it is equal in complexity and power to better known more commercial text based art Minimal writing Stephens writes can be beguilingly simple on the surface but can also offer iterative reading experiences on multiple levels from the fleeting to the ponderous absence of clutter for example the entire text of a poem by Robert Grenier is both expressive and self descriptive Stephens first sets out a theoretical framework for reading and viewing minimal writing and then offers close readings of works of minimal writing by Saroyan Grenier Norman Pritchard Natalie Czech and others He reverse engineers recent works by Jen Bervin Craig Dworkin and Christian B k that draw on molecular biology and explores print on demand books by Holly Melgard code poetry by Nick Montfort Twitter based work by Allison Parrish and the use of Instagram by Hans Ulrich Obrist and Saroyan Text it seems is becoming ever more prevalent in visual art meanwhile poems are getting shorter When reading has become scanning a screen and writing tapping out a text absence of clutter invites us to reflect on how we read see and pay attention

The Typographic Medium Kate Brideau, 2021-10-19 An innovative examination of typography as a medium of communication rather than part of print or digital media Typography is everywhere and yet widely unnoticed When we read type we fail to see type In this book Kate Brideau considers typography not as part of print media or digital media but as a medium of communication itself able to transcend the life and death of particular technologies Examining the contradiction between typographic form often overlooked and function often overpowering Brideau argues that typography is made up not of letters but of shapes and that shape is existentially and technologically central to the typographic medium After considering what constitutes typographic form Brideau turns to typographic function and how it relates to form Examining typography s role in both the neurological and psychological aspects of reading she argues that typography s functions exceed reading typographic forms communicate but that communication is not limited to the content they carry To understand to what extent the design and operations of the typographic medium affect the way we perceive information Brideau warns we must understand the medium s own operational logic embodied in the full diversity of typographic forms Brideau discusses a range of topics from intellectual property protection for typefaces to Renaissance and Enlightenment ideal letterforms and draws on a wide variety of theoretical work including phenomenological ideas about comprehension German media archaeology and the media and communication theories of Vil m Flusser and others Hand drawn illustrations of typographic forms accompany the text

Objects in Exile Robin Schuldenfrei, 2024-01-23 An essential examination of how emigration and resettlement defined modernism In the fraught years leading up to World War II many modern artists and architects emigrated from continental Europe to the United States and Britain The experience of exile infused their modernist ideas with new urgency and forced them to use certain materials in place of others modify existing works and reconsider their approach to design itself In *Objects in Exile* Robin Schuldenfrei reveals how the process of migration was crucial to the development of modernism charting how modern art and architecture was shaped by the need to constantly face and transcend the materiality of things Taking readers from the prewar era to the 1960s Schuldenfrei explores the

The Chinese Typewriter Thomas S. Mullaney, 2018-10-09 How Chinese characters triumphed over the QWERTY keyboard and laid the foundation for China's information technology successes today Chinese writing is character based the one major world script that is neither alphabetic nor syllabic Through the years the Chinese written language encountered presumed alphabetic universalism in the form of Morse Code Braille stenography Linotype punch cards word processing and other systems developed with the Latin alphabet in mind This book is about those encounters in particular thousands of Chinese characters versus the typewriter and its QWERTY keyboard Thomas Mullaney describes a fascinating series of experiments prototypes failures and successes in the century long quest for a workable Chinese typewriter The earliest Chinese typewriters Mullaney tells us were figments of popular imagination sensational accounts of twelve foot keyboards with 5 000 keys One of the first Chinese typewriters actually constructed was invented by a Christian missionary who organized characters by common usage but promoted the less common characters for Jesus to the common usage level Later came typewriters manufactured for use in Chinese offices and typewriting schools that turned out trained typewriter girls and typewriter boys Still later was the Double Pigeon typewriter produced by the Shanghai Calculator and Typewriter Factory the typewriter of choice under Mao Clerks and secretaries in this era experimented with alternative ways of organizing characters on their tray beds inventing an input method that was the first instance of predictive text Today after more than a century of resistance against the alphabetic not only have Chinese characters prevailed they form the linguistic substrate of the vibrant world of Chinese information technology The Chinese Typewriter not just an object history but grappling with broad questions of technological change and global communication shows how this happened A Study of the Weatherhead East Asian Institute Columbia University
