blind us to their incapacity to address deeply rooted social problems Stone takes the historical approach seriously The flow of events enables us to see how some groups deploy their resource advantages to fashion governing arrangements to their liking But no one enjoys a completely free hand some arrangements are more workable than others Stone's theory minded analysis of key events enables us to ask why and what else might be done Regime Politics offers readers a political history of postwar Atlanta and an elegant innovative and incisive conceptual framework destined to influence the way urban politics is studied

Wast, 1989 Offering an important new way of analyzing urban public policy a theoretical life cycle of the policy making process in American cities this book explains many crucial aspects of urban policy formulation how issues emerge and get on the agendas of local governments how policy makers translate issues into policy how the age of cities affects the content and process of policy making and how pluralist coalitions form and participate in city politics Wast's ecology model highlights the strengths and weaknesses of current methods of dealing with problems such as crime inadequate public schools aging infrastructures pollution poverty and toxic waste disposal The book offers a major service to urban and policy scholars by combining theories and concerns that are generally relegated either to public policy or studies of urban politics providing both theoretical and case study linkage between the two areas An important and original contribution this book will be of great interest to all who study urban affairs or policy making and to officials involved in public administration

*The Politics of Urban Development* Clarence Nathan Stone, Heywood T. Sanders, 1987 In the past twenty years the study of urban politics has shifted from a predominant concern with political culture and ethos to a preoccupation with political economy particularly that of urban development

Urban scholars have come to recognize that cities are shaped by forces beyond their boundaries From that focus have emerged the views that cities are clearly engaged in economic competition that market processes are shaped by national policy decisions sometimes intentionally and sometimes inadvertently and that the costs and benefits of economic growth are unevenly distributed But what else needs to be said about the policies and politics of urban development To supplement prevailing theories The Politics of Urban Development argues that the role of local actors in making development decisions merits closer study Whatever the structural constraints politics still matters Collectively the essays provide ample evidence that local government officials and other community actors do not simply follow the imperatives that derive from the national political economy they are able to assert a significant degree of influence over the shared destiny of an urban population The impact of the collection is to heighten awareness of local political practices and of how and why they make a difference
