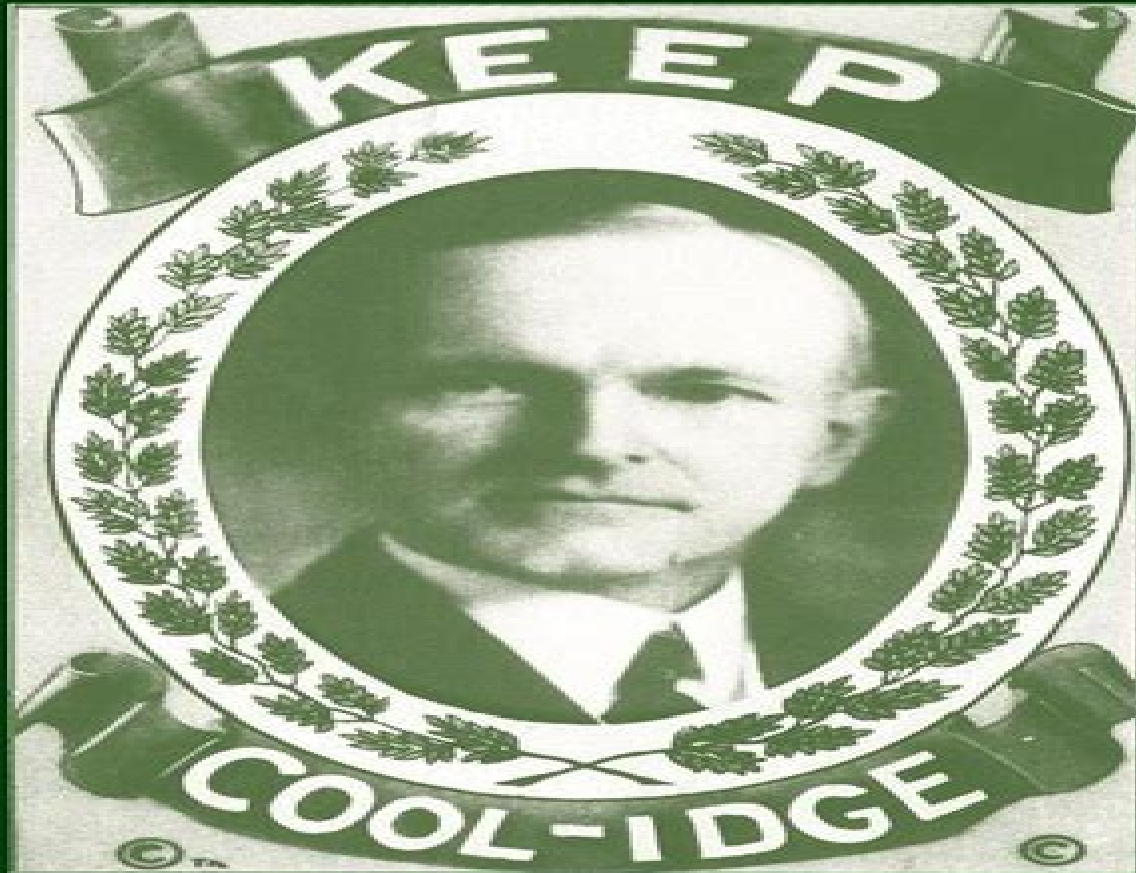

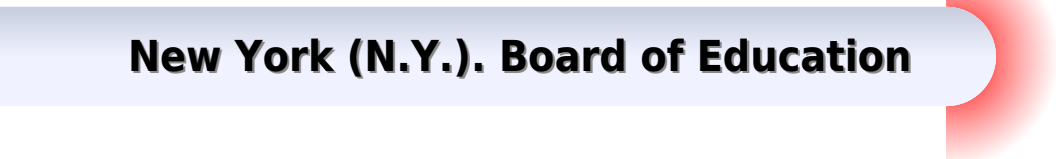


A 1924 Presidential Campaign Flyer
