Macbeth articulates two reasons why he should not kill King Duncan. Firstly he is a subject of the King so should be a loyal servant to him. Secondly as host, he should protect King Duncan from intruders whilst he is in his care.

Macheth declares that King Duncan has been a very good King and that his murder would therefore not be justified in the eyes of the heavens. This may result in God punishing everyone involved.
