Walking and Trekking in Zagori Aris Leontaritis, 2019-01-15 Zagori in Greece's Northern Pindos National Park is among the last relatively undiscovered and unspoilt hiking destinations in Europe This guide presents a selection of thirty walks and three short treks within the region's captivating scenery from dramatic gorges to mystical forests crystal clear turquoise rivers rugged alpine peaks and characterful mountain villages Routes vary from easy walks on clear paths to strenuous ascents and mountain traverses meaning that there is something to suit most ambitions and abilities Clear mapping accompanies the route description and the introduction to the guide covers all the practicalities including getting to Zagori accommodation equipment maps and safety There is also a wealth of information about the region's rich history architecture geology plants and wildlife as well as fascinating notes on points of interest encountered on route The routes are presented in five chapters covering Central Zagori Vikos Gorge and vicinity Mt Timfi Konitsa and Mt Smolikas and Valia Kalda National Park and Metsovo with highlights including Mt Timfi and Mt Smolikas Greece's second highest mountain the breathtaking Vikos Gorge traditional stone arch bridges and the alpine tarns of Drakolimni Dragonlakes With so much stunning scenery this is a region that cries out to be explored

Hiking and Cycling in the Black Forest Kat Morgenstern, 2019-03-15 15 day walks 3 multi stage treks and 5 cycle routes are described covering the north central and

southern areas of Germany's Black Forest The walks and cycle routes are evenly distributed across all three areas and comprise both long distance routes and day walks although each stage of every long distance walk can also be done as individual day tour The chosen routes include the main Black Forest destinations such as Feldberg Belchen Schauinsland Hornisgrinde and Mummelsee as well as Allerheiligen Abbey and waterfalls and the source of the Danube to name but a few Two of the three long distance routes are certified quality trails Schluchtensteig 120km which means gorge trail traverses the Wutachschlucht one of the last untamed river systems in Germany and Zweitersteig 108km a highly diverse circular route which leads through some of the most beautiful and contrasting parts of the Central Black Forest Seensteig 71km partially follows the central ridge of the Black Forest mountain range offering unsurpassed views along the way The cycle routes 4 day rides and the 242km Southern Black Forest Cycle Route are mostly easy and scenic and utilise the extensive and well maintained bicycle trail system that criss crosses the entire region The walks and rides are described in detail and basic maps are provided for orientation

Hiking in Norway - South Ute Koninx, 2021-02-15 This guide describes 10 shorter hut to hut treks showcasing southern Norway's wild natural beauty with highlights including Galdhøpiggen Norway's highest peak at 2469m and the iconic Pulpit Rock and Kjeragbolten on the Lysefjord The routes range from 3 to 8 days although many can be adapted or combined to create longer or shorter routes and cover Jotunheimen Rondane Dovrefjell Trollheimen and Ryfylke They are suitable for experienced hikers with a good level of fitness and can be walked from mid July to the end of September Clear route description and mapping are provided for each hike Stages are graded according to difficulty although all of the routes follow waymarked trails some cross remote and challenging terrain which may include exposed sections calling for a sure foot and a good head for heights However in many instances alternatives are provided avoiding the most demanding sections The guide also offers comprehensive advice on public transport access and accommodation options and background notes on each of the featured mountain regions From narrow ridges to wide glacial valleys and from shimmering fjords to striking alpine peaks Norway is home to many awe inspiring landscapes Throw in the warmth and hospitality of the Norwegian Trekking Association's extensive hut network and you have all the ingredients of a fantastic adventure This guide is an ideal companion to discovering some of Norway's classic shorter hikes and best loved mountain landscapes

trail from Port la Nouvelle on the Mediterranean coast to Ariège's departmental capital Foix linking several of the impressive Cathar castles The route follows ancient footpaths jeep tracks and country lanes and calls for a moderate level of fitness as it sweeps from sea level to 1300m across the rugged hill ranges of the Corbières and Fenouillades The guide describes the main route in 13 stages and also includes the slightly more direct north variant as well as suggestions for shorter itineraries Summary statistics introduce each day's walking and are followed by step by step route description illustrated with clear mapping There are also details of facilities available en route and accommodation listings An introduction covers all the practicalities with comprehensive advice for planning your trip including when to go how to get there and what to take in addition to a wealth of information about the region's fascinating history and the intriguing Cathars themselves The trail traverses rocky hills and meanders through woodland vineyards ancient villages gorges and plateaus As well as the rich Cathar heritage there are also historic wine producing towns sites associated with the French Resistance of WWII and mysterious places steeped in ancient legend The guide is a perfect companion to discovering the Cathar Way and the captivating stories of this distinctive region
