Wacousta or, The Prophecy John Richardson, 1987-12-15 Set on the northwest frontier during the Pontiac conspiracy of the 1760s this story of false identity wasted love diabolic vengeance and unquenchable hatred articulates themes and mythologies relevant to French British Canadian and American history

Canadian Gothic Cynthia Sugars, 2014-01-15 This book explores the Gothic tradition in Canadian literature by tracing a distinctive reworking of the British Gothic in Canada It traces the ways the Gothic genre was reinvented for a specifically Canadian context On the one hand Canadian writers expressed anxiety about the applicability of the British Gothic tradition to the colonies on the other they turned to the Gothic for its vitalising rather than unsettling potential After charting this history of Gothic infusion Canadian Gothic turns its attention to the body of Aboriginal and diasporic writings that respond to this discourse of national self invention from a post colonial perspective These counter narratives unsettle the naturalising force of this invented history rendering the sense of Gothic comfort newly strange The Canadian Gothic tradition has thus been a conflicted one which reimagines the Gothic as a form of cultural sustenance This volume offers an important reconsideration of the Gothic legacy in Canada

America Unbound Antonio Barrenechea, 2016-11-15 This original contribution to hemispheric American literary studies comprises readings of three important novels from Mexico Canada and the United States Carlos Fuentes's *Terra Nostra* Quebecois writer Jacques Poulin's *Volkswagen Blues* and Native American writer Leslie Marmon Silko's *Almanac of the Dead* The encyclopedic novel has particular generic characteristics that serve these writers as a vehicle for the reincorporation of hemispheric histories Starting with an examination of *Moby Dick* as precursor Barrenechea shows how this narrative genre allows Fuentes Poulin and Silko to reflect the interconnected world of today as well as to dramatize indigenous and colonial values in their narratives His close attention to written documents visual representations and oral traditions in these encyclopedic novels sheds light on their comparative cultural relations and the New World from pole to pole This study amplifies the scope of America across cultures and languages time and tradition

Imitation Nation Jason Richards, 2017-12-26 How did early Americans define themselves The American exceptionalist perspective tells us that the young republic rejected Europeans Native Americans and African Americans in order to isolate a national culture and a white national identity Imitativeness at this time was often seen as antithetical to self and national creation but Jason Richards argues that imitation was in fact central to such creation *Imitation Nation* shows how whites simultaneously imitated and therefore absorbed the cultures they so readily disavowed as well as how Indians and blacks emulated the power and privilege of whiteness while they mocked and resisted white authority By examining the republic's foundational literature including works by Washington Irving James Fenimore Cooper Harriet Beecher Stowe Herman Melville and Martin Delany Richards argues that the national desire for cultural uniqueness and racial purity was in constant conflict with the national need to imitate the racial and cultural other for self definition The book offers a new model for understanding the ways in

Groening,2005-01-18 Groening argues that what Frantz Fanon terms the manichean allegory has shaped European understanding of the New World to such an extent that the image patterns fundamental to the allegory continue to dominate depictions of Native characters Although a world separated into two categories defined by light and dark reason and emotion mind and body technology and nature future and past is no longer also characterized as good and evil revaluing the tropes has not made them disappear And without their disappearance good intentions notwithstanding nonaboriginal Canadian writers will continue to portray Native characters as part of a dead and dying culture Groening demonstrates that the real issue cannot be about censorship as censorship involves the abrogation of freedom and the imagination is never truly free

The Indian Chief as Tragic Hero Gordon M.
