"Spain Mad": British Engagement with the Spanish Civil War Tom Buchanan, 2024-06-15 Taking inspiration from a police informer's comment that his workmates had gone Spain mad in response to the Spanish Civil War this book uses biographical studies to explore the nature of British engagement with the conflict The opening chapter presents a general analysis of the subject and assesses the available evidence Some 2400 Britons volunteered to fight in the conflict and some 500 died there Accordingly the International Brigades are well represented in the book with chapters on two of the commanders of the British Battalion Wilfred Macartney and Fred Copeman and the Anglo Canadian volunteer Frank Whitfield Two of the other subjects George Orwell and Felicia Browne fought in other units However the book shows that engagement in the Civil War could take many forms hence the chapters on the journalist Philip Jordan clergyman E O Iredell and the humanitarian activist and politician G T Garratt The remaining chapters look at three historians and writers who have shaped the understanding of the Civil War in Britain Orwell Hugh Thomas and Jim Fyfe The book is based on extensive new research and many of these subjects have never previously been studied in any depth , **Spain 1936** Raanan Rein, Joan Maria Thomas, 2018-04-23 Marking the 80th anniversary of the outbreak of the Spanish Civil War this volume takes a close look at the initial political moves military actions and consequences of the fratricidal conflict and their impact on both Spaniards and contemporary European powers The contributors re-examine the crystallization of the political alliances formed in the Republican and the Nationalist zones the support mobilized by the two warring camps and the different attitudes and policies adopted by neighbouring and far away countries *Spain 1936 Year Zero* goes beyond and against commonly held assumptions as to the supposed unity of the Nationalist camp vis-à-vis the fragmentation of the Republican one and likewise brings to the fore the complexities of initial support of the military rebellion by Nazi Germany and Soviet support of the beleaguered Republic Situating the Iberian conflict in the larger international context senior and junior scholars from various countries challenge the multitude of hitherto accepted ideas about the beginnings of the Spanish Civil War A primary aim of the editors is to enable discussion on the Spanish Civil War from lesser known or realized perspectives by investigating the civil war's impact on countries such as Argentina Japan and Jewish Palestine and from lesser heard voices at the time of women intellectuals and athletes Original contributions are devoted to the Popular Olympiad organized in Barcelona in July 1936 Japanese perceptions of the Spanish conflict in light of the 1931 invasion to Manchuria and international volunteers in the International Brigades **The Truth about Spain!** Hugo García, 2010 Based on a combination of a wide ranging secondhand sources along with previously unknown archival material from Spain Britain France and the US this book explores the Spanish Civil War of 1936 1939 as a propaganda battle aimed mainly at foreign public opinion It shows how both Nationalists and Republicans used the experiences of previous conflicts such as World War I as well as that of their totalitarian allies to set up a number of propaganda and censorship services with the goal of persuading foreign and

specifically British audiences of the legitimacy of their causes and of the need to give them political military and relief assistance The propaganda messages designed by both sides ranging from the atrocities committed by the enemy to illegal foreign intervention on its behalf are analyzed in detail together with the techniques that were employed to transmit these messages such as eye witness accounts official commissions unofficial missions of investigation documentaries art exhibitions etc As to the impact of both campaigns on the British population the book argues that their crude nature helped to mobilize both the extreme right and the extreme left but alienated the great majority who preferred to rally to the Non Intervention policy adopted by the Baldwin and Chamberlain governments The chronicle of this relatively neglected topic demonstrates not only the utter modernity of the Spanish conflict but also the origin of some of the arguments still employed by current historians of the war As Nibel Townson the series editor points out in the preface The aim of *The Truth about Spain* is not to establish the veracity or otherwise of the Spanish propaganda campaigns but to reveal their inner workings and how these impinged upon their efforts to sway British public opinion In this the author succeeds admirably presenting a dispassionate and detailed study of the forms and functioning of those campaigns *Bulletin for Spanish and Portuguese Historical Studies* 37 1 December 2012 211 215 **Anti-Fascism in a Global Perspective** Kasper Braskén, Nigel Copsey, David J

centrist consensual politics Thus while Lerroux was the most significant advocate of a revolutionary break with Spains monarchical and authoritarian past before 1931 after the proclamation of the Second Republic he wished to build an inclusive and tolerant democracy This book is the first scholarly biography in any language of this titan of modern Spanish politics Nigel Townsons *The Crisis of Democracy in Spain* 2000 is the only book in English to discuss Lerrouxs career in any detail but his study is restricted to the Second Republic Utilising neglected primary material Villa Garcia argues that Lerroux embodies the transition from the elitist liberal politics of the nineteenth century to the modern mass politics of the twentieth Like the Second Republic itself Lerrouxs political career ended in failure The work is a timely reminder to students of modern Spain that the demise of Republican democracy was not inevitable Nevertheless after the abrupt end to Lerrouxs effort to sustain a broadly based moderate and democratic government Spain would never again achieve stable and constitutional rule until 1977 The political defeat of Lerroux was a major turning point in the countrys history a fateful step in the failure of democracy and the coming of civil war

Transatlantic Anarchism during the Spanish Civil War and Revolution, 1936-1939 Morris Brodie, 2020-04-08 Between 1936 and 1939 the Spanish Civil War showcased anarchism to the world News of the revolution in Spain energised a moribund international anarchist movement and activists from across the globe flocked to Spain to fight against fascism and build the revolution behind the front lines Those that stayed at home set up groups and newspapers to send money weapons and solidarity to their Spanish comrades This book charts this little known phenomenon through a transnational case study of anarchists from Britain Ireland and the United States using a thematic approach to place their efforts in the wider context of the civil war the anarchist movement and the international left

'Paracuellos' Dr Julius Ruiz, 2016-11-01 This book examines the most polemical atrocity of the

Spanish Civil War the massacre of 2 500 political prisoners by Republican security forces in the villages of Paracuellos and Torrejón de Ardoz near Madrid in November December 1936 The atrocity took place while Santiago Carrillo later Communist Party leader in the 1970s was responsible for public order Although Carrillo played a key role in the transition to democracy after Franco's death in 1975 he passed away at the age of 97 in 2012 still denying any involvement in Paracuellos the generic term for the massacres The issue of Carrillo's responsibility has been the focus of much historical research Julius Ruiz places Paracuellos in the wider context of the Red Terror in Madrid where a minimum of 8 000 fascists were murdered after the failure of military rebellion in July 1936 He rejects both revisionist right wing writers such as Cesar Vidal who cite Paracuellos as evidence that the Republic committed Soviet style genocide and left wing historians such as Paul Preston who in his Spanish Holocaust argues that the massacres were primarily the responsibility of the Soviet secret police the NKVD The book argues that Republican actions influenced the Soviets not the other way round Paracuellos intensified Stalin's fears of a Fifth Column within the USSR that facilitated the Great Terror of 1937-38 It concludes that the perpetrators were primarily members of the Provincial Committee of Public Investigation CPIP a murderous all leftist revolutionary tribunal created in August 1936 and that its work of eliminating the Fifth Column an imaginary clandestine Francoist organisation was supported not just by Carrillo but also by the Republican government In Autumn 2015 the book was serialised in *El Mundo* Spain's second largest selling daily to great acclaim

Mexico and the Spanish Civil War Mario Ojeda

radical regimes which have been much less studied fascist Italy the Iberian dictatorships and Nazi Germany Through analyses of the travel writing produced as a result of such visits the book gauges the appeal of these forms of authoritarianism for inter war French intellectuals from a broad political spectrum It examines not only those whose political sympathies with the extreme right or extreme left were already publicly known but also non aligned intellectuals who were interested in political models that offered an apparently radical alternative to the French Third Republic This study shows how travel writing provided a space for reflection on the lessons France might learn from the radical political experiments of the inter war years It argues that such writing can usefully be read as a form of utopian thinking distinguishing this from colloquial understandings of utopia as an ideal location Utopianism is understood neither as a fantasy ungrounded in the real nor as a dangerously totalitarian ideal but in line with Karl Mannheim Paul Ric ur and Ruth Levitas as a form of non congruence with the real that it seeks to transcend The utopianism of French political travel writing is seen to lie not in the attempt to portray the destination visited as utopia but rather in the pursuit of a dialogue with radical political alterity

Gibraltar and the Spanish Civil War, 1936-39 Julio Ponce Alberca, 2014-11-20 Incorporating local national and international dimensions of the conflict Gibraltar and the Spanish Civil War 1936 39 provides the first detailed account of the British enclave Gibraltar s role during and after the Spanish Civil War The neutral stance adopted by democratic powers upon the outbreak of the Spanish Civil War is well known The Non Intervention Committee played a key role in this strategy with Great Britain a key player in what became known as the London Committee British interests in the Iberian Peninsula however meant that events in Spain were of crucial importance to the Foreign Office and the victory of the Popular Front in February 1936 was deemed a potential threat that could drive the country towards instability This book explores how British authorities in Gibraltar ostensibly initiated a formal policy of neutrality when the uprising took place only for the Gibraltarian authorities to provide real support for the Nationalists under the surface The book draws on a wealth of primary source material some of it little known before now to deliver a significant contribution to our knowledge of the part played by democratic powers in the 1930s confrontation between Communism and Fascism It is essential reading for anyone seeking a complete understanding of the Spanish Civil War

Falangist and National Catholic Women in the Spanish Civil War (1936-1939) Angela Flynn, 2020-03-11 Although there is an established historiography on women s roles during the Spanish Civil War 1936 9 little has been written on Nationalist women in the Republican held zones Women were the anti Republican resisters of the first hour in the capital but they have been largely overlooked in the historical record During the bitter civil conflict a sector of dissident women helped to create a subversive and clandestine national Catholic space in the heart of Republican Madrid By examining the vital and invisible role played by women within Madrid s fifth column this monograph offers a new contribution to the gender historiography of the Spanish Civil War and re evaluates the significance of women in the Nationalist war effort It explores how and why a sector of Falangist and Catholic women decided to mobilise against the

legally constituted Popular Front government in support of an undemocratic military coup While women s subversive activities often involved the transgression of traditional gender norms their social and political agency arose within the conditions and precepts of Catholicism and was conceptualised and imagined within new national Catholic discourses of holy Crusade

Alcala Zamora and the Failure of the Spanish Republic, 1931-1936 Stanley G. Payne, 2017-02-23 The Second Spanish Republic 1931-36 was the only new liberal democratic regime to emerge in Europe during the 1930s Historians however have focused primarily on the Civil War of 1936-39 that followed devoting much less attention to the parliamentary regime that preceded it This book deals with the history and failure of the democratic polity in Spain through a detailed examination of the initiatives of its president Niceto Alcala Zamora As civil servant lawyer politician and writer by 1931 he had become one of the most successful men of Spain He played the leading role in the downfall of the monarchy and the inauguration of the Republic which he served for eight months as initial prime minister and then as the first president Stanley Payne s study argues that the failure of the Republic was not inevitable but depended on the policy choices of its president and the key party leaders Alcala Zamora s professed goal was to center the Republic stabilizing the new regime while avoiding extremes but he failed altogether in this project The Constitution of 1931 stipulated the double responsibility of parliamentary government both to the president and to a voting majority Though Alcala Zamora resisted strong efforts from the left to cancel the results of the first fully democratic elections in 1933 he subsequently used his powers recklessly making and unmaking governments at will refusing to permit normal functioning of parliament This first critical scholarly account of the presidency of Alcala Zamora casts new light on the failure of democracy in interwar Europe and on the origins of the Spanish Civil War
