clinical populations complementing the data presented on healthy subjects. Importantly, this book includes chapters from authors using many different approaches to the analyses of neuronal oscillations ranging from local oscillatory activities to the usage of graph theoretical tools in the analyses of synchronization. In this way, the present volume provides a comprehensive view on the analyses and functional significance of neuronal oscillations in humans. This book is aimed at doctoral and post doctoral students as well as research scientists in the fields of cognitive neuroscience, psychology, medicine, and neurosciences.

Few studies come close to answering why pictures and sculptures fascinate and intrigue regardless of any practical functions they might serve. In this original, thought-provoking study, Paul Crowther reveals the intrinsic significance of pictures and sculptures. To address the question of how painting becomes an art, Crowther uses the analytic philosophy of Richard Wollheim as a starting point. But to sufficiently answer the question, he makes an important link to a tradition much more successful in giving voice to the deeper ontology of visual art: existential phenomenology. The result is a work that demonstrates the reciprocal relationship between phenomenology and analytic aesthetics. Der erste Teil des Buchs ist eine vollständige Dokumentation der Ausstellung *Seeing Red: an International Exhibition of Nonobjective Painting*, die im Frühjahr 2003 in den Hunter Art Galleries New York gezeigt wurde. Die Ausstellung umfasste ca. 150 rote Gemälde von 75 Künstlerinnen und Künstlern aus Europa und den USA. Im zweiten Teil des Buchs wird das Symposium *Color as Experience* dokumentiert, das anlässlich der Ausstellung im Goethe Institut New York stattfand. Die Geschichte der abstrakten und nicht gegenständlichen Malerei des 20. Jahrhunderts steht zwar im engen Zusammenhang mit der Entwicklung von wissenschaftlichen Farbtheorien, doch wurden diese Beziehung kaum untersucht, wie überhaupt Kunst und Wissenschaft nur selten Gegenstand einer systematischen Forschung wurden. Mit der zunehmenden Standardisierung von Farbdarstellungen in den elektronischen Medien ist jedoch das Interesse an den wissenschaftlichen Untersuchungen zur Wirkung von Farbe und dem künstlerischen Umgang mit ihr neu erwacht. Ein wichtiger Aspekt dieser Entwicklung geht auf den Austausch zwischen amerikanischen und deutschen Künstlern und Wissenschaftlern zurück. Die Amerikaner wurden insbesondere durch die beiden deutschen Maler Hans Hofmann und Josef Albers und die Gestalttheoretiker stark beeinflusst, während die nicht gegenständliche Malerei vor allem in den 50er und 60er Jahren von den Amerikanern vorangetrieben wurde. Die Ausstellung *Seeing Red* versuchte, dieser Entwicklung mit einem speziellen Ansatz nachzugehen. property to date A Neofederalist Vision of TRIPS by Graeme B Dinwoodie and Rochelle C Dreyfuss examines its interpretation its impact on the creative environment and its effect on national and international lawmaking It propounds a vision of TRIPS as creating a neofederalist regime one that will ensure the resilience of the international intellectual property system in time of rapid change In this vision WTO members retain considerable flexibility to tailor intellectual property law to their national priorities and to experiment with changes necessary to meet new technological and social challenges but agree to operate within an international framework This framework while less powerful than the central administration of a federal government comprises a series of substantive and procedural commitments that promote the coordination of both the present intellectual property system as well as future international intellectual property lawmaking Part I demonstrates the centrality of state autonomy throughout the history of international negotiations over intellectual property Part II which looks at the present analyzes the decisions of the WTO in intellectual property cases It concludes that the WTO has been inattentive to the benefits of promoting cultural diversity the values inherent in intellectual property the rich fabric of its law and lore the necessary balance between producers and users of knowledge goods and the relationship between the law and the technological environment in which it must operate Looking to the future Part III develops a framework for integrating the increasingly fragmented international system and proposes the recognition of an international intellectual property acquis a set of longstanding principles that have informed and should continue to inform intellectual property lawmaking The acquis would include both express and latent components of the international regime put access regarding guarantees such as user rights on a par with proprietary interests and enshrine the fundamental importance of national autonomy in the international system
