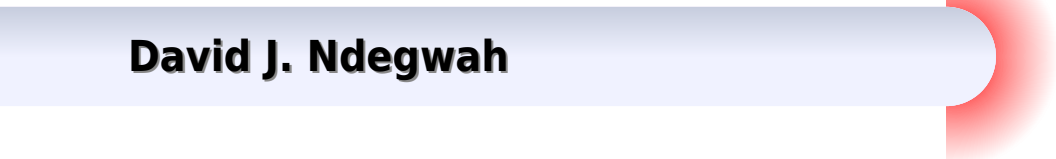

McGuire, 2024-07-23 Why do contemporary Christians seem to routinely talk past one another amid contentious theological debates In this illuminating study Sean M W McGuire argues that interpreters lack of self critical reflection on the process of interpretation and compounding cultural factors are problematizing interpretive practice Thus to work through difficult topics Christians need to develop the ability to reflect on the complexity informing how they interpret Scripture and how they see others interpreting Scripture so that they can coherently and constructively discuss their interpretations with others Grounding the study in the discipline of practical theology McGuire utilizes the cultural theory of metamodernism and the hermeneutics of Hans Georg Gadamer 1900 2002 together with a proposed revision of the Wesleyan Quadrilateral to develop a paradigm for observing and describing differences in biblical interpretive practice Using current debates regarding sexuality as an illustrative example the project reveals the complexity underlying contemporary interpretive practice showing that amid this complexity the prioritization or lack thereof of theological reflection sources prompts certain interpretive conclusions Perceiving the multivalent nature of interpretation readers will be equipped to think

carefully and critically about how they come to their biblical interpretive conclusions and how those conclusions inform transformed living in Christ
