An abnormal base deficit may indicate poor perfusion and tissue hypoxia, which results in the generation of hydrogen ions and metabolic acidosis.

Activation of the SYMPATHETIC NERVOUS SYSTEM causes the ADRENAL glands to release TWO catecholamines - EPINEPHRINE and NOREPINEPHRINE. These cause... - ANSWER-- HIGH levels of EPINEPHRINE cause smooth muscle relaxation in the airways and causes arteriole smooth muscle contractility (potentiating inotropic effect). EPI also INCREASES heart rate (positive chronotropic effect), peripheral vasoconstriction, and glycogenolysis (breakdown of glycogen stores in liver into glucose for cellular use)
