Three Critics of the Enlightenment Isaiah Berlin, 2013-11-10 Isaiah Berlin was deeply admired during his life but his full contribution was perhaps underestimated because of his preference for the long essay form. The efforts of Henry Hardy to edit Berlin's work and reintroduce it to a broad eager readership have gone far to remedy this. Now Princeton is pleased to return to print under one cover Berlin's essays on these celebrated and captivating intellectual portraits Vico Hamann and Herder. These essays on three relatively uncelebrated thinkers are not marginal ruminations but rather among Berlin's most important studies in the history of ideas. They are integral to his central project: the critical recovery of the ideas of the Counter Enlightenment and the explanation of its appeal and consequences, both positive and often tragic. Giambattista Vico was the anachronistic and impoverished Neapolitan philosopher sometimes credited with founding the human sciences. He opposed Enlightenment methods as cold and fallacious. J G Hamann was a pious cranky dilettante in a peripheral German city. But he was brilliant enough to gain the audience of Kant, Goethe and Moses Mendelssohn. In Hamann's chaotic and long ignored writings, Berlin finds the first strong attack on Enlightenment rationalism and a wholly original source of the coming swell of romanticism. Johann Gottfried Herder, the progenitor of populism and European nationalism, rejected universalism and rationalism but championed cultural pluralism. Individually, these fascinating intellectual biographies reveal Berlin's own great intelligence, learning and generosity, as well as the passionate genius of his subjects. Together, they constitute an arresting interpretation of romanticism's precursors. In Hamann's railings and the more considered writings of Vico and Herder, Berlin finds critics of the Enlightenment worthy of our careful attention. But he identifies much that is misguided in their rejection of universal values, rationalism and science. With his customary emphasis on the frightening power of ideas, Berlin traces much of the next century's irrationalism and suffering to the historicism and particularism they advocated. What Berlin has to say about these long dead thinkers in appreciation and dissent is remarkably timely in a day when Enlightenment beliefs are being challenged not just by academics but by politicians and by powerful nationalist and fundamentalist movements. The study of J G Hamann was originally published under the title *The Magus of the North: J G Hamann and the Origins of Modern Irrationalism*. The essays on Vico and Herder were originally published as *Vico and Herder: Two Studies in the History of Ideas*. Both are out of print. This new edition includes a number of previously uncollected pieces on Vico and Herder, two interesting passages excluded from the first edition of the essay on Hamann, and Berlin's thoughtful responses to two reviewers of that same edition.

Rosa Newmarch and Russian Music in Late Nineteenth and Early Twentieth-Century England Philip Ross Bullock, 2017-07-05 Philip Ross Bullock looks at the life and works of Rosa Newmarch 1857-1940 the leading authority on Russian music and culture in late nineteenth and early twentieth century England Although Newmarch's work and influence are often acknowledged most particularly by scholars of English poetry and of the role of women in English music the full range of her ideas and activities has yet to be studied As an inveterate traveller prolific author and polyglot friend of some of Europe's leading musicians such as Elgar Sibelius and Janáček Newmarch deserves to be better appreciated On the basis of both published and archival materials the details of Newmarch's busy life are traced in an opening chapter followed by an overview of English interest in Russian culture around the turn of the century a period which saw a long standing Russophobia largely political and military challenged by a more passionate and well informed interest in the arts Three chapters then deal with the features that characterize Newmarch's engagement with Russian culture and society and more significantly perhaps which she also championed in her native England nationalism the role of the intelligentsia and feminism In each case Newmarch's interest in Russia was no mere instance of ethnographic curiosity rather her observations about and passion for Russia were translated into a commentary on the state of contemporary English cultural and social life Her interest in nationalism was based on the conviction that each country deserved an art of its own Her call for artists and intellectuals to play a vital role in the cultural and social life of the country illustrated how her Russian experiences could map onto the liberal values of Victorian England And her feminism was linked to the idea that women could exercise roles of authority and influence in society through participation in the arts A final chapter considers how her late interest in the music of Czechoslovakia pivots on

Jeremiah Under the Shadow of Dhuhr Joseph M. Henderson, 2019-11-14 Joe Henderson offers

a critique of the assumption that poetic form in the book of Jeremiah indicates authenticity This assumption undergirds Bernhard Duhm s reconstructions 1901 of the prophet s biography and the book s composition the basic components of the dominant paradigm for twentieth century Jeremiah scholarship Henderson argues that Duhm s model is best understood as an attempt to bring the book into conformity with nineteenth century systems of aesthetics historiography and theology and with the Grafian reconstruction of the history of Israel s religion The accord between these systems and Duhm s assumption about poetic form has less to do with their common grasp of the historical reality of Hebrew prophecy than with their common roots in the Romantic theory of prophetic and poetic inspiration a theory forged by Robert Lowth in his exposition 1752 of the poetry he found in the prophetic books Henderson contends that continued adherence to Duhm s foundational assumption has held back recent attempts to move beyond Duhm and overcome the fragmentation of the book entailed by his model Rhetorical critics who maintain that Jeremiah 2 10 is unified by the structural devices of the historical prophet and redaction critics who maintain that Jeremiah 11 20 is unified by the theological agenda of Deuteronomistic editors both rely on the assumed authenticity of the poetry Henderson observes that although these scholars have uncovered evidence of dramatic presentation in Jeremiah 2 20 they have failed to see that the dramatic nature of these chapters undermines their use for Duhm s historical critical projects and reveals what actually unifies them narrative progression
