The Women's Liberation Movement and the Politics of Class in Britain George Stevenson, 2019-02-21 This is the first study of the British Women's Liberation Movement's relationship with class politics It explores the meaning of class to women's liberationists identities and activism both nationally and regionally using a previously neglected feminist cluster in North East England as a case study Stevenson demonstrates that British feminism was shaped fundamentally by its relationship to synthesis with and rejection of class politics Through these processes feminists recognised how post war changes in the economy and gender roles were reshaping class and the Women's Liberation Movement attempted to remake class politics in response However socio economic and cultural class differences between the women involved linked to occupation education and background remained intractable obstacles causing tensions within groups fragmentations into specific class based groups and the ultimate failure of the movement to coalesce into a coherent coalition with labour politics despite great levels of solidarity around particular struggles Examining regional feminism against the national backdrop The Women's Liberation Movement and the Politics of Class in Britain provides an engaging exploration of the fruitful but challenging relationship between British feminism and class politics in a capitalist society

The Dynamics of Working-class Politics Michael Savage, 1987 In an important contribution to a perennial debate Dr Savage argues that over concentration on national labour movements has ignored the variety of local political strategies developed by working class movements these variations show that working class politics develops on the basis of different types of solidarity rooted in various forms of local social structure Such mutations are not a recent development testifying to the decline of class politics but have been an enduring feature of capitalist societies In a detailed case study of Preston Lancashire Dr Savage shows how the strategies and strengths of the various political parties changed between 1880 and 1940 as workplace solidarities gave way to neighbourhood based ones and as changing gender relations in the textile industry facilitated the organisation of women Its sophisticated use of sociological theory and detailed empirical analysis distinguish **The Dynamics of Working Class Politics** as one of the more important essays in historical sociology published in past years
