How Traditions Live and Die Olivier Morin, 2016 Of all the things we do and say most will never be repeated or reproduced Once in a while however an idea or a practice generates a chain of transmission that covers more distance through space and time than any individual person ever could What makes such transmission chains possible For two centuries the dominant view from psychology to anthropology was that humans owe their cultural prosperity to their powers of imitation In this view modern cultures exist because the people who carry them are gifted at remembering storing and reproducing information How Traditions Live and Die proposes an alternative to this standard view What makes traditions live is not a general purpose imitation capacity Cultural transmission is partial selective often unfaithful Some traditions live on in spite of this because they tap into widespread and basic cognitive preferences These attractive traditions spread not by being better retained or more accurately transferred but because they are transmitted over and over This theory is used to shed light on various puzzles of cultural change from the distribution of bird songs to the staying power of children's rhymes and to explain the special relation that links the human species to its cultures Morin combines recent work in cognitive anthropology with new advances in quantitative cultural history to map and predict the diffusion of traditions This book is both an introduction and an accessible alternative to contemporary theories of cultural evolution

The Evolution of Techniques Mathieu Charbonneau, 2024-03-19 A novel interdisciplinary exploration of the relative contributions of rigidity and flexibility in the adoption maintenance and evolution of technical traditions Techniques can either be used in rigid stereotypical ways or in flexibly adaptive ways or in some combination of the two The Evolution of Techniques edited by Mathieu Charbonneau addresses the impacts of both flexibility and rigidity on how techniques are used transformed and reconstructed at varying social and temporal scales The multidisciplinary contributors demonstrate the important role of the varied learning contexts and social configurations involved in the transmission use and evolution of techniques They explore the diversity of cognitive behavioral sociocultural and ecological mechanisms that promote and constrain technical flexibility and rigidity proposing a deeper picture of the enablers of and obstacles to technical transmission and change In line with the extended evolutionary synthesis the book proposes a more inclusive and materially grounded conception of technical evolution in terms of promiscuous dynamic and multidirectional causal processes Offering new evidence and novel theoretical perspectives the contributors deploy a diversity of methods including ethnographies field and laboratory experiments cladistics and phylogenetic tree building historiography and philosophical analysis Examples of the wide range of topics covered include field experiments with potters from five cultures stability and change in Paleolithic toolmaking why children lack flexibility when making tools and cultural techniques in nonhuman animals The volume's three thematic sections are Timescales of technical rigidity and flexibility Rigid copying to flexible reconstruction Exogenous factors of technical rigidity and flexibility The volume closes with a discussion by philosopher Kim Sterelny Contributors Rita Astuti

Banditry in the Medieval Balkans, 800-1500 Panos Sophoulis, 2020-10-28 This book explores the history of banditry in the medieval Balkans between the ninth and fifteenth centuries While several scholars have recognized the problems which various outlaw groups caused in the region during the Middle Ages few have given much attention to the bandits themselves their origins their reasons for taking up brigandage and the steps taken by the central authorities to control their activity Among other things this book identifies three main sources of banditry shepherds soldiers and peasants Far from being lone wolves these men operated within well defined social networks Poverty played a decisive role in driving them to a life of crime but there is strong evidence to suggest that the growing economic prosperity in parts of the Balkans from the ninth century onwards may have also contributed to the rise of the phenomenon *Networks and Geographies of Global Social Policy Diffusion* Michael Windzio, Ivo Mossig, Fabian Besche-Truthe, Helen Seitzer, 2021-11-24 This open access book analyses the global diffusion of social policy as a process driven by multiplex ties between countries in global social networks The contributions analyze links between countries via global trade colonial history similarity in culture and spatial proximity Networks are viewed as the structural backbone of the diffusion process and diffusion is analysed via several subfields of social policy in order to interrogate which network dimensions drive this process The focus is on a global perspective of social policy diffusion via networks and it is the first book to explicitly follow this macro quantitative perspective on diffusion at a global scale whilst also comparing different networks The collection tests the network structures in terms of their relevance to the diffusion process in different subfields of social policy such as old age and survivor pensions labor and labor markets health and long term care education and training and family and gender policy The book will therefore be invaluable to students and researchers of global social policy sociology political science international relations organization theory and economics **Living with Distrust** Radu Umbres, 2022 Based on fieldwork in the Romanian village of Sateni this book offers an ethnographic interdisciplinary interpretation of social interactions in a low trust society Radu Umbres makes sense of the villagers worldview one divided between strong moral relationships and deep suspicion towards the rest of the village society *Communicating & Relating* Robert B. Intercorporeality Christian Meyer, Jürgen Streeck, J. Scott Jordan, 2017-07-10 This book draws inspiration from Maurice Merleau-Ponty's concept of intercorporeality to offer a new multidisciplinary perspective on the body. By drawing attention to the body's ability to simultaneously sense and be sensed, Merleau-Ponty transcends the object-subject divide and describes how bodies are about, into, and within other bodies. Such inherent relationality constitutes the essence of intercorporeality, and the chapters in this book examine such relationality from a host of diverse perspectives. The book begins with an introductory chapter in which the editors review the current research on bodily interaction and introduce the notion of intercorporeality as a potentially integrative framework. The first section then offers four chapters devoted to clarifying theoretical and developmental perspectives on intercorporeality. Section 2 contains three chapters that provide insight on intercorporeality from evolutionary, historical, and cross-sectional perspectives. In Section 3, four chapters examine the intercorporeal nature of meaning-making during human interaction. Section 4 then presents three chapters that explore the intercorporeal nature of multi-agent interactions and the role that non-animate bodies, i.e., objects, play in such interaction. Throughout all the chapters, the authors work to integrate research in their specific discipline into the larger transdisciplinary notion of intercorporeality. This collection provides an indisputably unique perspective on bodies in interaction while simultaneously offering an interdisciplinary way forward in contemporary scholarship on bodies, meaning, and interaction.

The Ethnomethodology

Program Douglas W. Maynard, John Heritage, 2022 It's been more than fifty years since Harold Garfinkel created the field of ethnomethodology, a discipline that offers a new way of understanding how people make sense of their everyday world. Since his book *Studies in Ethnomethodology* published in 1967, there has been a substantial, although often subterranean, growth in ethnomethodological (EM) work. Studies in and appreciation of ethnomethodological work continue to grow, but the breadth and penetration of his insights and inspiration for ongoing research have yet to secure their full measure of recognition. This volume celebrates Harold Garfinkel's enormous contributions to sociology and conversation analysis, exploring how ethnomethodology emerged, the empirical consequences of Garfinkel's work, and the significant contemporary work that has resulted from it. Douglas W. Maynard and John Heritage bring together experts from a wide range of theoretical and empirical areas to create the first comprehensive collection of work on EM that encompasses its role in studies of work in conversation.

Analysis and in other subdisciplines Chapters highlight ethnomethodology's distinctive forms of ethnographic inquiry and its influences on a host of substantive domains including legal environments science and technology workplace and organizational inquiries survey research social problems and deviance and disability and atypical interaction The book explains how EM especially helped to set the agenda for gender studies while also developing insights for inquiries into racial and ethnic features of everyday life and experience Still there is much of what Garfinkel called unfinished business which means that ethnomethodological inquiries are continuing to intensify and develop Harold Garfinkel and Ethnomethodology addresses this unfinished business not only drawing attention to past accomplishments in the field but also suggesting how these accomplishments set the stage for future endeavors that will benefit from EM inspired approaches to social organization and interaction

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
