Walking to Guantánamo Richard Fleming, 2008 First time author Fleming pens a compelling and entertaining account of his walk across Cuba Truth be told he didn't walk from Pinar del Río to Guantanamo as he had envisioned but occasionally biked on the famous Chinese made Flying Pigeon or caught rides both motorized and animal powered He chronicles his travels in Cuba from several years ago around the time of the Elian Gonzalez incident given the state of the Cuban economy the lives of average Cubans have probably not changed drastically In addition to documenting his interactions with locals some revolutionary some not Fleming an avid birder includes lots of information on Cuban ornithology He discusses the practice of Santería Palo Monte and Vodou and includes detailed descriptions of Cuban music another of his delights He focuses his wry modest prose on the country not himself as a traveler He is brutally honest even when it shows him in an unflattering light This is perhaps the most accurate and readable work on Cuba this reviewer has seen Lee Arnold Historical Society of Pennsylvania Philadelphia Copyright 2008 Reed Business Information **The Guantanamo Effect** Laurel Emile Fletcher, Eric Stover, 2009-09-01 This book based on a two year study of former prisoners of the U S government's detention facility at Guantánamo Bay Cuba reveals in graphic detail the cumulative effect of the Bush administration's war on terror Scrupulously researched and devoid of rhetoric the book deepens the story of post 9/11 America and the nation's descent into the netherworld of prisoner abuse Researchers interviewed more than sixty former Guantánamo detainees in nine countries as well as key government officials military experts former guards interrogators lawyers for detainees and other camp personnel We hear directly from former detainees as they describe the events surrounding their capture their years of incarceration and the myriad difficulties preventing many from resuming a normal life upon returning home Prepared jointly by researchers with the Human Rights Center University of California Berkeley and the International Human Rights Law Clinic University of California Berkeley School of Law in partnership with the Center for Constitutional Rights The Guantánamo Effect contributes significantly to the debate surrounding the U S's commitment to international law during war time
