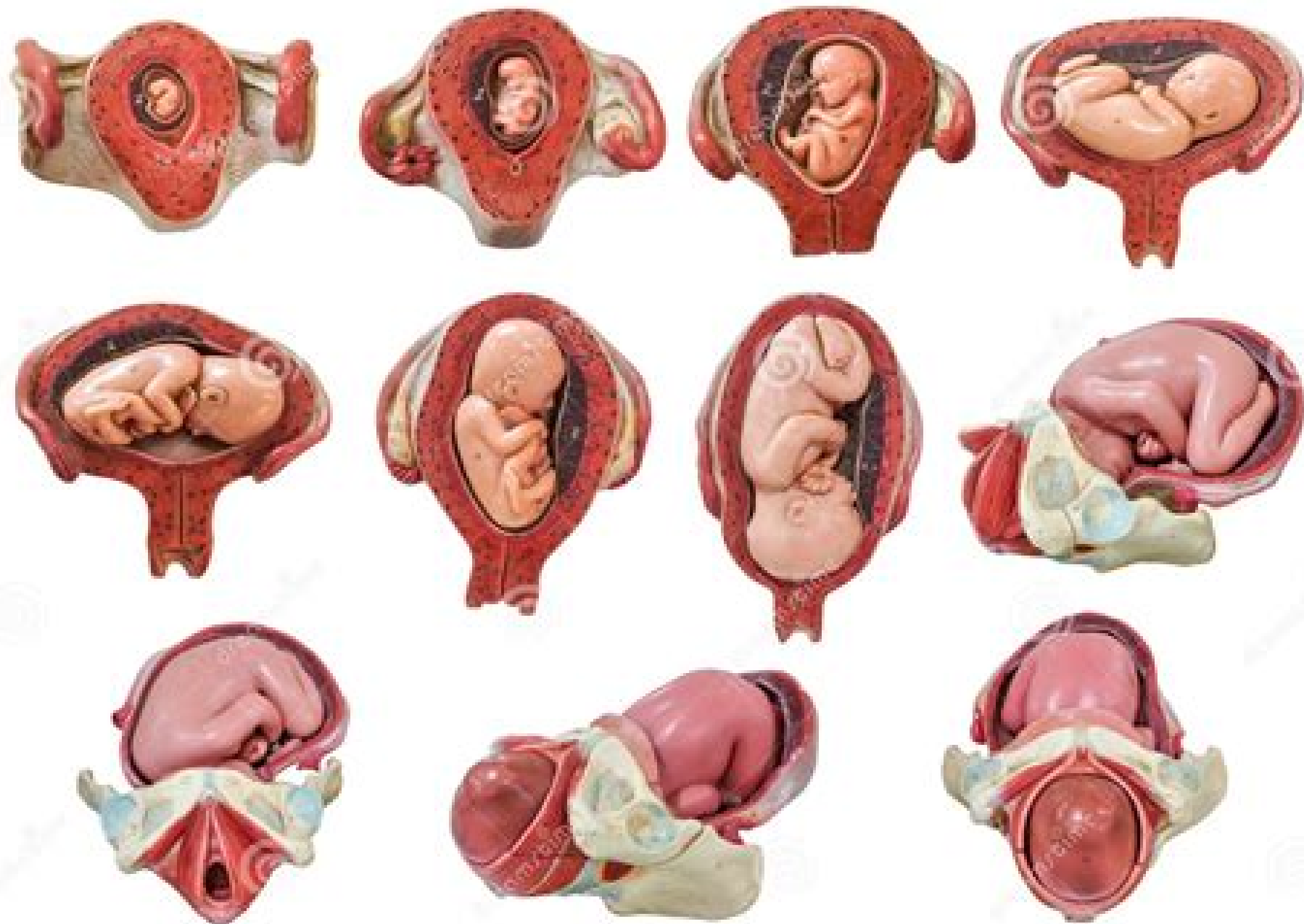

maternal emotions during pregnancy Her findings demonstrate clearly how psychoanalytical evidence enhances deepens and supports observational data on the remarkable behavioural and psychological continuities between pre natal and post natal life
