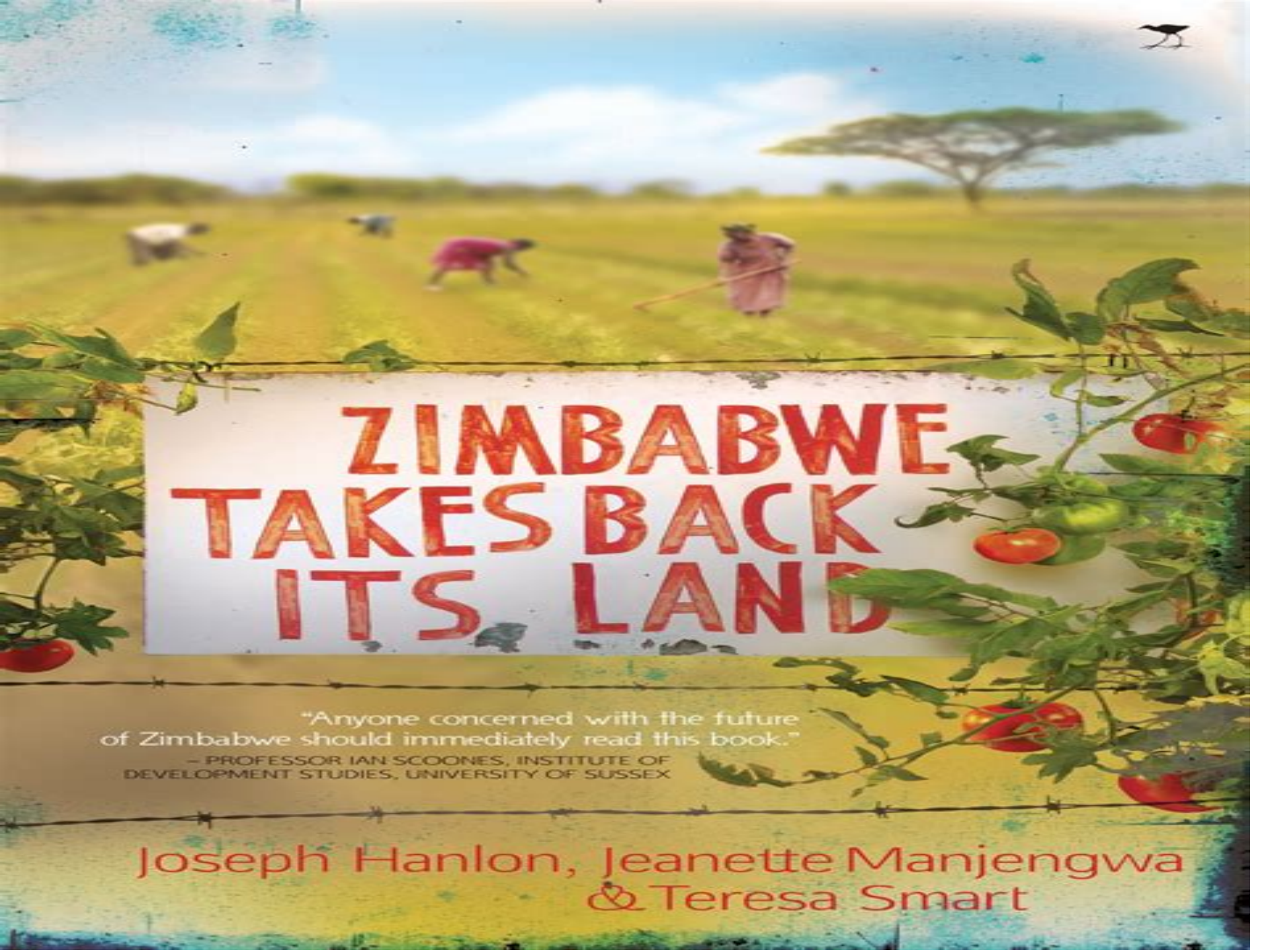

The Land Reform Deception Charles Laurie, 2016-02-01 The Land Reform Deception looks at a particularly contentious period in Zimbabwe's recent history from 2000-2008 when the government seized commercial farms using illegal and violent methods against a largely unarmed population of farmers and farm workers Robert Mugabe's government began the seizures on a small targeted scale in an effort to suppress political opposition groups but they soon escalated into an out of control frenzy targeting all farms in the country The state claimed that the seizures occurred in response to a public cry for land redistribution and to rectify colonial era injustices and were part of a structured land reallocation program Yet land was often distributed ad hoc to those with little or no farming experience As a result agricultural output contracted and inflation and unemployment rose dramatically in what became a social and economic disaster for the country In The Land Reform Deception Charles Laurie asks why the state would target its own agricultural industry using such violent methods and risk such dire consequences He also seeks to uncover the major actors and their motivations and strategies Laurie argues that the seizure of the most valuable farms was largely carried out by politically influential individuals for financial and political gain rather than to address historical injustices In fact he finds that the scale on which the farm invasions were carried out and the violent methods used were never part of a planned government land policy Indeed Laurie shows that Mugabe initially opposed the seizures knowing that they would wreck the economy only to later support them in order to appease his supporters and retain political power Incorporating unprecedented empirical evidence gathered from in depth interviews with senior politicians members of the secretive Central Intelligence Organization the military and police along with farmers and farm workers who were targeted during the invasions The Land Reform Deception strips away official explanations and delves into the political and economic drivers that triggered the seizure of commercial farms in Zimbabwe

Land and Agrarian Transformation in Zimbabwe Grasian Mkodzongi, 2020-06-05. This book examines the dynamics underpinning the implementation of Zimbabwe's fast track land reforms. By utilising ethnographic data gathered in central Zimbabwe, the book goes beyond the polarised debates which dominated scholarship in the earlier period to highlight the changing livelihoods occasioned by the land reform. The book argues that despite the challenges faced by the newly resettled farmers, the land reform has allowed landless and land short peasants access to land and other natural resources which were previously enclosed to them under a bi-modal agrarian structure inherited from colonialism.

Land, the State and the Unfinished Decolonisation Project in Africa Chitonge, Horman, Mine, Yoichi, 2019-06-25. This book focuses on the work of one of the leading African scholars on the land question and agrarian transformation in Africa, Sam Moyo. It offers a critical discussion in conversation with Sam Moyo of the land question and the response of African states. Since independence, African states have been trying to address the colonial legacy on land policy and governance. After six decades of formulating and implementing land reforms, most countries have not succeeded in decolonising approaches to land policy and the administrative framework. The book brings together the broader debates on the implications of decolonisation of Africa's land policy. Through case studies from several African countries, the book offers an empirical analysis on land reforms and the emerging land relations and how these affect land allocation and use, including agricultural production. Most of the chapters discuss how the unresolved land question in post-colonial Africa impacts on agricultural production and rural development broadly. The failure to decolonise colonial land policy and the imported tenure systems has left post-colonial African states dancing to two tunes, resulting in schizophrenic land and agrarian policies. The book demonstrates that the failure by African states to reconcile imported and indigenous land tenure systems and practices is evident in the deliberate denigration of customary tenure. It is also evident in the rising land inequality and the neglect of the agricultural sector, the small scale and subsistence sub-sectors in particular.

Violence and Memory in Zimbabwean Literature Tanaka Chidora, 2025-12-01. This book investigates how Zimbabwean literary texts subvert state-sponsored amnesia when it comes to the many forms of past and ongoing political violence in Zimbabwe. Zimbabwean Literature provides an important space for confronting the past and reflecting on

how violence continues into the present day This violent past was forgotten either through the promise of violence against those who sought to remember or by depicting the violence as a necessary tool of a never ending decolonisation process or by appealing to the logic of letting bygones be bygones For instance by claiming that the five years of the Gukurahundi genocide were a moment of madness Robert Mugabe set a climate of state sponsored amnesia which has persisted through subsequent acts of state violence and into the Mnangagwa era Drawing on key works by Shimmer Chinodya Alexander Kanengoni Yvonne Vera Novuyo Rosa Tshuma Brian Chikwava Chenjerai Hove Panashe Chigumadzi and NoViolet Bulawayo this book investigates how fictional works challenge this state sponsored amnesia in relation both to Gukurahundi and other past and ongoing forms of violence Bringing together iconic literary texts from 1980 to 2022 the book draws a common thread through the texts connected histories and highlights their role in de silencing the past Situated at the interface of memory studies and literary criticism this book will be of interest to researchers across the fields of African literature politics development and history

Society, Power, and Land in Northeastern Zimbabwe, ca. 1560–1960 Admire Mseba, 2024-11-12 A little over two decades ago Zimbabwe undertook its Fast Track Land Reform Programme Critics saw it as nothing more than an assault on human and property rights for political expedience by a ruling elite that was fast losing its power In contrast those sympathetic to the land reform program saw it as fundamental to the righting of colonialism's historical wrongs Yet rural displacements at the hands of state actors or of those closely connected to them continue As in the past the continuing land conflicts are mostly understood as the result of the actions of an authoritarian state that exploits its control of land for the political and economic benefit of those who inhabit it These explanations share one thing in common each understands the country's perpetual land questions in terms of the actions or inactions of the colonial or the postcolonial state This book refocuses attention on how regimes of power rooted in kinship gender generation and status have individually and in combination informed access to land in precolonial northeastern Zimbabwe It then examines how these regimes of power interacted with colonial policies to inform the African experience in colonial Zimbabwe Further the book places land and the ability to ensure its fecundity at the center of the making and moderation of precolonial political power and how this power was impacted by the imposition of colonial rule

Tracing the dynamics of land and power from precolonial times together with their entanglement with colonial policies is important for this relationship is almost always neglected by both scholars and policymakers drawn to the high drama of colonial and postcolonial politics of land This oversight has real consequences on our understandings of landed inequalities and how they are addressed When Zimbabwe's postcolonial state focused on colonially induced racialized land inequalities its land reform efforts left older forms of landed inequalities based on gender generation and ideas of belonging intact The book which details these inequalities reminds Zimbabweans and others that if the quest for equity espoused in postcolonial land reforms is to be meaningful it must be attentive to both colonially induced inequalities and those enduring disparities that predated were deepened by and outlived colonial rule At the same time Zimbabweans who now live with a postcolonial state that is increasingly centralizing power over land may well learn from past societies creative efforts to limit the authority of their leaders
