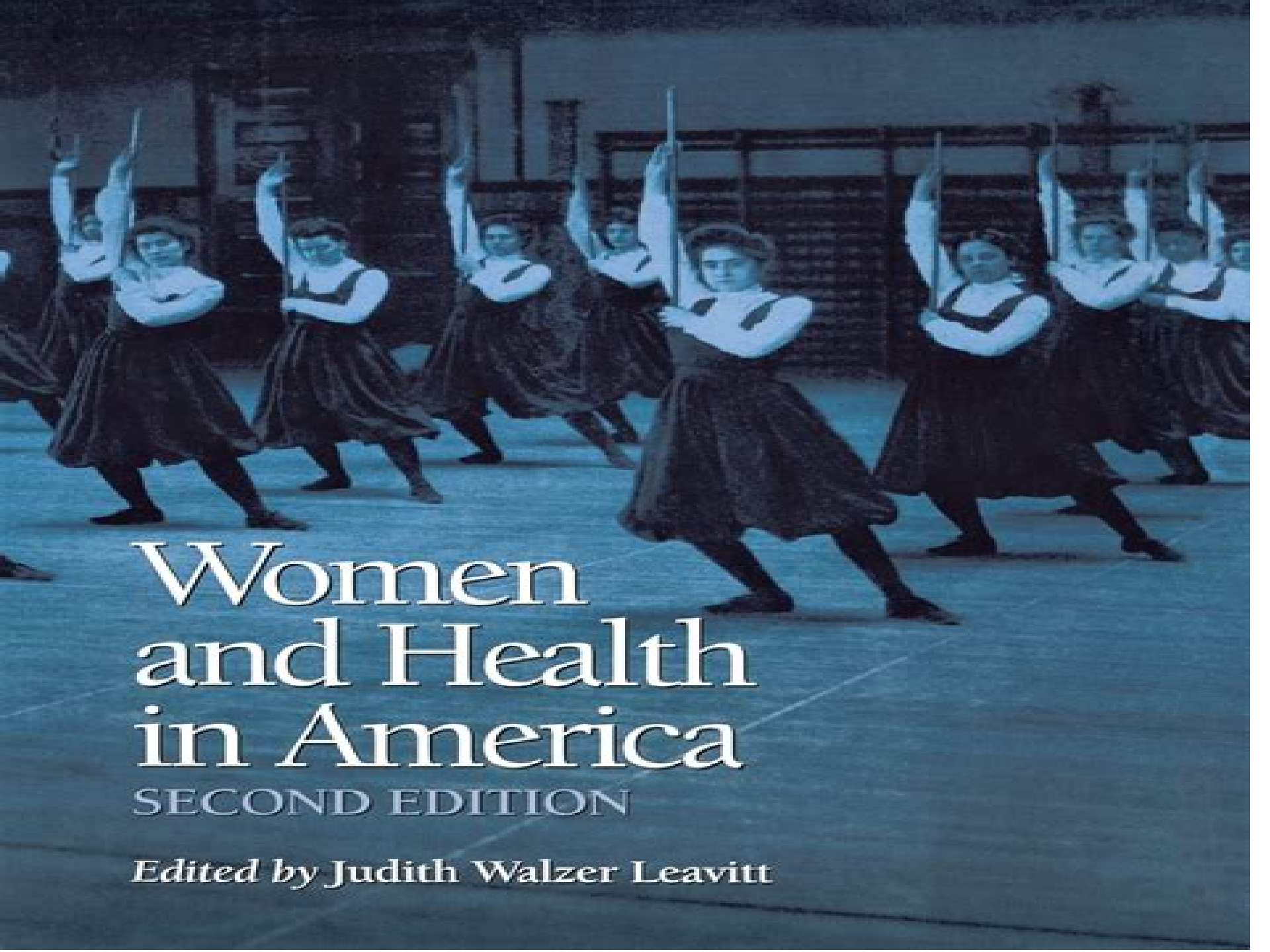

The Birth Control Clinic in a Marketplace World Rose Holz, 2014-02 An examination of the complex interrelationship between charity birth control clinics and the commercial marketplace in the United States through the 1970s The Birth Control Clinic in a Marketplace World is the first book to chart the origins and evolution of the charity birth control clinic movement in the United States from the 1910s through the 1970s a period that witnessed dramatic transformation in the goods and services such clinics provided Rose Holz uncovers the virtually unexamined relationship between Planned Parenthood and the commercial marketplace sphere Challenging more than thirty years of historiography on birth control Holz sheds new light on battles over reproductive rights through her analysis of the Planned Parenthood Federation of America within the context of the commercial birth control world Revealing that it would be Planned Parenthood's engagement to charity the argument the organization once used to discredit the presumed profit driven exploitation of the marketplace that would put precisely those women it hoped to assist in dangerous situations she asks such probing questions as What were the meanings attached to the provision of birth control and its commercial distribution How in turn were these meanings used as sources of power The project draws on rich primary sources to answer these questions and to examine the historical role of the local birth control clinic in modern America Rose Holz earned her PhD in history from the University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign She is associate director of and associate professor of practice in the Women's and Gender Studies Program at the University of Nebraska Lincoln

Unceasing Militant, Second Edition Alison M. Parker, 2025-03-17 Born into slavery during the Civil War Mary Church Terrell 1863 1954 would become one of the most prominent activists of her time with a career bridging the late nineteenth century to the civil rights movement of the 1950s The first president of the National Association of Colored Women and a founding member of the NAACP Terrell collaborated

closely with the likes of Frederick Douglass Ida B Wells and W E B Du Bois *Unceasing Militant* is the first full length biography of Terrell bringing her vibrant voice and personality to life Though most accounts of Terrell focus almost exclusively on her public activism Alison M Parker also looks at the often turbulent unexplored moments in her life to provide a more complete account of a woman dedicated to changing the culture and institutions that perpetuated inequality throughout the United States This new edition includes a new preface in which Parker reflects on the resurgence of public interest in Terrell and discusses the newly available digitized files of Terrell s papers at the Library of Congress

Science Has No Sex Arleen Marcia Tuchman,2006-12-08 German born Marie Zakrzewska 1829 1902 was one of the most prominent female physicians of nineteenth century America Best known for creating a modern hospital and medical education program for women Zakrzewska battled against the gendering of science and the restrictive definitions of her sex In *Science Has No Sex* Arleen Tuchman examines the life and work of a woman who continues to challenge historians of gender to this day At a time when most women physicians laid claim to female qualities of care and nurturance to justify their professional choice Zakrzewska insisted that all physicians regardless of gender should depend upon the rational faculties developed through training in the natural sciences She viewed science as a democratizing tool anyone could master science she asserted and therefore the doors to the elite profession of medicine should be opened to all Shedding light on the changes that radically transformed medicine in the late nineteenth century Tuchman s analysis also demonstrates how Zakrzewska s activism is important to the ongoing debate over the relationship between science and sex

which Chicagoans negotiated the extraordinary challenges of rape as either victims or accused perpetrators Drawing on extensive trial testimony government reports and media coverage Dawn Rae Flood examines how individual men and women particularly African Americans understood and challenged rape myths and claimed their right to be protected as American citizens protected by the State against violence and protected from the State s prejudicial investigations and interrogations Flood shows how defense strategies evolving in concert with changes in the broader cultural and legal environment challenged assumptions about black criminality while continuing to deploy racist and sexist stereotypes against the plaintiffs Uniquely combining legal studies medical history and personal accounts Flood pays special attention to how medical evidence was considered in rape cases and how victim patients were treated by hospital personnel She also analyzes medical testimony in modern rape trials tracing the evolution of contemporary rape kit procedures as shaped by legal requirements trial strategies feminist reform efforts and women s experiences
