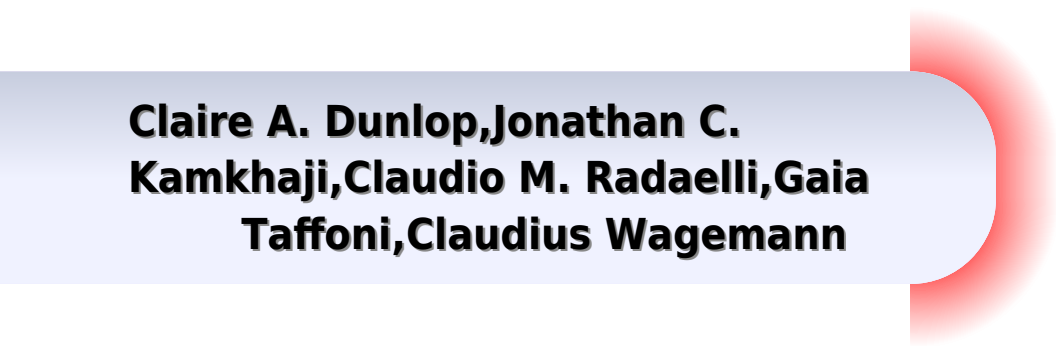

Gupta, Michael Mason, 2014-07-18 A critical assessment of whether transparency is a broadly transformative force in global environmental governance or plays a more limited role Transparency openness secured through greater availability of information is increasingly seen as part of the solution to a complex array of economic political and ethical problems in an interconnected world The transparency turn in global environmental governance in particular is seen in a range of international agreements voluntary disclosure initiatives and public private partnerships This is the first book to investigate whether transparency in global environmental governance is in fact a broadly transformative force or plays a more limited instrumental role After three conceptual context setting chapters the book examines ten specific and diverse instances of governance by disclosure These include state led mandatory disclosure initiatives that rely on such tools as prior informed consent and monitoring measuring reporting and verification and private or private public largely voluntary efforts that include such corporate transparency initiatives as the Carbon Disclosure Project and such certification schemes as the Forest Stewardship Council The cases which focus on issue areas including climate change biodiversity biotechnology natural resource exploitation and chemicals demonstrate that although transparency is ubiquitous its effects are limited and often specific to particular contexts The book explores in what circumstances transparency can offer the possibility of a new emancipatory politics in global environmental governance **The Ecology Politic** Anthony Burke, Stefanie

Fishel, 2025-05-06 A compelling proposal for new international law and institutions to address the planetary crisis that improves biodiversity protection supports Indigenous peoples and prevents catastrophic climate change In **The Ecology Politic** Anthony Burke and Stefanie Fishel contend that the roots of our planetary crisis lie in the modern state in its destructive entanglement with capitalism and its colonial legacies of extraction and oppression This in turn has shaped global governance and international law as they continue to fail to curb global heating deforestation and extinction In a far reaching critique of the foundational political theory of the modern state the Body Politic the authors insist that nothing less than a radically different model of the polity an Ecology Politic is needed if we are to escape this impasse Burke and Fishel argue that the international rule of law enacts a sovereign ban of nature that appropriates nonhuman lives for profit and use while denying them political and legal standing We fail because we rely on the very institutions worldviews and systems that

generated the crisis to solve it The authors reconsider political power agency scale and democracy in the Anthropocene and assert a biospheric ethic that values the entangled planetary structure of matter energy and life Further they argue for more than human beings to be represented in an ecological democracy that flows across borders In short they imagine a polity whose fundamental purpose is to protect planetary ecosystems and nurture interlocking systems of social and ecological justice *Democratic Norms of Earth System Governance* Walter F. Governing Complex Systems Oran R. Young, 2017-03-10 An exploration of the need for innovative mechanisms of governance in an era when human actions are major drivers of environmental change The onset of the Anthropocene an era in which human actions have become major drivers of change on a planetary scale has increased the complexity of socioecological systems Complex systems pose novel challenges for governance because of their high levels of connectivity nonlinear dynamics directional patterns of change and emergent properties Meeting these challenges will require the development of new intellectual capital In this book Oran Young argues that to achieve sustainable outcomes in a world of complex systems we will need governance systems that are simultaneously durable enough to be effective in guiding behavior and agile enough to adapt to rapidly changing circumstances While some insights from past research on governance remain valid in this setting Young argues that we need new social capital to supplement mainstream regulatory approaches that feature rule making with an emphasis on compliance and enforcement He explores the uses of goal setting as a governance strategy the idea of principled governance and the role of what is often called good governance in meeting the challenges of the Anthropocene Drawing on his long experience operating on the science policy frontier Young calls for more effective collaboration between analysts and practitioners in creating and implementing governance systems capable of producing sustainable outcomes in a world of complex systems **Global Shifts** Philip Schleifer, 2023-06-20 What global shifts in markets and power mean for the politics and governance of sustainability In recent years major shifts in global markets from North to South have created a new geography of trade and consumption particularly in the agricultural sector How this shift affects the governance of sustainability and thus the future of the planet is the pressing topic Philip Schleifer takes up in this book The processes of twenty first century globalization are fundamentally changing the politics and governance of commodity production Schleifer argues with profound implications for the environment in the food producing countries of the Global South At the center of Schleifer s study are Brazil and Indonesia two key sites of experimentation in new models of global environmental and commodity governance where palm oil and soy supply chains have seen unprecedented degrees of private environmental governance in recent years However instead of transforming these industries the diffusion of transnational sustainability standards has accompanied a worsening ecological crisis with mounting evidence of increasingly strong links between deforestation and globalization in twenty first century agricultural

trade To uncover the causes of this governance failure Schleifer develops a multi level framework for analyzing how contemporary globalization is reconfiguring the political economies of such industries The result is the first comprehensive analysis of the shift of global agricultural trade to the South and the deepening crisis of commodity driven deforestation and a complex and evolving picture of both the risks and opportunities for sustainability presented by this transformative shift

Learning in Governance Katharina Rietig, 2021-08-24 An investigation of the role of learning and its impact on policy change as exemplified in European Union climate policy integration Although learning is often considered an important factor in effective environmental governance it is not clear to what extent learning affects decision making and policy outcomes In this book Katharina Rietig examines the role of learning understood as additional knowledge or experience that is taken into account by policymakers in earth system governance and policy change She does this by examining learning in European Union climate policy integration looking in detail at the examples of the Renewable Energy Directive its controversial biofuels component and the greening measures in the Common Agricultural Policy To examine how learning occurs in the policy process how to differentiate aspects of learning and under what conditions learning matters for policy outcomes Rietig introduces the Learning in Governance Framework applying it to analyze the EU examples She finds that policy outcomes are affected through leadership of policy entrepreneurs who use previously acquired knowledge and past experience to achieve outcomes aligned with their deeper beliefs and policy objectives She concludes that learning does matter in governance as an intervening variable and can affect policy outcomes

in combination with dedicated leadership by policy entrepreneurs who act as learning brokers Bargaining dominates the policymaking process among actors who represent the interests of different organizations Rietig s theoretical framework empirical studies and nuanced analysis offer a new perspective on the relevance of learning in earth system governance
