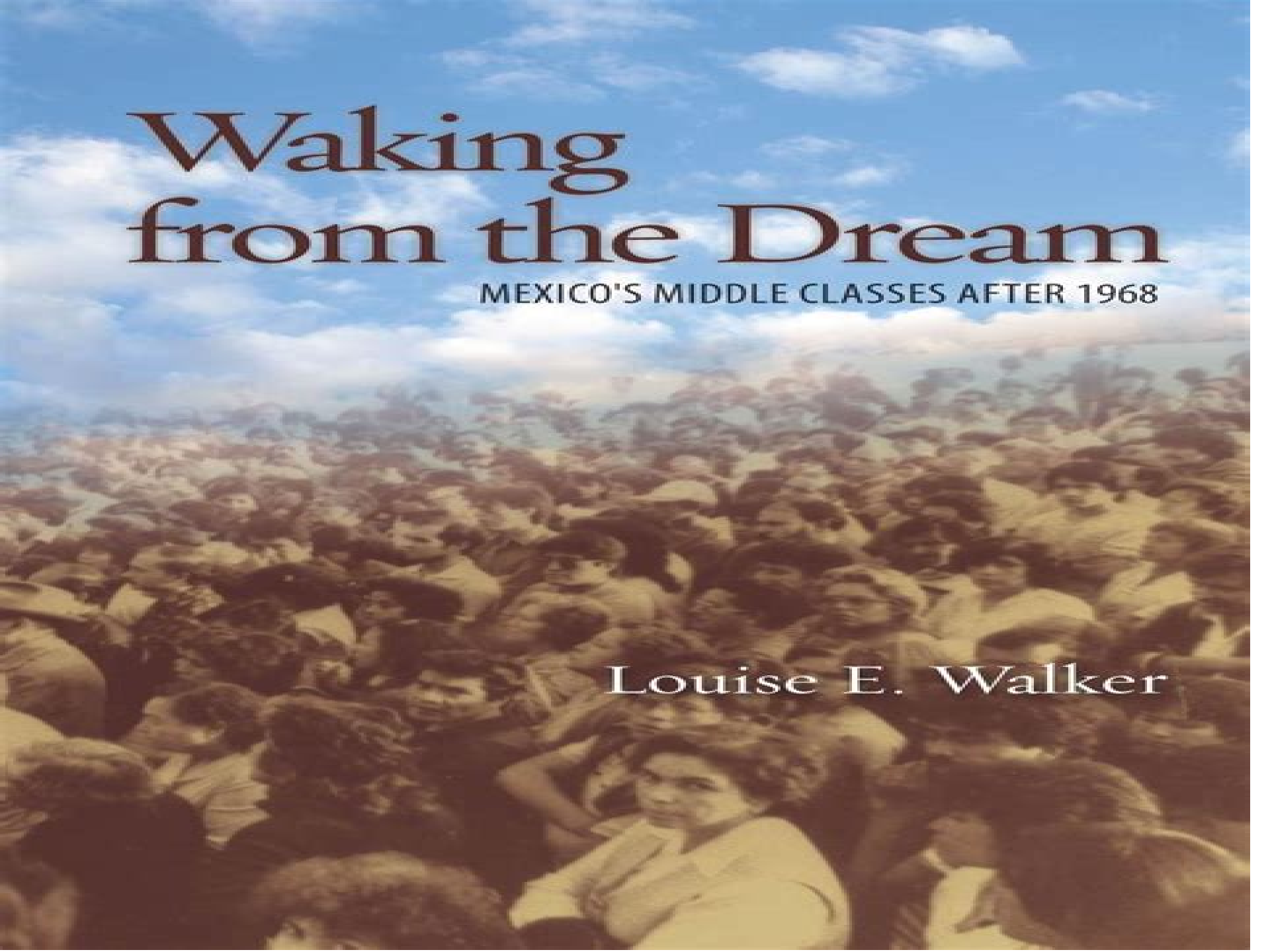

Citizens of Scandal Vanessa Freije, 2020-09-14 In *Citizens of Scandal* Vanessa Freije explores the causes and consequences of political scandals in Mexico from the 1960s through the 1980s. Tracing the process by which Mexico City reporters denounced official wrongdoing, she shows that by the 1980s political scandals were a common feature of the national media diet. News stories of state embezzlement, torture, police violence, and electoral fraud provided collective opportunities to voice dissent and offered an important though unpredictable and inequitable mechanism for political representation. The publicity of wrongdoing also disrupted top-down attempts by the ruling Partido Revolucionario Institucional to manage public discourse, exposing divisions within the party and forcing government officials to grapple with popular discontent. While critical reporters denounced corruption, they also withheld many secrets from public discussion, sometimes out of concern for their safety. Freije highlights the tensions between free speech and censorship, representation and exclusion, and transparency and secrecy that defined the Mexican public sphere in the late twentieth century.

Abandoning Their Beloved Land Alberto García, 2023-01-17 *Abandoning Their Beloved Land* offers an essential new history of the Bracero Program, a bilateral initiative that allowed Mexican men to work in the United States as seasonal contract farmworkers from 1942 to 1964. Using national and local archives in Mexico, historian Alberto García uncovers previously unexamined political factors that shaped the direction of the program, including how officials administered the bracero selection process and what motivated campesinos from central states to migrate. Notably, García's book reveals how and why the Mexican government's delegation of Bracero Program-related responsibilities, the powerful influence of conservative Catholic opposition groups in central Mexico, and the failures of the revolution's agrarian reform all profoundly influenced the program's administration and individuals' decisions to migrate as braceros.

Garcia, who spent a decade conducting anthropological fieldwork in Mexico City, draws readers into their many dimensions, casting light on the mothers and their children who are entangled in this hidden world. Following the stories of its denizens, she asks what these places are, why they

exist and what they reflect about Mexico and the wider world With extraordinary empathy and a sharp eye for detail Garcia attends to the lives that the anexos both sustain and erode wrestling with the question of why mothers turn to them as a site of refuge even as they reproduce violence Woven into these portraits is Garcia s own powerful story of family childhood homelessness and drugs a blend of ethnography and memoir converging on a set of fundamental questions about the many forms and meanings that violence love care family and hope may take Infused with profound ethnographic richness and moral urgency *The Way That Leads Among the Lost* is a stunning work of narrative nonfiction a book that will leave a deep mark on readers

Smith, 2018-08-07 Mexico today is one of the most dangerous places in the world to report the news and Mexicans have taken to the street to defend freedom of expression As Benjamin T Smith demonstrates in this history of the press and civil society the cycle of violent repression and protest over journalism is nothing new He traces it back to the growth in newspaper production and reading publics between 1940 and 1976 when a national thirst for tabloids crime sheets and magazines reached far beyond the middle class As Mexicans began to view local and national events through the prism of journalism everyday politics changed radically Even while lauding the liberty of the press the state developed an arsenal of methods to control what was printed including sophisticated spin and misdirection techniques covert financial payments and campaigns of threats imprisonment beatings and even murder The press was also pressured by media monopolists tacking between government demands and public expectations to maximize profits and by coalitions of ordinary citizens demanding that local newspapers publicize stories of corruption incompetence and state violence Since the Cold War both in Mexico City and in the provinces a robust radical journalism has posed challenges to government forces

political and social turbulence that characterized the Cold War era in general and by maintaining relations with Cuba it played a unique and heretofore overlooked role in the hemispheric Cold War The Cuban Revolution was an especially destabilizing force in Mexico because Fidel Castro's dedication to many of the same nationalist and populist causes that the Mexican revolutionaries had originally pursued in the early twentieth century called attention to the fact that the government had abandoned those promises A dynamic combination of domestic and international pressures thus initiated Mexico's Cold War and shaped its distinct evolution and outcomes

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
