Michon, Aladin Akyrürek, 2013-03-12 Soar A Cognitive Architecture in Perspective represents a European perspective on Soar with the exception of the special contribution from Allen Newell arguing for Unified Theories of Cognition The various papers derive from the work of the Soar Research Group that has been active at the University of Groningen The Netherlands since 1987 The work reported here has been inspired in particular by two topics that precipitated the group s interest in Soar in the first place road user behavior and the temporal organization of behavior more specifically planning At the same time the various contributions go well beyond the simple use of Soar as a convenient medium for modeling human cognitive activity In every paper one or more fundamental issues are raised that touch upon the very nature and consistency of Soar as an intelligent architecture As a result the reader will learn about the operator implementation problem chunking multitasking the need to constrain the depth of the goal stack and induction etc Soar is still at a relatively early stage of development It does nevertheless constitute an important breakthrough in the area of computer architectures for general intelligence Soar shows one important direction that future efforts to build intelligent systems should take if they aim for a comprehensive and psychologically meaningful

the variation in mixing patterns in the speech of Russia German adolescents and young adults in Germany and ii to propose and test usage based explanations of variation in mixing patterns in three morphosyntactic contexts the adjective modified noun phrase the prepositional phrase and the plural marking of German noun insertions in bilingual sentences In these contexts German noun insertions combine with either Russian or German words and grammatical markers thus yielding mixed bilingual and German monolingual constituents in otherwise Russian sentences the latter also labelled as embedded language islands The results suggest that the frequency with which words are used together mediates the distribution of mixing patterns in each of the examined contexts The differing impacts of co occurrence frequency are attributed to the distributional and semantic specifics of the analyzed morphosyntactic configurations Lexical frequency has been found to be another important determinant in this variation Other factors include recency or lexical priming in discourse in the case of prepositional phrases and phonological and structural similarities and differences in the inflectional systems of the contact languages in the case of plural marking

use interactive systems The latter half of this book describes theory practices in detail A new methodology called Cognitive Chrono Ethnography CCE is introduced which adds the time dimension to Hutchins Cognitive Ethnography in order to practice know the users systematically by designing user studies based on a simulation of users mental operations controlled by Two Minds The author then shows how CCE has been applied to understanding the ways in which people navigate in real physical environments by walking and by car respectively and explores the possibility of applying CCE to predict people s future needs This is not for understanding how people use interfaces at present but to predict how people want to use the interfaces in the future given they are currently using them in a certain way Finally the book concludes by describing implications of human machine interactions that are carried out while using modern artefacts for people s cognitive development from birth on the basis of the theories of action selection and memorization
