Egypt as a Monster in the Book of Ezekiel Safwat Marzouk, 2015-06-05 Appealing to Monster Theory and the ancient Near Eastern motif of Chaoskampf Safwat Marzouk argues that the paradoxical character of the category of the monster is what prompts the portrayal of Egypt as a monster in the book of Ezekiel While on the surface the monster seems to embody utter difference underlying its otherness there is a disturbing sameness Though the monster may be defeated and its body dismembered it is never completely annihilated Egypt is portrayed as a monster in the book of Ezekiel because Egypt represents the threat of religious assimilation Although initially the monstrosity of Egypt is constructed because of the shared elements of identity between Egypt and Israel the prophet flips this imagery of monster in order to embody Egypt as a monstrous Other In a combat myth YHWH defeats the monster and dismembers its body Despite its near annihilation Egypt in Ezekiel's rhetoric is not entirely obliterated Rather it is kept at bay hovering at the periphery questioning Israel's identity

Peter Feinman, 2021-10-13 Did the Exodus occur This question has been asked in biblical scholarship since its origin as a modern science The desire to resolve the question scientifically was a key component in the funding of archaeological excavations in the nineteenth century Egyptian archaeologists routinely equated sites with their presumed biblical counterpart Initially it was taken for granted that the Exodus had occurred It was simply a matter of finding the archaeological data to prove it So far those results have been for naught The Exodus An Egyptian Story takes a very real world approach to understanding the Exodus It is not a story of cosmic spectacles that miraculously or coincidentally occurred when a people prepared to leave Egypt There are no special effects in the telling of this story Instead the story is told with real people in the real world doing what real people do Peter Feinman does not rely on the biblical text and is not trying to prove that the Bible is true He places the Exodus within Egyptian history based on the Egyptian archaeological record It is a story of the rejection of the Egyptian cultural construct and defiance of Ramses II Egyptologists not biblical scholars are the guides to telling the Exodus story What would you expect Ramses II to say after he had been humiliated If there is an Egyptian smoking gun for the Exodus how would you recognize it To answer these questions requires us to take the Exodus seriously as a major event at the royal level in Egyptian history **Variability in the Earlier Egyptian**

Egyptians produced several wonders of the world revolutionized architecture and construction created some of the world's first systems of mathematics and medicine and established language and art that spread across the known world With world famous leaders like King Tut and Cleopatra it's no wonder that today's world has so many Egyptologists Perhaps the most intriguing aspect of ancient Egyptian civilization was its inception from the ground up as the ancient Egyptians had no prior civilization which they could use as a template In fact ancient Egypt itself became a template for the civilizations that followed The Greeks and the Romans were so impressed with Egyptian culture that they often attributed many attributes of their own culture usually erroneously to the Egyptians To the ancient Egyptians as was the case with any society made up of inquiring humans the world was a confusing and often terrifying place of destruction death and unexplained phenomena In order to make sense of such an existence they resorted to teleological stories Giving a phenomenon a story made it less horrifying and it also helped them make sense of the world around them Unsurprisingly then the ancient Egyptian gods permeated every aspect of existence Baboons held a prestigious place in Egyptian religion They were kept as sacred animals in many temples because contemporary Egyptians considered them the original religious observers particularly with respect to the sun god Re Ancient Egyptians took the wild baboons stretching on their hind legs forelegs raised to the sky to be an oration to the sun god at dawn Furthermore these ancient ancestors of the land of Egypt were greeted at dawn by the concatenations of the baboons nattering which the religious minded took to be an early morning devotion and even believed that the baboons spoke the original language of religion and a claim they could understand baboons was often one asserted by certain members of the priestly class However it is his association with the ibis that most defines Thoth's visual imagery Since the ancient Egyptians believed that the universe arose from the swamp like waters of Nun it was the water bird that garnered the most prestigious veneration Birds like geese herons and the ibises were associated with this period of creation and according to some beliefs the world came about thanks to the great honk of a primordial goose whose eggshell was said to be preserved in the temple of Thoth It was believed that Re created Thoth's baboon form to be that of his shining moon but his ibis form was that of a messenger between heaven and earth although he was much more than this Thoth The History and Legacy of the Ancient Egyptian God Who Maintains the Universe looks at the mythology surrounding one of antiquity's most famous deities Along with pictures depicting important people places and events you will learn about Thoth like never before
