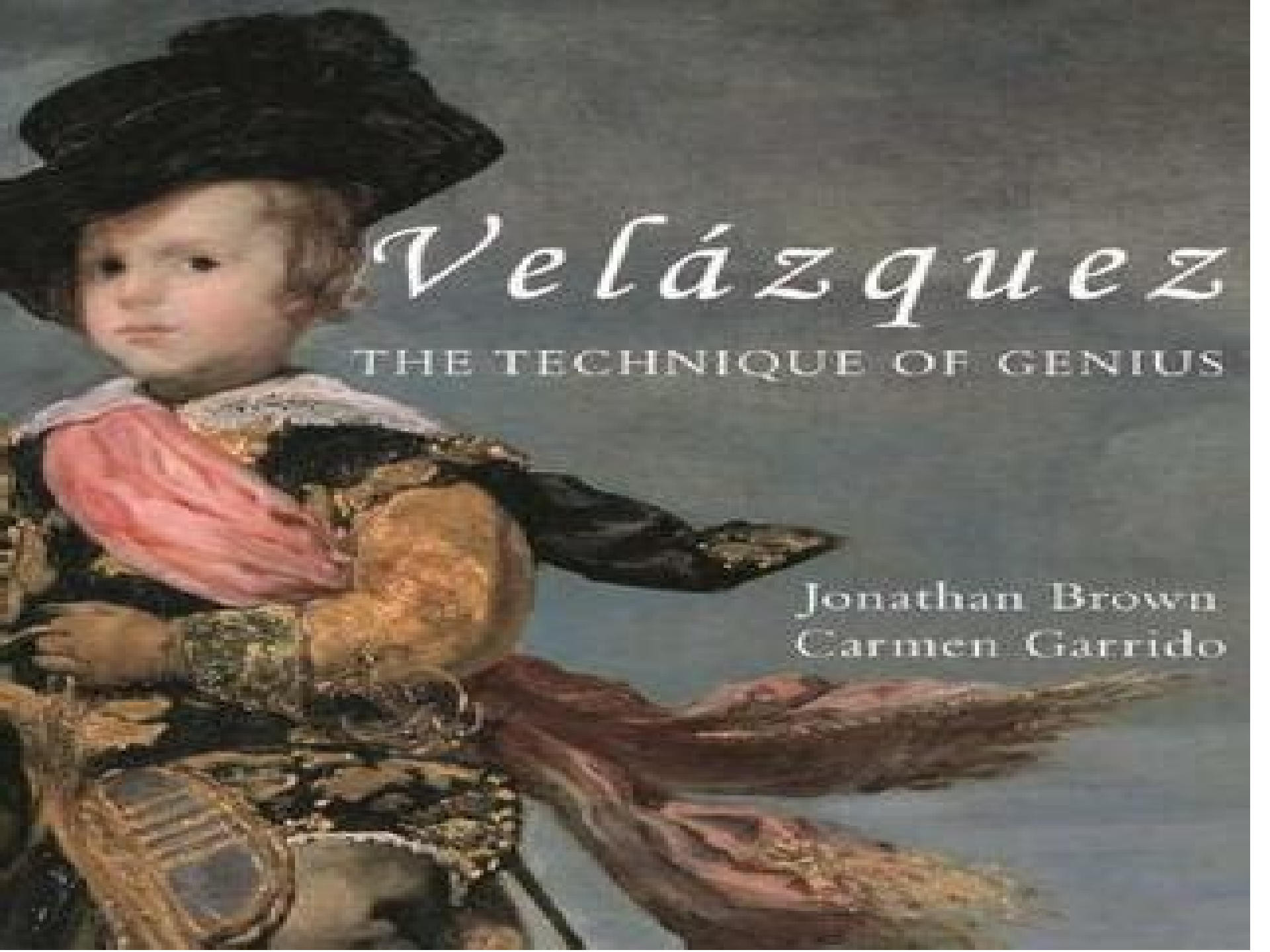

poems by both canonical Garcilaso de la Vega Luis de Gongora Lope de Vega etc and less well known writers Juan de la Cueva Alonso de Castillo Solorzano Salvador Jacinto Polo de Medina etc and culminating in detailed examination of select mythological works by Philip IV's court painter Diego Velazquez this book sheds light on questions relating to aspects of classical reception in the Renaissance the rise of specific poetic styles epic mock epic burlesque etc the interplay between the sister arts of poetry and painting and the continual process of imitation and invention that was one of the defining features of the Spanish Golden Age

The Spatial Reformation Michael J. Sauter, 2019-01-11 In *The Spatial Reformation* Michael J Sauter offers a sweeping history of the way Europeans conceived of three dimensional space including the relationship between Earth and the heavens between 1350 and 1850 He argues that this spatial reformation provoked a reorganization of knowledge in the West that was arguably as important as the religious Reformation Notably it had its own sacred text which proved as central and was as ubiquitously embraced Euclid's *Elements* Aside from the Bible no other work was so frequently reproduced in the early modern era According to Sauter its penetration and suffusion throughout European thought and experience call for a deliberate reconsideration not only of what constitutes the intellectual foundation of the early modern era but also of its temporal range *The Spatial Reformation* contends that space is a human construct that is it is a concept that arises from the human imagination and gets expressed physically in texts and material objects Sauter begins his examination by demonstrating how Euclidean geometry when it was applied fully to the cosmos estranged God from man enabling the breakthrough to heliocentrism and by extension the discovery of the New World Subsequent chapters provide detailed analyses of the construction of celestial and terrestrial globes Albrecht Dürer's engraving *Melencolia* the secularization of the natural history of the earth and man and Hobbes's rejection of Euclid's sense of space and its effect on his political theory Sauter's exploration culminates in the formation of a new anthropology in the eighteenth century that situated humanity in reference to spaces and places that human eyes had not actually seen *The Spatial Reformation* illustrates how these disparate advancements can be viewed as resulting expressly from early modernity's embrace of Euclidean geometry

the body and the material world is the unacknowledged force behind early modern Spain Life is a dream as the title of Calderon's famous play of the period proclaimed but there is always a body dreaming it **The Late Paintings of Velázquez** Giles Knox, 2017-07-05 The startling conclusion of The Late Paintings of Velázquez is that Diego Velázquez painted two of his most famous works The Spinners and Las Meninas as theoretically informed manifestos of painterly brushwork As a pair Giles Knox argues the two paintings form a learned retort to the prevailing critical disdain for the painterly Knox presents a Velázquez who was much more aware of the art theory of his era than previously acknowledged leading him to reinterpret Las Meninas and The Spinners as representing together a polemically charged celebration of the handedness of painting Knox removes Velázquez from his Iberian isolation and seeks to recover his highly self-conscious attempt to carve out a place for himself within the history of European painting as a whole The Late Paintings of Velázquez presents an artist who like Annibale Carracci Poussin Rembrandt and Vermeer was not only aware of contemporary theoretical writings on art but also able to translate that knowledge and understanding into a distinctive and personal theory of painting In Las Meninas and The Spinners Velázquez propounded this theory with paint not words Knox's rethinking of the dynamic relationship between text and image presents a case not of writing influencing painting or vice versa but of the two realms being inextricably bound together Painterly brushwork presented a challenge to writers on art not just because it was connected too intimately with the base actions of the hand it was also devilishly hard to describe By reading Velázquez's painterly performance as text Knox deciphers how Velázquez was able to craft theoretical arguments more compelling and more vivid than any written counterparts

century conversions and the first blood purity laws designed to marginalize conversos through the early sixteenth century Erasmian and radical mystical movements to a Counter Reformation environment in which conversos become the advocates for pacifism and concordance His account ends at the court of Philip IV where growing intolerance towards Madrid's converso courtiers is subtly attacked by Spain's greatest painter Diego Velázquez in his work *Los Borrachos* Finally Ingram examines the historiography of early modern Spain in which he argues the converso reform phenomenon continues to be underexplored

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
