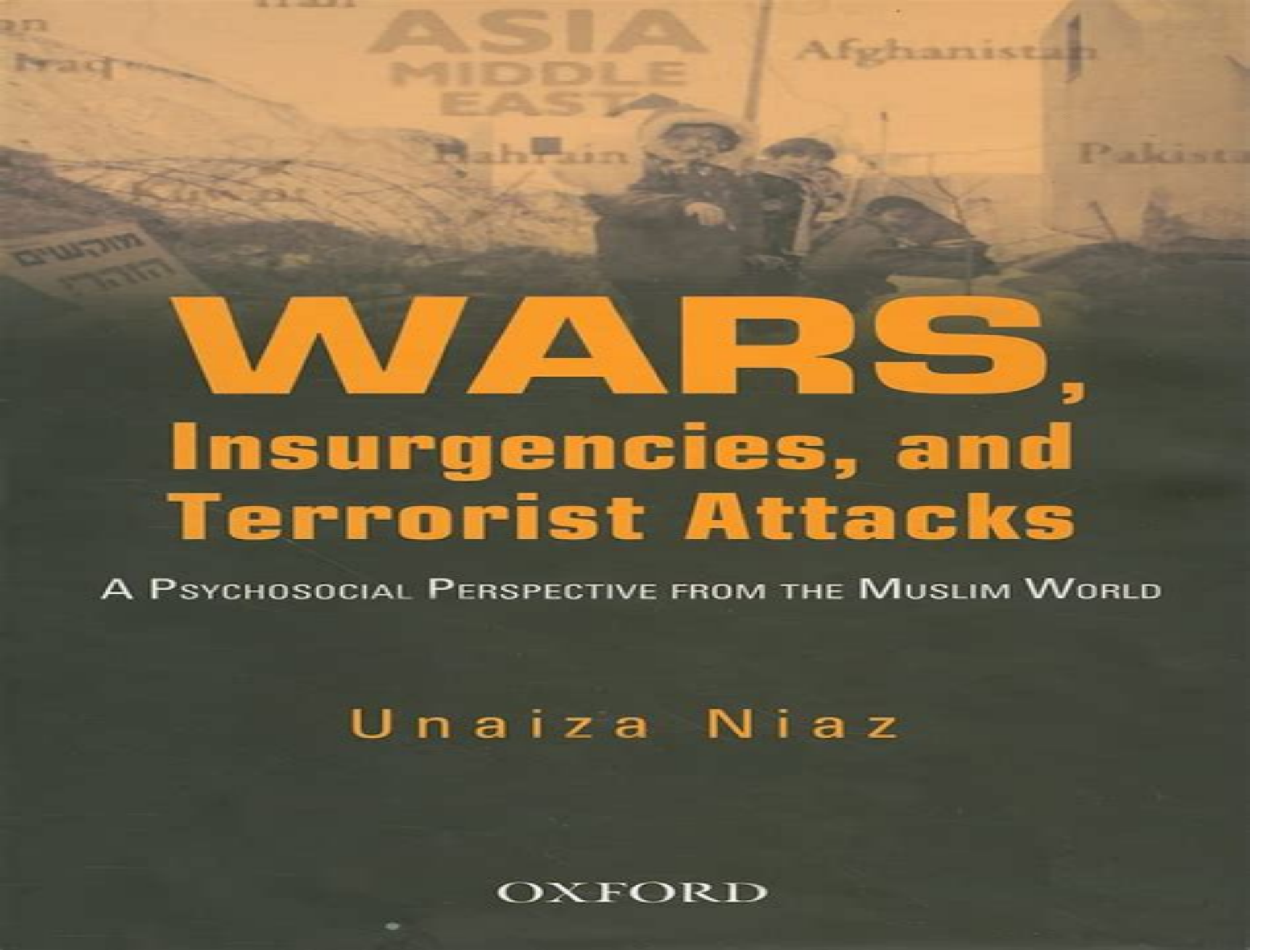

argued is what initially handed al Qaeda and later al Shabaab opportunities for mobilization enabled by its creative politicization of religion. The heavy handed tactics employed by security forces under the auspices of the War on Terror further catalyzed this process resulting in more Kenyan individuals joining the group. Using an historical and political process approach the book shows how the interplay of structural conditions and al Shabaab's mobilization strategy linked with individuals' motivations for joining the group. Based on individuals' own narratives about their participation the latter is empirically demonstrated to be non linear incorporating motivations beyond rational ones contrary to the overemphasis on ideology in the literature on participation in groups similar to al Shabaab. This book will be of much interest to students of political violence, African politics, Islamic studies and International Relations.

Understanding Near Crises and Escalation in World Politics Steven E. Lobell, Patrick James, Scott A. Silverstone, Victor Asal, Kyle Beardsley, Edward Gonzalez, Norrin M. Ripsman, 2025-07-31. This book introduces the near crisis phase of conflict and escalation. These time sensitive disputes between states and even with violent non state actors do not involve significant risk of military escalation at least in the moment. Investigating how and why some near crises escalate while others do not requires an explanation of the different dynamics of international disputes and the policy tools that states and international institutions can employ. We ask an expanded set of questions about specific cases and general patterns of conflict behavior such as why did Israeli leaders respond to Hezbollah's 2006 cross border raid with escalation resulting in the Second Lebanon War while in previous instances the Israelis limited their retaliation. Why didn't the 2015 Iranian Ballistic Missile Test or the 1995 Norwegian Black Brant Missile Launch escalate while the 2009 North Korea Missile Movement and the 1995 Taiwan Straits dispute tipped into a full blown crisis and why did the 2008 Russia Georgia conflict escalate from near crisis to war. We use primary sources and newly created data on near crises to answer these questions and others. The overall conclusion is that an ounce of prevention at the near crisis phase is worth a pound of cure in averting a full blown crisis or war. This book will be of great interest to students of security studies, conflict studies, foreign policy and international relations.

Extreme Britain Elizabeth Pearson, 2023-12-11. Misogyny and toxic masculinity are increasingly implicated in radicalisation. From the men's incel involuntary celibate movement online to jihadist groups like Islamic State to radical right Free Speech protests radicalisation spans ideologies. Though an often used term the process of radicalisation is not well understood and the role of gender and masculinities has often been ignored. This book uses primary research among two of Britain's key extremist movements the banned Islamist group al Muhajiroun and those networked to it and the anti Islam radical right including the English Defence League and Britain First to reveal radicalisation as a masculinity project. Through interviews with leaders including Anjem Choudary, Jayda Fransen and Tommy Robinson as well as their followers Extreme Britain explores the emergence of extreme misogyny and masculinities. Pearson situates extreme identities in wider social norms showing how masculinities are mobilised into action. The book cautions against oversimplifying extreme masculinity as toxic. It demonstrates how both men

and women do extreme masculinities and the costs and benefits to them both of activism Understanding the men and women involved in extreme movements will better equip us to counter them This fascinating study offers invaluable insight into some of their lives and motivations

Terrorism Risk Assessment Instruments Raymond Corrado, Ariel Merari, 2021-03-15 The search for a distinct terrorist profile has been going on for many years and while it is generally agreed that nobody is born a terrorist there is plenty of disagreement about why a person might become one Whereas personal and situational push and pull factors can be combined to determine how and why young people become involved in terrorism preventing an individual from following a path that ends in violence without moral restraint poses an enormous challenge especially in an open society This book presents papers from the NATO Advanced Research Workshop titled A Review of the Utility of Existing Terrorism Risk Assessment Instruments and Policies Is there the Need for Possible New Approaches held in Berlin Germany on 29 30 November 2019 Researchers were asked to present papers for discussion sessions with invited participants and practitioners from a number of NATO member and partner countries Various assessment instruments for identifying problematic individuals at an early stage were presented by experts It was generally agreed that due to cultural religious and other differences there is no simple way to identify the relatively few high risk individuals among the larger population of politically radicalized but not necessarily violent individuals who pose no threat Framed by an Introduction and Conclusion the 16 chapters in the book are divided into three parts Theory and Risk Threat Assessment Instrument Policy Themes Implementation of Politically Motivated Terrorism Protocols and Personality Traits Disorders Anti State Terrorism Profiles and the DSM 5 Personality Trait Instrument This practice oriented book will be of interest to all those tasked with protecting society from some of its most dangerous members

How Globalization Spurs Terrorism Fathali M. Moghaddam, 2008-08-30 This book explores modern Islamic terrorism in the context of globalization and cultural evolution 21st century terrorism is different and new first because it relies heavily on electronic communication systems and other aspects of modern technologies and second because it is in large part a product of fractured globalization with its associated threats to the collective identity of Muslims Part one of this work contrasts globalization as an ideal with globalization as it is actually taking place with its enormous contradictions and threats Moghaddam a longtime and highly respected terrorism and conflict researcher argues that globalization is resulting in serious threats to the basic psychological needs of some particularly in connection with collective identity Part two explores how globalization has brought sudden contact between different groups with no previous history of large scale contact resulting in a rapid decline in diversity Terrorism is one of the dysfunctional defense mechanisms of people in such conditions facing external threats Part three describes long term solutions focusing particularly on the role of women and the nature of the family in traditional Islamic societies Moghaddam shows us why globalization is resulting in what he calls catastrophic evolution the rapid decline and disappearance of

Moghaddam, 2006-06-30 Presenting a picture of the world giving rise to Islamic terrorism *From the Terrorists' Point of View* argues that terrorism arises from a deep and pervasive identity crisis in Islamic societies The account presented in these 10 chapters is shaped by the author's first hand experiences of life in the Islamic world as well as his more than quarter century of research on the psychology of conflict and radicalism Moghaddam shows us why individuals who are recruited into terrorist organizations are convinced it is the only viable alternative They believe there are no effective legal means of expressing their grievances and participating in decision making so they become socialized to see terrorist organizations as legitimate The organizations they join train them to adopt an us vs them categorical view seeing all members outside their group including civilians as among the evil enemy ranks Looking at the perspective of the terrorist groups themselves Moghaddam explains why current U S policy focusing almost exclusively on individual terrorists and their eradication will achieve only short term gains He argues that the more effective long term policy against terrorism is prevention That he writes requires cultivation and nourishment of contextualized democracy through culturally appropriate avenues Only allowing people a greater voice and creating mobility opportunities for them will ensure that they do not feel a need to climb the staircase to terrorism **Why Muslims Rebel** Mohammed M.
