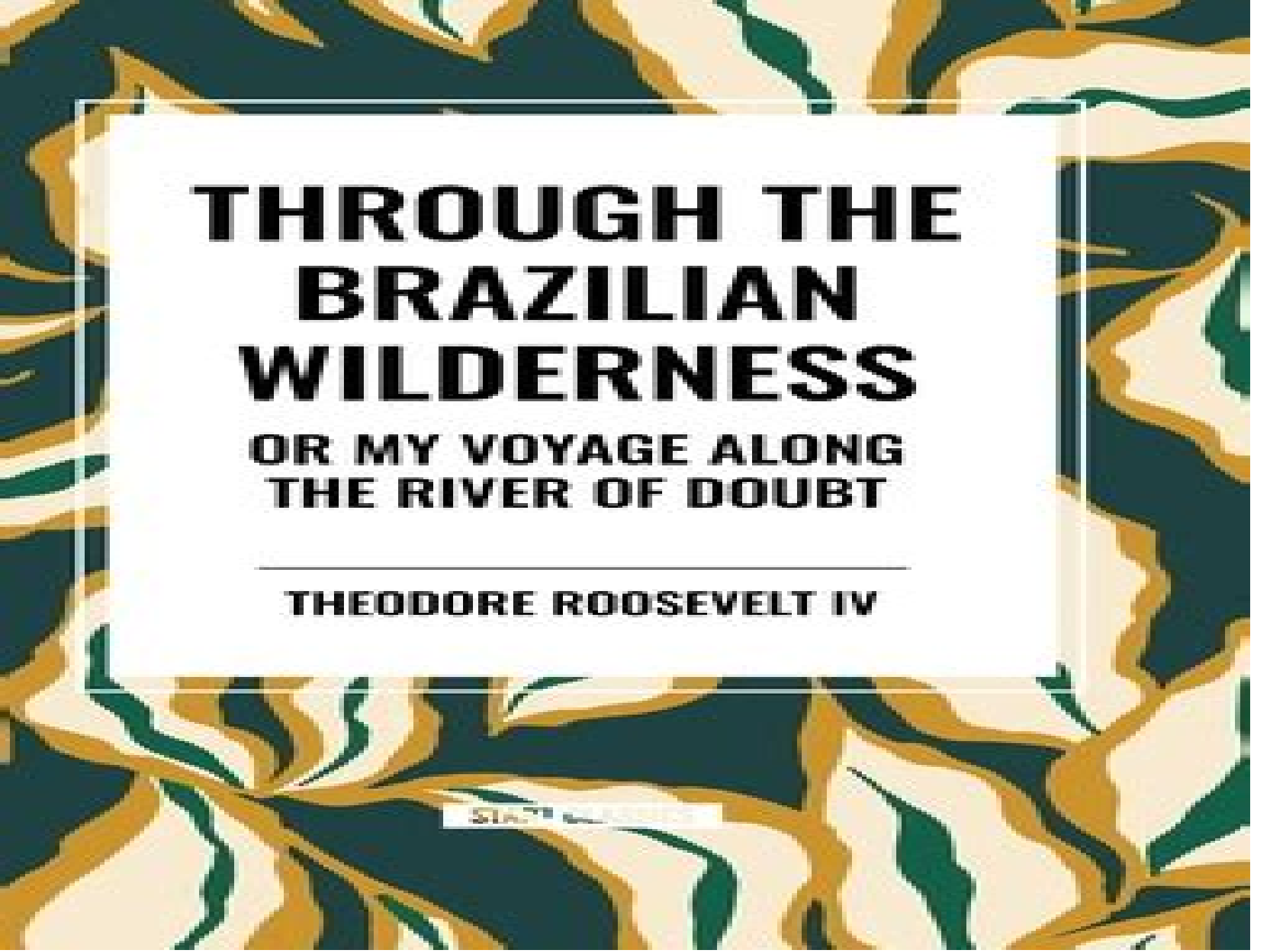

Men died, boats were lost, food became scarce, dangerous animals, and natives were about fever-borne by insects sickened many in the party and led to Roosevelt's own death five years later. If he had followed the interests of his youth, he would have grown up to be a naturalist rather than President of the United States. However, T.R. never lost his interest in nature. Following his presidency, he set out on an expedition to explore and map unknown regions of Paraguay and Brazil on the 950-mile River of Doubt, a previously unexplored tributary of the Amazon River.
