Theory of mind and its development have been subjects of much research over the last 40 years. It is generally thought to be very important in cognitive and social development. However, there is still much debate as to how it should be defined and even as to whether it is a single entity. In particular, there is controversy as to the extent to which it should be seen as a specific cognitive module or rather as dependent on or mutually developing with other cognitive abilities and characteristics such as language, metacognition, executive function and cognitive and perceptual styles that emphasize gist versus detail, strong versus weak central coherence. It is also possible that the theory of mind itself has several different components which may be related to different degrees of different cognitive abilities and characteristics. Any relationships between the theory of mind and other cognitive characteristics may also vary with age and may differ between typically developing children and those with autism and other atypical conditions. Gaining a greater understanding of these issues is important to increasing our understanding of theory of mind itself, the nature of cognitive development, the similarities and differences between typically and atypically developing children and whether it may be possible to devise interventions to improve theory of mind either directly or by means of improving other abilities.
